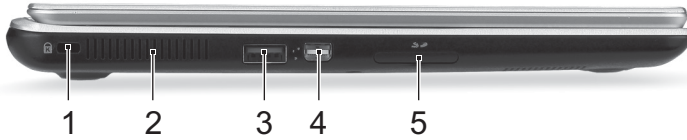
#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Webcam	Web camera for video communication. <i>A light next to the webcam indicates that the webcam is active.</i>
2		Touchscreen	Displays computer output. Supports multi-touch input.






Keyboard view



#	Icon	Item	Description
		Power indicator	Indicates the computer's power status.
1		Battery indicator	Indicates the computer's battery status. Charging: <i>The light is amber when the battery is charging.</i> Fully charged: <i>The light is blue when plugged in.</i>
2		Keyboard	For entering data into your computer. See "Using the keyboard" on page 8. Caution: <i>Do not use a keyboard protector or similar cover as the keyboard includes ventilation intakes for cooling.</i>
3		Touchpad	Touch-sensitive pointing device which functions like a computer mouse. <i>The touchpad and selection buttons form a single surface.</i> <i>Press down firmly on the touchpad surface to perform a left click.</i> <i>Press down firmly on the lower right corner to perform a right click.</i>
4		Microphone	Internal microphone for sound recording.

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Kensington lock slot 	Connects to a Kensington-compatible computer security lock. <i>Wrap the computer security lock cable around an immovable object such as a table or handle of a locked drawer. Insert the lock into the notch and turn the key to secure the lock. Keyless models are also available.</i>
2		Ventilation and cooling fan	Allows the computer to stay cool. <i>Do not cover or obstruct the openings.</i>
3		USB port	Connects to USB devices.
4		Acer Converter Port	Connects to the Acer Converter cable, allowing for easy connection to a LAN, an external display or an additional USB device. Note: <i>There are different cables available. Please check with your retailer to see which are compatible with your computer.</i>
5		SD card reader	Accepts one Secure Digital (SD or SDHC) card. Note: <i>To remove the card, simply pull it from the slot.</i>

Information on USB 3.0

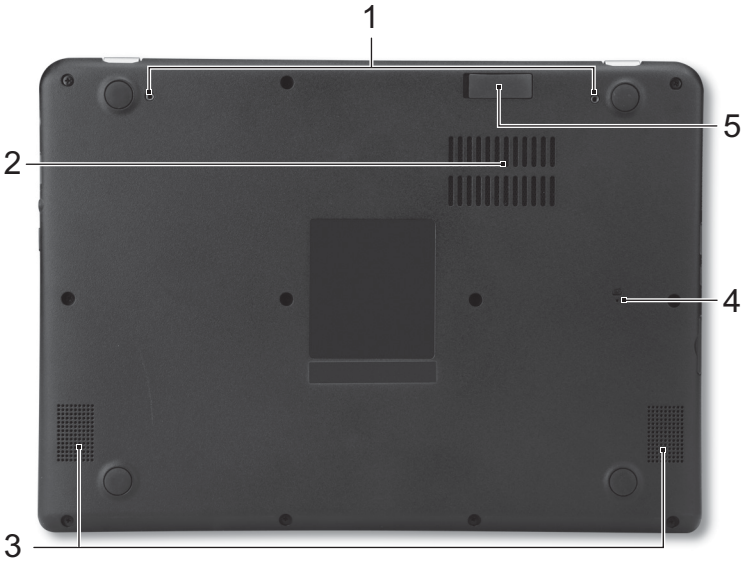
- USB 3.0 compatible ports are blue.
- Compatible with USB 3.0 and earlier devices.
- For optimal performance, use USB 3.0-certified devices.
- Defined by the USB 3.0 specification (SuperSpeed USB).


Right view



#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Power button	Turns the computer on and off.
2		Headset/speaker jack	Connects to audio devices (e.g., speakers, headphones) or a headset with microphone.
3		USB port	Connects to USB devices.
4		DC-in jack	Connects to an AC adapter.

Base view



#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Screw holes	Screw holes for attaching the optional second battery.
2		Ventilation and cooling fan	Allows the computer to stay cool. <i>Do not cover or obstruct the openings.</i>
3		Speakers	Deliver stereo audio output.
4		Battery reset pinhole	Insert a paperclip into the hole and press for four seconds to reset the computer (simulates removing and reinstalling the battery).
5		Second battery connector	Connects to the second battery to provide power and charge the second battery.

Using the keyboard

The keyboard has full-sized keys and an embedded numeric keypad, separate cursor, lock, Windows, function and special keys.








The embedded numeric keypad functions like a desktop numeric keypad. It is indicated by small characters located on the upper right corner of the keycaps. To simplify the keyboard legend, cursor-control key symbols are not printed on the keys.





Desired access	Num Lock on	Num Lock off
Number keys on embedded keypad	Type numbers in a normal manner.	
Cursor-control keys on embedded keypad	Hold <Shift> while using cursor-control keys.	Hold <Fn> while using cursor-control keys.
Main keyboard keys	Hold <Fn> while typing letters on embedded keypad.	Type the letters in a normal manner.

Hotkeys

The computer employs hotkeys or key combinations to access most of the computer's controls like screen brightness and volume output.

To activate hotkeys, press and hold the <Fn> key before pressing the other key in the hotkey combination.

Hotkey	Icon	Function	Description
<Fn> + <F3>		Airplane mode	Turns on / off the computer's network devices.
<Fn> + <F4>		Sleep	Puts the computer in Sleep mode.
<Fn> + <F5>		Display toggle	Switches display output between the display screen, external monitor (if connected) and both.
<Fn> + <F6>		Display off	Turns the display screen backlight off to save power. Press any key to return.
<Fn> + <F7>		Touchpad toggle	Turns the built-in touchpad on and off.
<Fn> + <F8>		Speaker toggle	Turns the speakers on and off.
<Fn> + <F9>		Keyboard backlight	Turns the keyboard backlight on and off. <i>Selected models only.</i>

Hotkey	Icon	Function	Description
<Fn> + <F11>	NumLk	Number Lock	Turns the embedded numeric keypad on or off.
<Fn> + <F12>	Scr Lk	Scroll Lock	Turns Scroll Lock on or off.
<Fn> + <▷>		Brightness up	Increases the screen brightness.
<Fn> + <◁>		Brightness down	Decreases the screen brightness.
<Fn> + <△>		Volume up	Increases the sound volume.
<Fn> + <▽>		Volume down	Decreases the sound volume.
