
Installation

Installing the faucet assembly




CAUTION: Always turn off the water supply before removing an existing faucet or replacing any part of a faucet. Open the faucet handle to relieve water pressure and ensure that the water is completely shut off.

- Shut off the water supply. Remove the old faucet.
- Clean the mounting surface.
- Remove the lock nut (N), U-shaped washer(M), mounting brace (L), washer (K) from the faucet.
- WITHOUT DECK PLATE: Insert the inlet hoses
 (H) through the mounting hole in the sink until faucet body (A) sets on top of the sink.



WITH DECK PLATE: Align the hole in the gasket (E) and deck plate (D) with the mounting hole in the sink. Insert the inlet hoses (H) through the deck plate (D) and mounting hole in the sink until faucet (A) sets on top of deck plate(D).






NOTE: If the sink is uneven, use silicone under the gasket (E).


? Securing the faucet

 From underneath the sink, secure the faucet body (A) to the sink by threading the washer (K), mounting brace(L), and U-shaped washer (M) onto the threaded tube (O). Tighten the lock nut (N) securely.



3 Connecting the pull-out hose


 Attach the pull-down hose (F) to the outlet tube (0) and screw on the adapter(G), and tighten firmly in place.



Installation (continued)


4 Connecting the weight

- Tighten the two halves of the weight (J) to the pull-down hose (F) approximately 30 cm (1 ft.) below the connection of the water outlet tube.
- Check the function of the weight and hose by pulling the pull-down hose (F) and checking that its movement path underneath the sink is free from obstruction.



5 Connecting the inlet hoses

- Connect the water inlet hoses of the faucet (A) to the sink water supply lines.
- Ensure that the faucet inlet hose with the red marking is attached to the hot water supply line and the blue faucet inlet hose is attached to the cold water supply line.




Operation

Flushing and checking for leaks



IMPORTANT: After installation is completed, remove the spray head to flush the water lines. Do not lose the gasket in the spray head.

- Ensuring the handle is in the off position, turn on the water supply and check for leaks.
- If you discover any leaks, check the connections to ensure they are installed properly.
- Remove the spray head (C) from the faucet body (A), Be sure to hold the end of the hose down into the sink and turn the faucet on. Run the water for approximately 1 minute to flush the lines.
- Re-attach the spray head (C).




Operation (continued)

2 Controlling water flow and temperature


 Pull the faucet handle away from the faucet body (A) to turn the water on. Push the faucet handle back towards the faucet body (A) to turn the water off.

 For cold water, pull the faucet handle towards you. For hot water push the faucet handle away from you.



3 Using the spray function

The spray head (C) works in two modes: aerator and spray.
 To switch between these modes, press the top and bottom points on the spray head button(1).



Care and Cleaning

- □ To clean, wipe down with a damp cloth and towel dry.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals when cleaning this faucet, or the warranty will be voided.


Troubleshooting



NOTE: Refer to the service parts section in this manual for a detailed drawing showing the location of the parts listed below

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
There are leaks underneath the handle.	The bonnet nut has come loose and the O-ring on the cartridge is dirty or damaged.	☐ Tighten the bonnet nut. Clean or replace the O-ring.
The aerator leaks or has an inconsistent water flow pattern.	The aerator is dirty or misfitted. The cartridge may be clogged.	□ Remove the aerator and check for debris in the aerator screens. □ Remove the cartridge and check for debris. □ En sure the aerator is properly installed.
There are leaks from the hose underneath the deck.	The hose and discharge tube connection may be loose.	☐ Tighten the connection between the discharge tube and hose.
The hose does not retract.	The weight is not installed in the appropriate position	□ Reinstall or readjust the weight.
The water pressure is low.	The connector underneath the deck is clogged with debris. The aerator is clogged.	□ Turn off the water supply and disconnect the connector/aerator. □ Unscrew the connector/aerator and clean under running water. □ Screw the connector/aerator back. □ Test water flow. If water pressure is still low then replace the connector/aerator.
There is no hot or cold water.	The water inlet hose was acc- cidentally kinked during installation and is limiting the water flow through.	□ Reinstall the water inlet hose.
