

Extension Cords

Only round jacketed extension cords should be used, and we recommend that they be listed by Underwriters Laboratories (U.L.). An extension cord must have adequate wire size (AWG or American Wire Gauge) for safety, and to prevent loss of power and overheating. The smaller the gauge number of the wire, the greater the capacity of the cable, that is 16 gauge has more capacity than 18 gauge. When using more than one extension cord to make up the total length, be sure each individual extension contains at least the minimum wire size.

To determine the minimum wire size required, refer to the chart below:

Before using an extension cord, inspect it for loose or exposed wires, damaged insulation, and defective fittings. Make any needed repairs or replace the cord if necessary. Black & Decker has extension cords available that are U.L. listed.

This warranty does not apply to accessories. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may have other rights which vary from state to state. 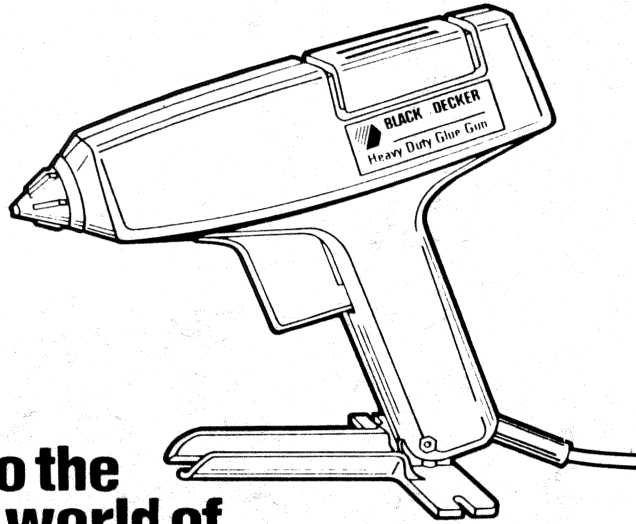

To install a new nozzle, plug the gun in, allow it to reach operating temperature and aim the gun straight up to prevent glue leakage. Unscrew the nozzle (use care when handling hot parts) and screw the new nozzle in.

WOOD/REPAIR GLUE: (Wood Tone in color)

For general repairs. Set time long enough to permit final positioning. Provides strong bonding of wood, plastics and metal.

CAULK/SEALER: (White in color)

For use as a repair sealant. Provides fast bonding and is electrically insulative and waterproof
