


Insert the D-Link CD-ROM Into Your Computer


Turn on the computer and Insert the D-link Personal *Air* DBT-120 Driver CD in the CD-ROM drive.












Installing The DBT-120 Wireless USB Bluetooth Adapter Into Your Computer

(You may also use the USB extension cable for easy access.)




Completing The Driver Installation
