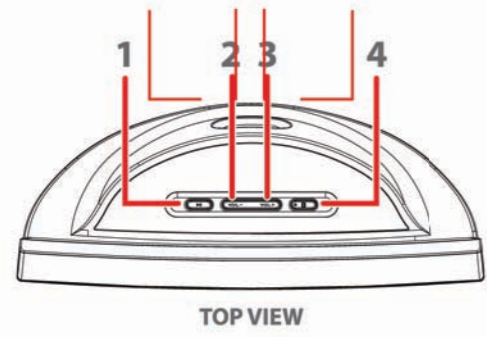

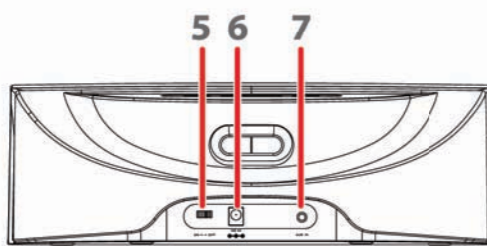

BACK VIEW

- [▶||] button
Quickpress = Pause
Quickpress again = Play
- [VOL-] button
Quickpress = previous song
Press & Hold = volume down
- [VOL+] button
Quickpress = next song
Press & Hold = volume up
- [BLUETOOTH CONNECT] button / LED indicator light.
Answer/end a call
- [POWER ON/OFF] switch
- DC IN jack
- 3.5 mm Auxiliary Cord jack

Powering ON / OFF

To turn ON:

- Connect the pin of the included AC adaptor to the **DC IN** jack on the back of the **Bluetooth Speaker**.
- Plug the AC adaptor into a wall outlet.
- Move the **[POWER ON/OFF]** switch to the ON position, the blue LED indicator light will remain lit indicating the speaker is turned on.

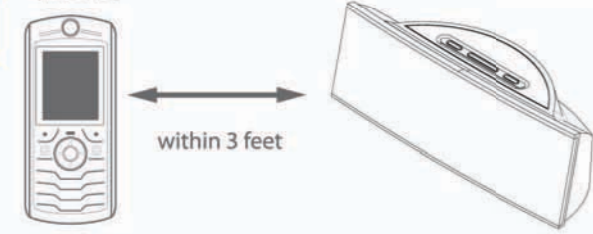
To turn OFF:

- Move the **[POWER ON/OFF]** switch to the OFF position, the blue LED indicator light will turn off indicating the speaker is turned off.

NOTE: When not using the speaker for extended periods of time it is recommended to unplug the AC adaptor from the wall outlet.

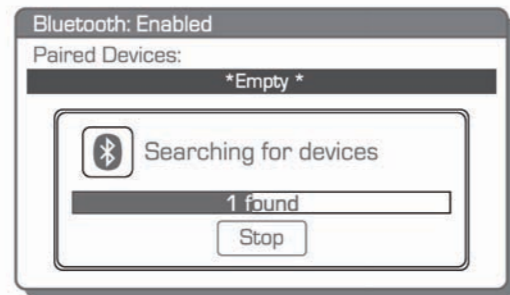
Pairing the speaker with a bluetooth enabled device

- Make sure the **Bluetooth Speaker** is plugged in and turned ON.
- Keep your **Bluetooth Speaker** and bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.

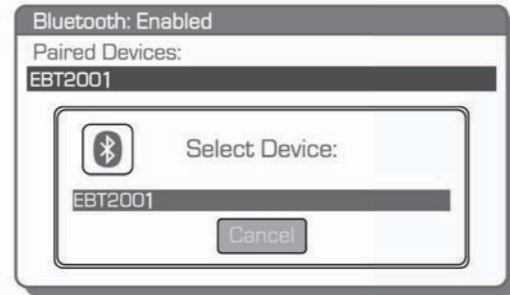


3. Press and HOLD the **[BLUETOOTH CONNECT]** button until you hear a beep and the blue LED indicator light starts flashing quickly. The **Bluetooth Speaker** is now in pairing mode.

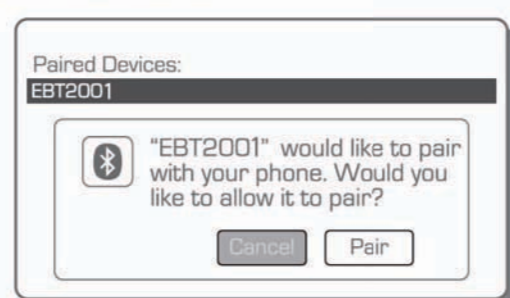
4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.



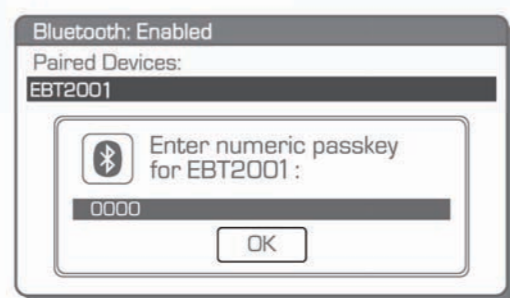
5. When the device finds the **Bluetooth Speaker**, confirm by selecting EBT2001 from the list.



6. Select "Pair" to connect the **Bluetooth Speaker** to your bluetooth enabled device.

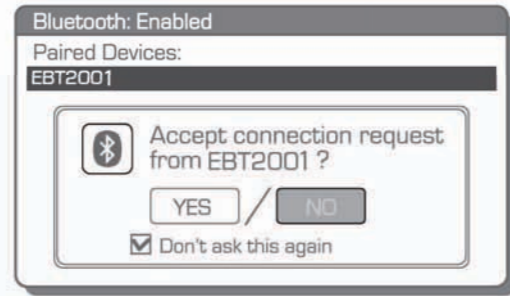


NOTE: Depending on which model device you are trying to connect the speaker to, it may not be necessary to enter a passcode and the following message (or similar) may appear on your device's display.

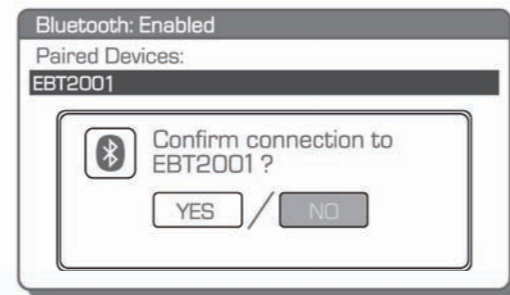


Enter passcode "0000" if prompted by the device.

7. Your Bluetooth enabled device will confirm that the pairing was completed, and prompt you to accept the connection. Please respond **YES** to connect the **Bluetooth Speaker** to your Bluetooth enabled device. If the pairing was successful, the **Bluetooth Speaker's** indicator light will begin flashing blue every two seconds.



9. When attempting to reconnect the **Bluetooth Speaker** to your Bluetooth enabled device, you may see the message below, and your phone will prompt you to accept the connection request to the EBT2001 speaker, and an option not to ask this again. Please accept the connection, and if you select "Don't ask this again", your phone will automatically accept future connection requests from your **Bluetooth Speaker**.



NOTE: The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled device in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's interface and interaction with the **Bluetooth Speaker** may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

Pairing with multiple devices

The **Bluetooth Speaker** can be paired with up to 8 devices. Once the number of paired devices exceeds 8, the first one will be replaced.

NOTE: It is only possible to use one paired device at a time.

Stereo Bluetooth

This **Bluetooth Speaker** allows you to listen (in full stereo) and control* the music on your Bluetooth enabled mobile phone, computer or mp3 player and supports the following Bluetooth profiles:

- **A2DP - Advanced Audio Distribution Profile**
- **AVRCP - Audio/Video Remote Control Profile**

To use the **Bluetooth Speaker** to listen to and/or control music, your Bluetooth enabled device must support the A2DP and AVRCP profiles. Please refer to the user guide of your Bluetooth enabled device for more information.

***The Emerson Bluetooth Speaker is compatible with any brand of Bluetooth-enabled phone or music device that supports Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) and Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP).**

In order for Bluetooth devices to communicate with one another properly, they must utilize the same Bluetooth profile. To determine the profiles supported by your device (mobile phone, gaming console, computer or mp3 player), please refer to the device's user guide.

Certain Bluetooth features including those listed may not be supported by all compatible Bluetooth-enabled devices, and/or the functionality of such features may be limited in certain devices.

Playing music

To enjoy wireless music on your **Bluetooth Speaker**, press the **[PLAY]** button of your Bluetooth enabled device to begin music playback. Once playback has begun, you can control the music from the control buttons of the Bluetooth Speaker (Not all Bluetooth enabled devices support the control of music using Bluetooth).

NOTE: Some phones, Bluetooth enabled media players, and/or applications require that your first press the **[PLAY/PAUSE]** button on your device before you can control the music with the **Bluetooth Speaker**.

Play/Pause*

Press the **[▶||]** button to pause the music. To resume music playback, press the **[▶||]** button again.

Adjusting the volume

Press and HOLD the **[VOL+]** or **[VOL-]** button to adjust the volume to the desired level.

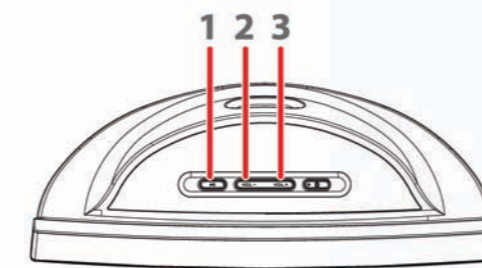
NOTE: You may also adjust the volume from your Bluetooth enabled device's volume control.

Skipping or searching songs* (Dependent on your phone supporting this feature)

Quickpress the **[VOL-]** button to go to the previous song.

Quickpress the **[VOL+]** button to go to the next song.

Music Controls

Troubleshooting tips

I Can pair the Bluetooth Speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music?

- Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.

I cannot get the Bluetooth Speaker into Pairing Mode.

- Make sure the **Bluetooth Speaker** is plugged in and turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
- Press and hold the **[BLUETOOTH CONNECT]** button until the **BLUE** indicator light flashes quickly, this will signal that the speaker is in **Pairing Mode**, and ready to connect to your Bluetooth enabled device.

My mobile phone is not able to pair with the Bluetooth Speaker.

- Make sure that the speaker is plugged in and turned on before pairing.
- Keep your **Bluetooth Speaker** and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Check that your device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
- Try repeating the pairing process, see "Pairing the Speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device."

After successfully pairing my Bluetooth enabled device and Bluetooth Speaker, when I shut my device off and turn it on again, the speaker did not automatically connect.

- Try turning the speaker **OFF**, and then turning it **ON** again.
- Many Bluetooth enable devices have an auto reconnect option when first attempting to reconnect to a newly paired Bluetooth device. Make sure you accept this option, so that your **Bluetooth Speaker** automatically reconnects to your Bluetooth enabled device; check the user guide of your Bluetooth enabled for more information regarding this option.
- Try unpairing the speaker from your Bluetooth enabled device, and repeat the pairing procedure.

The sound is very low.

- Try adjusting the volume by using the **[VOL]** buttons on your speaker; make sure the volume on your Bluetooth enabled device is turned up as well.

Using as a wired speaker

The EBT2001 can be used as a wired speaker by using the included 3.5mm Auxiliary Cord.

- Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is plugged in and turned on.
- Plug one end of the Auxiliary Cord into the **DC IN** jack located on the back of the Speaker.
- Plug the other end of the Auxiliary Cord into the headphone jack of any media device which has a 3.5mm headphone jack (this is a standard headphone-out jack).
- Use your media device's music controls to control the music and volume (the controls on the speaker will not function when using it as wired speaker).

Safety Information
