





Powering ON/OFF

To turn ON:

1. Connect the pin of the included AC adaptor to the DC IN jack on the back of the Bluetooth Speaker.

To turn OFF:


1. Move the [POWER ON/OFF] switch to the OFF position, the blue LED indicator light will turn off indicating the speaker

NOTE: When not using the speaker for extened periods of time it is recommened to unplug the AC adpator from the wall

Pairing the speaker with a bluetooth enabled device


1. Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is plugged in and turned ON.

2. Keep your **Bluetooth Speaker** and bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing



3. Press and HOLD the [BLUETOOTH CONNECT] button until you hear a beep and the blue LED indicator light starts flashing quickly. The Bluetooth Speaker is now in pairing mode.

4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device accept future connection requests from your Bluetooth to search for Bluetooth devices.




5. When the device finds the Bluetooth Speaker, confirm by selecting EBT2001 from the list.



6. Select "Pair" to connect the Bluetooth Speaker to your bluetooth enabled device.




NOTE: Depending on which model device you are trying to connect the speaker to, it may not be necessary to enter a passcode and the following message (or similar) may appear on your device's display.



Enter passcode "0000" if prompted by the device.

7. Your Bluetooth enabled device will confirm that the pairing was completed, and prompt you to accept the connection Please respond YES to connect the Bluetooth Speaker to your Bluetooth enabled device. If the pairing was successful, the Bluetooth Speaker's indicator light will begin flashing blue every two seconds.



9. When attempting to reconnect the **Bluetooth Speaker** to your Bluetooth enabled device, you may see the message below, and your phone will prompt you to accept the connection request to the EBT2001 speaker, and an option not to ask this again. Please accept the connection, and if you select "Don't ask this again", your phone will automatically

NOTE: The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled device in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's interface and interaction with the Bluetooth Speaker may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

Pairing with multiple devices

The Bluetooth Speaker can be paired with up to 8 devices. Once the number of paired devices exceeds 8, the first one will be replaced.

NOTE: It is only possible to use one paired device at a time.

Stereo Bluetooth

This **Bluetooth Speaker** allows you to listen (in full stereo) and control* the music on your Bluetooth enabled mobile phone, computer or mp3 player and supports the following Bluetooth

 A2DP - Advanced Audio Distribution Profile • AVRCP - Audio/Video Remote Control Profile

To use the **Bluetooth Speaker** to listen to and/or control music, your Bluetooth enabled device must support the A2DP and AVRCP profiles. Please refer to the user guide of your Bluetooth enabled device for more information.

*The Emerson Bluetooth Speaker is compatible with any brand of Bluetooth-enabled phone or music device that supports Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) and Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP).

In order for Bluetooth devices to communicate with one another properly, they must utilize the same Bluetooth profile. To determine the profiles supported by your device (mobile phone, gaming console, computer or mp3 player), please refer to the device's user guide.

Playing music

To enjoy wireless music on your Bluetooth Speaker, press the [PLAY] button of your Bluetooth enabled device to begin music playback. Once playback has begun, you can control the music from the control buttons of the Bluetooth Speaker (Not all Bluetooth enabled devices support the control of music using Bluetooth).




