



### Installing a wall-mount bracket


- 1 Carefully place your TV screen face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.

#### **Connecting power**

Plug the power cord into the **DC IN** jack on the back of your TV, then plug the other end of the cord into a power outlet.





#### Setting up and using your remote control

- 1 Press the release button on the back of the remote control to remove the battery compartment cover.
- 2 Insert two AAA batteries into the battery compartment. Make sure that the + and symbols on the batteries match the + and symbols in the battery compartment.
- **3** Replace the cover.




