INSTALLATION GUIDE for the

SB-D-CLBR/10W1v2 2007 - Up Dodge Caliber



Thank you for choosing a JL Audio Stealthbox® for your automotive sound system. With proper installation, your new vehicle-specific enclosed subwoofer system will deliver years of listening pleasure.

We strongly recommend that you have your new Stealthbox® installed by your authorized JL Audio dealer. The installation professionals employed by your dealer have the necessary tools and experience to disassemble and reassemble your vehicle properly. Also, keep in mind that your warranty coverage extends to 1 year if your system is installed or approved by your authorized JL Audio dealer. If you prefer to perform your own installation, please read this installation guide completely before beginning the process.



! IMPORTANT

If you choose to perform the installation yourself, it is absolutely vital that the Stealthbox* be properly mounted to the vehicle according to these instructions. Failure to mount the enclosure properly presents two problems:

- 1) The sub-bass performance will suffer due to the movement of the enclosure caused by the force exerted by the woofer(s).
- 2) A loose enclosure presents a serious safety hazard in the event of a collision or sudden deceleration.





ESTIMATED TIME: 1 HOUR



STEP 1Remove all contents from the cargo area.




STEP 2Remove the right side rear hold down cleat.



STEP 3Pull the plastic flooring and rear sill plate out.



STEP 4Remove the right side rear cargo panel out of the car.



STEP 5Place the supplied wax square into position, as in the picture.



S T E P 6Fully thread the supplied hex bolt into the bottom of the Stealthbox®.



STEP 7Position the Stealthbox® into place.

This mounting area is a tight fit. The Stealthbox® needs to angle into the mounting area. Start by sliding the rear of the Stealthbox® into the mounting area. Then turn the Stealthbox® clockwise.



STEP 8
Press down on to the Stealthbox® firmly.


Remove the Stealthbox® carefully, leaving the wax square in place. The hex bolt will leave an impression onto the wax.



STEP 9

Note: Before drilling, make sure that you are not going to be drilling into any gas lines, brake lines, transmission lines, electrical wiring, transfer case (4x4 vehicles) or anything else that might cause a reduction in your weekly pay. Always wear eye protection when drilling!

With a drill and a 1/2-inch drill bit, drill through the impression made in the wax square. Remove the wax square.




STEP 10

Run speaker wire from the amplifier location to the Stealthbox® location and check for proper operation of the woofer.

Back out the hex bolt that was installed in **Step 6**.

Place the Stealthbox® back into the mounting area.



STEP 11

Place the supplied lock washer, flat washers and then fender washer onto the hex bolt.

From under the car place the hex bolt assembly up through the floor and into the threaded insert on the bottom of the Stealthbox*.

Secure the bolt assembly.


Note: For added protection, it is recommended that you apply a bead of silicone between the vehicle and the fender washer. After the bolt assembly is tightly secured, it is also recommended that vehicle undercoating material is applied to the exposed assembly.



STEP 12

Remove the door that is located on the front of the side cargo panel.

Grind off the plastic weld tabs that secure the pocket to the back of the side cargo panel.



STEP 13

Place a supplied washer onto each supplied screw.

Place the supplied grille into the location of the door that was removed in **STEP 12**.

From the back side cargo panel, pass each screw assembly through a factory hole. As seen in the picture.

Secure the grille to the side cargo panel.

Place the side cargo panel back into the car, from **STEP 4**.



STEP 14

Place the plastic flooring and rear sill plate back into place, from $\mbox{\bf STEP 3}.$

Mount the right side rear hold down cleat back into place, from **STEP 2**.


