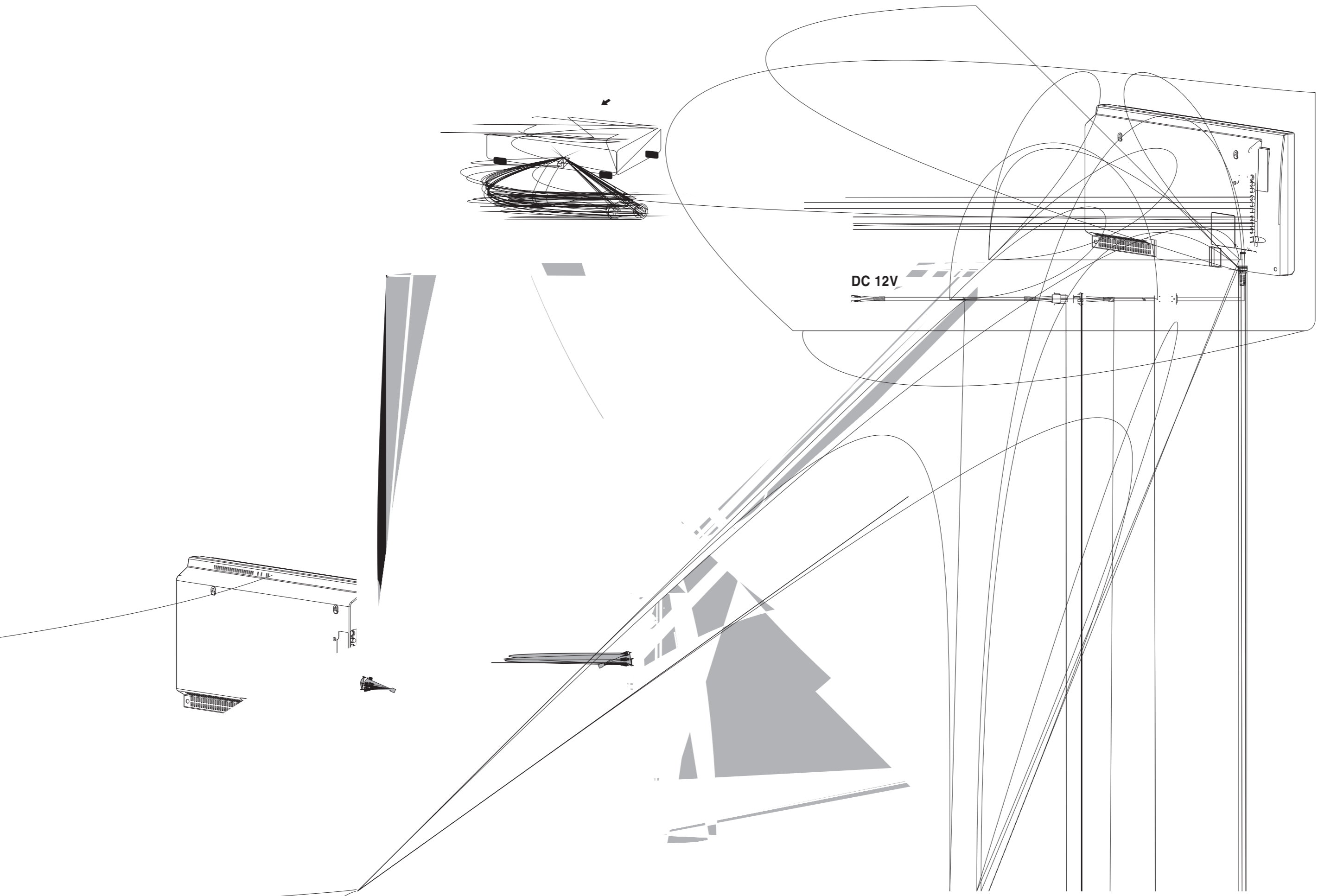
1. Install all batteries correctly, and as marked on the remote control.

VOLUME SETTING:

MODE (SOURCE):

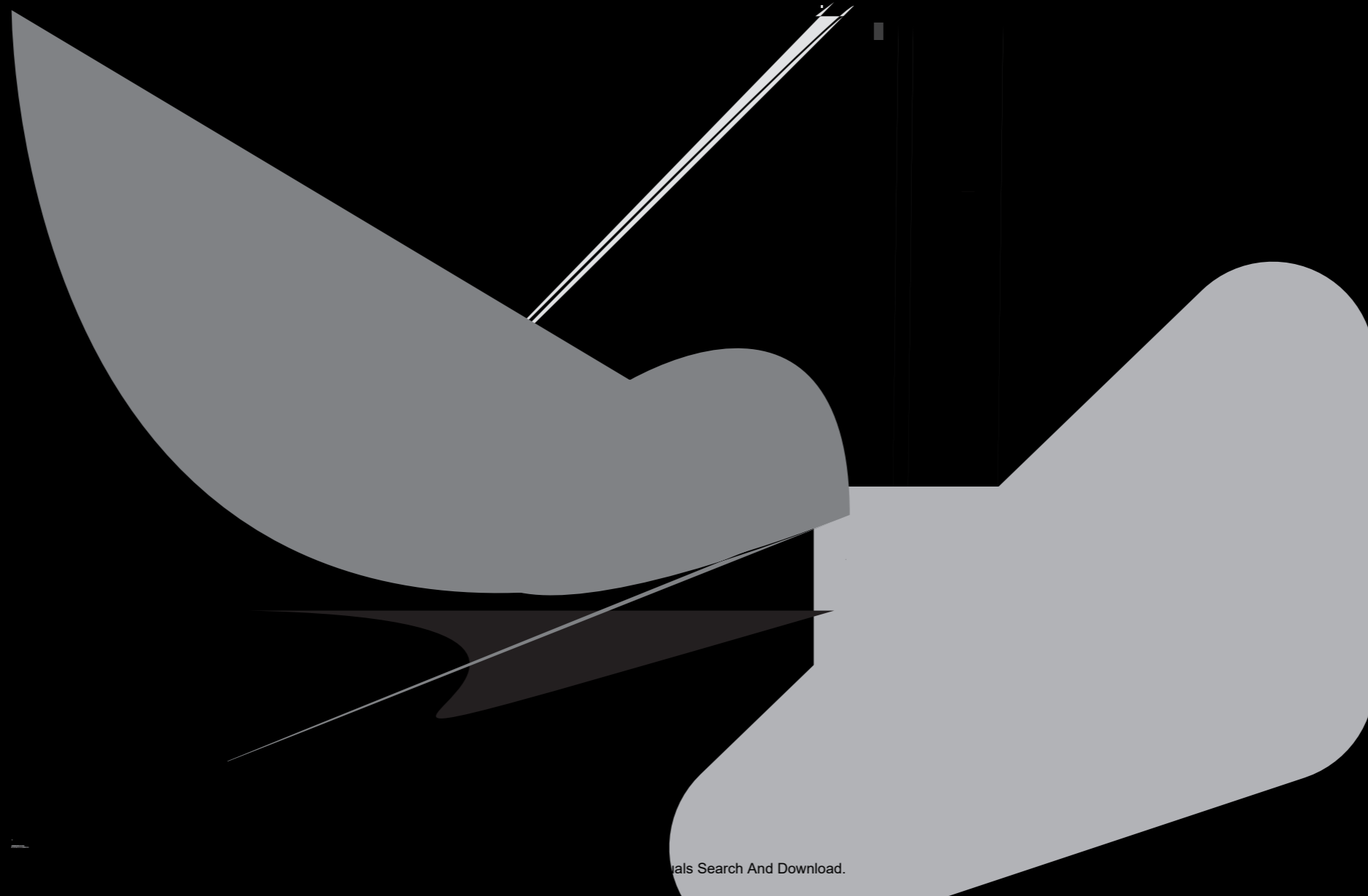
1. Press the "Mode" button on the TV front panel or remote control "SOURCE BUTTON" to select from the various video source.
2. The mode setting status will change each time the "Mode" (SOURCE) button is pressed – "S-VIDEO/CVBS/CHANNEL"

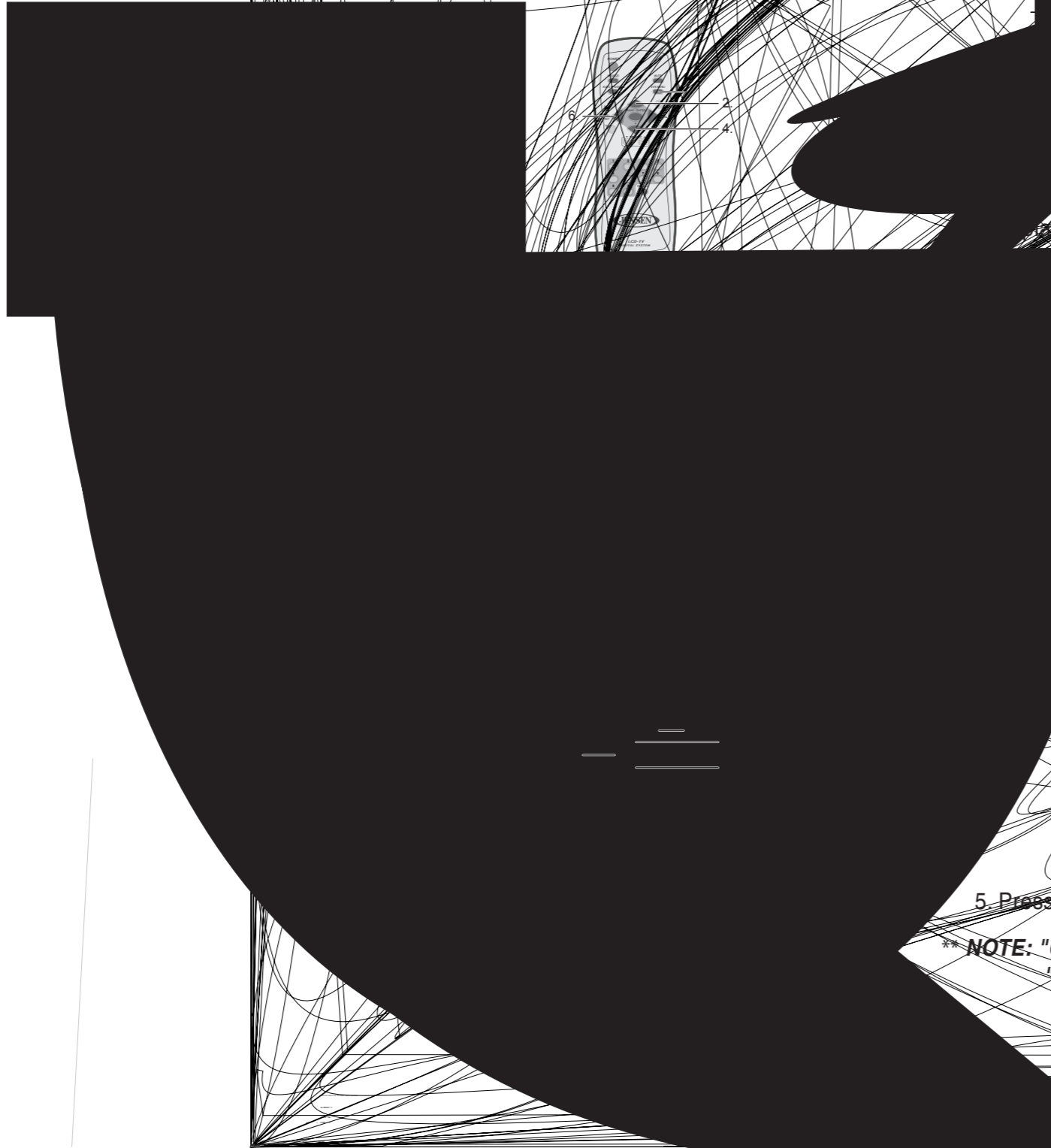


CHANNEL SEARCH:

LCD Monitor Care & Cleaning Tips:

8. ANNEX B

Troubleshooting:

If the unit fails to operate normally, try solving the problems using the guide below. If the problem persists, switch off the unit and ask the dealer or customer services officer for assistance. Do not attempt to repair the defective unit yourself. Do not endanger yourself as high voltage is involved.

1. No Picture

- Check that the power cord is plugged into the main socket and the power supply is turned on.
- Check the contrast and brightness setting.
- Check the Antenna connection to see if it is properly connected to the LCD TV Input Terminal.
- Be sure you have selected the correct source mode.

2. Snowish Picture

- Check to see if the Antenna is correctly connected.
- Check to see if the picture setting is correctly set.

3. Flickers Picture

- Check that the power coming from the main socket is sufficient.
- Check that unit is not placed too near speakers or magnetic objects.
- Check to see that the unit setting is correctly set.

4. No Sound

- Check that mute function is off.
- Increase the volume.

5. Remote Control not Working.

- Check batteries are installed correctly, replaced if necessary.
- Aim the remote controller towards the unit remote sensor.
