Safety Precautions

To make sure you understand how to use your new TV, please read this manual thoroughly before you begin.

- Follow this manual regarding setup!
- Connect only to a 110-240 V, 50/60Hz AC outlet.
Make enough room for inserting and removing the power plug!
Place the TV as close to the outlet as possible!

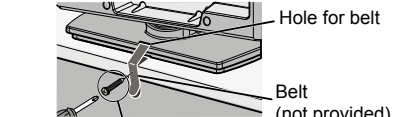
- Never insert the power cord by wet hand!

Care when setting

- Power requirements
- Connect the power cord only to a 110-240V, 50/60Hz AC outlet.
Installation requirements
- To avoid overheating, ensure the unit has ample room.

- If the microphone is installed, should be lock it's cable follow picture.
To prevent the TV from falling thread the belt through the hole on the back of the stand and secure it to the TV rack.

Viewing Teletext: You can watch the Teletext broadcast channel with Text Functions. Includes List Mode and Sub-page options.

Watching Video or DVDs: 1. Select the input source, 2. Select "Set Up" Menu. Includes HDMI setting and PC Setting options.

Connect a "DVI" device to "HDMI" using "DVI-HDMI" conversion cable. Connect analogue sound output of the DVI device to L and R terminals in INPUT VIDEO-2.
