
EMBROIDERY SEWING MACHINE MODEL 19005

CONVENTIONAL SEWING MODE

Suggested machine settings such as pressure dial number ①, thread tension number ②, and presser foot ③ appear on the touchscreen for easy reference while sewing.



In the Conventional sewing mode, there are four categories of sewing:

Utility stitches

Select from 11 different utility stitches.

Buttonholes

Select from five buttonhole variations, plus an eyelet.

Satin stitches

Select from satin stitches, elongation patterns and program-assorted stitch combinations.

Decorative stitches

Select from decorative stitches and programassorted stitch combinations.

(4) Twin Needle key


Automatically limits stitch width to a range acceptable for twin needle sewing.

5 Needle Up/Down key

Push to select Needle Up or Down position at the end of a stitch.

(6) Adjust key

Change stitch length and width by pressing the or + - key.





EMBROIDERY MODE

Edit

Press desired embroidery design to open the design in the Ready to Sew screen. Press the Edit Key on the Ready to Sew window to open the design on the Edit screen for adjustments.

1) Built-in designs

Press to access 30 embroidery designs, plus Clothsetter crosshairs and outlines.

② Monogramming key

Press to choose from two fonts and two-or three-letter monogramming.

(3) ATA PC Card key

Press to open a Saved File.

4 Card Reader key

Press to read 19000-series memory cards.


*To use memory cards, Reader 19000 and Y-style RS-232 cable are required. These items are sold separately from 19005.


(5) Edit key

Press to open the Edit Screen

Embroidery Screen

When you select an embroidery design, the visual touchscreen will show the design's parts and their sequence numbers, the thread color code, the presser foot to use, embroidery time, number of colors needed and the design's actual measurements.





1 Jog keys

Adjust the hoop position with the jog keys for precise

2 Trace key


Check the size of the embroidery area by pressing the trace key. The carriage traces the outline of the selected embroidery pattern before embroidering.


3 Color/Part keys


The thread color and embroidery order of each embroidery part are indicated on these keys.


Edit Screen

In the edit mode, you can edit and combine designs to create original embroidery. You can open the built-in designs and monograms, or designs from the ATA PC

Common Set

1) Screen contrast

Adjust the visual screen contrast.

2 Sound control

Adjust the buzzer volume.

③ EcoMode

If the machine is on but has not been used for a set period of time, the machine will enter EcoMode to conserve energy.

4 Inch/millimeter

You can set your machine's unit of measurement to either "inch" or "millimeter."




5 Key position adjustment

Adjust alignment of selection keys on the touchscreen.

6 Language selection

Choose the onscreen language by pressing the desired language key.



7 Embroidery speed

Choose from embroidery speeds of 400, 500 or 650 stitches per minute, depending upon the design.

Formatting Memory

8 Built-in memory

To format the internal memory, press the key next to built-in memory

9 ATA PC card

To format the ATA PC card or Compact Flash, press the key next to ATA PC card.


10 Reset all to default

Pressing the key will return all settings except for language to defaults (the same settings as when you purchased the machine).







Customizer programs EasyImport and EasyEdit allow the user to create or modify embroidery designs. Embroidery data should require the CompactFlash™ be saved in [.JEF] file format before transferring to SanDisk® CompactFlash™ card.

TWO

To save embroidery designs to the SanDisk® CompactFlash™, computers without PC card slots Reader / Writer. Most laptop computers do not require an additional reader device.

THREE

Customizer includes both a SanDisk® CompactFlash™ and SanDisk® CompactFlash™ PC Card Adapter. After embroidery data is saved, the card is attached to the SanDisk® CompactFlash™ PC Card Adapter.





Reader 19000 [RSOS 93301]

Attaches to model 19005 with a Y-style RS-232C cable (Sold separately). It reads Memory cards K-101 and above.

Y-style RS 232C cable [RSOS 93302]

For existing R/W 19000 owners, the Y-style RS-232C cable connects R/W 19000 directly to model 19005 without an AC adapter.


