









• Finally, tighten all bolts at the end of the assembly firmly. Do not use electric screwdrivers!

Please absolutely pay attention to the following safety information and if necessary, pass these instructions for use to further users of the high chair.

IMPORTANT SAFETY REFERENCES

- The High chair must only be used for its intended purpose, i.e. as a seat for one (1) child.
- KETTLER® high chairs are produced as per EN 1178 and only suited for children that can already sit upright alone.
- Never leave your child unattended in the High chair.
- · Always position the high chair on a safe ground and never near sources of danger (e.g. open fire, heat sources, stairs, etc.) or at high positions (e.g. table). Danger of serious injuries! Only transport the chair without a child inside.
- · Keep your child away from the chair during assembly and disassembly. Only place your child into a properly assembly high chair. Only adjust the operating elements without your child being in the chair.
- · First bolt all the parts together loosely, then check that they have been assembled correctly. Firmly tighten them at the end of the assembly. Do not use electric screwdrivers!
- The High chair is only intended for a stationary use and must not be used in vehicles.
- Do not hang/place any objects on/at the high chair that might impair its stability.
- Only use the High chair after all component parts have been mounted and adjusted by an adult.
- Regularly check the High chair for unintentionally loosened connections and possible defects/ missing parts. In this case, the chair must not be used any longer until a proper repair has been made. Only use spare parts supplied by the manufacturer. In such a case, please contact **KETTLER** parts & service
- · For the safety of your child, KETTLER® products are produced with utmost care and are continuously checked by our quality control. Please, read these instructions for use carefully before the chair's first use.

- It is possible for the Cotton bumper pad colors to fade after several washings.
