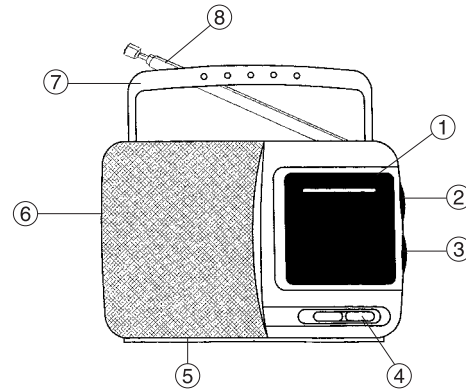

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Open the battery door at the rear of the cabinet.
2. Insert 3 "C" batteries (not included) into the battery case. Be sure the battery position is correct by referring to the marking on the battery case.
3. Close the battery door.

NOTE: WEAK OR DEAD BATTERIES MAY LEAK AND CORRODE THE SET. ALWAYS REMOVE BATTERIES WHEN THE SET WILL NOT BE USED FOR A LONG PERIOD OF TIME.

TO USE WITH AC

Plug in AC cord set into radio's AC socket. Connect AC plug it to a conveniently located AC outlet having 120V and 60Hz only.

HOW TO OPERATE RADIO

1. Turn Volume to ON position.
2. Set the Band Selector to either AM, TV1, FM, TV2 or WB Position.
 - (a) Tuning AM
To select the desired station, slide the Tuning Control. All AM radios have "DIRECTIONAL" characteristics. It may be desirable to turn the radio until the best reception is obtained. This is particularly noticeable on weak or distant stations.
 - (b) Tuning FM
Extend the telescopic antenna to its full length. To select the desired station, slide the tuning control per the above instruction.
 - (c) Tuning TV1, TV2 or WEATHER
Use same procedure as in tuning FM.
3. Adjust the volume control to the desired sound quality listening level.

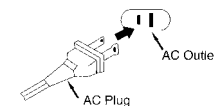

INSTALLATION

Unravel the AC cord and connect it to a conveniently located AC outlet having 120V and 60Hz only.



CAUTION: To prevent electric shock, match wide blade of plug to wide slot, fully insert.

WEATHER BROADCASTS

A very important service available on the weather band is the broadcast of local weather conditions and forecasts. This service is a new service provided 24 hours per day under U.S. Government supervision by the United States Department of Commerce, Environmental Services. The new service is available simply by tuning the dial pointer to (162.55 MHz) on the weather band dial scale.
