#### Please read these safety precautions carefully before using the product.



Warning

Failure to follow those warnings may result in death, serious injury or damage to the product or other property.



#### **Electrical Power Related Precautions**



#### Warning

- Use only the power cord supplied with the unit or another manufacturer authorized cord.
  - Failure to do so may result in fire or electrical shock or damage to the product.
- Use only a properly grounded plug and receptacle.
  - If you do not you may be electrocuted or injured. Or the product might be damaged.
- Do not use a damaged or loose plug.
  - This may cause electrical shock or fire.
- Operate the display only from a power source(i.e. voltage) indicated in the product specification.
  - Otherwise the product can be damaged, fire can occur or you may be electrocuted. If you are not sure what type of power supply you have, consult a certified electrician.
- In the presence of thunder and lightning, never touch the power cord and signal cable because it can be very dangerous.
  - It can cause electric shock.
- Do not connect several extension cords, electrical appliances or electrical heaters to a single outlet. Use a power bar with a grounding terminal designed for exclusive use with the computer.
  - A fire can break out due to overheating.
- Do not touch the power plug with wet hands. Additionally, if the cord pin is wet or covered with dust, dry the power plug completely or wipe dust off before plugging in the cord.
  - You may be electrocuted due to excess moisture.
- If you don't intend to use the product for a long time, unplug the power cable from the product.
  - Covering dust can cause a fire, or insulation deterioration can cause electric leakage, electric shock or fire.
- Insert the power plug firm so it cannot come loose.
  - A loose connect can cause fire.
- Hold the plug when pulling out the power cable. Do not pull the plug out by the wire. Do not bend the power cord with excessive force or put heavy objects on the power cord.
  - The power line can be damaged, which may cause electric shock or fire.
- Do not insert conductive material (ea. metal chopstick) into the product opening into one end of the power cable while the other end is plugged in. Additionally, do not touch the power cable right after plugging into the wall input terminal.
  - You may be electrocuted.
- The power supply cord is used as the main disconnection device. Ensure that the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.
- Do not unplug the power cord while the product is in use.
  - Electrical shock can damage the product.
- As long as this unit is connected to the AC wall outlet, it is not disconnected from the AC power source even if the unit is turned off.

## **Precautions in installing the Product**



#### Warning

- Keep away from heat sources like electrical heaters, curdles or other open flames.
  - Electrical shock, fire, malfunction or deformation may occur.
- Keep the packing anti-moisture material or vinyl packing out of the reach of children.
  - Anti-moisture material is harmful if swallowed. If swallowed by mistake, force the patient to vomit and visit the nearest hospital. Additionally, vinyl packing can cause suffocation. Keep it out of the reach of children.
- Do not put heavy objects on the product on sit upon it.
  - If the product collapses or is dropped, you may be injured. Children must pay particular attention.
- Do not leave the power or signal cable when someone can trip over it.
  - The passerby can falter, which can cause electrical shock, fire, product breakdown or injury.
- Install the product in a neat and dry place. Do not use near water.
  - Dust or moisture can cause electrical shock, fire or product damage.
- Do not add accessory that have not been designed for this display.
- If you smell smoke or other odors or hear a strange sound from the product unplug the power cord and contact the service center.
  - If you continue to use without taking proper measures, electrical shock or fire can occur.
- If you dropped the product or the case is broken, turn off the product and unplug the power cord.
  - If you continue to use without taking proper measures, electrical shock or fire can occur. Contact the service center.
- Do not drop an object on or apply impact to the product. Do not throw any toys or objects at the product.

   It can cause injury to humans, problems to the product and damage the display.
- Keep out of reach of children and do not place toys near the product.
- Make sure the product ventilation hole is not blocked. Install the product more than 10cm from the wall.
  - If you install the product too close to the wall, it may be deformed or fire can break out due to internal heat build-up.
- Do not cover the product with cloth or other material (eg. plastic) while plugged in.
  - The product can be deformed or fire can break out due to internal overheating inside the product.
- Place the product on a flat and stable surface that is large enough to support the product.
  - If the product is dropped, you may be injured or the product may be broken.
- Install the product where no Electromagnetic Interference occurs.
- Keep the product away from direct sunlight.
  - The product can be damaged.
- Do not place the product on the floor.
  - Small Children and others may trip over it.



### **Precautions in Moving the Product**



#### Warning

- Make sure to turn off the product.
  - You may be electrocuted or the product can be damaged.
- Make sure to remove all cables before moving the product.
  - You may be electrocuted or the product can be damaged.
- When lifting or moving the product, do not hold it upside down while holding only the stand.
  - This may cause the product to fall resulting in damage or injury.
- Do not shock the product when moving it.
  - You may be electrocuted or the product can be damaged.



# Safety Precautions

- Make sure the panel faces forward and hold it with both hands to move.
  - If you drop the product, the damaged product can cause electric shock or fire. Contact an authorized the service center for repair.
- Do not place the product face down.
  - This may damage the TFT-LCD screen.



#### **Precautions in Using/Cleaning the Product**



### **Warning**

- Do not attempt to disassemble, repair or modify the product yourself.
  - Fire or electric shock can occur.
  - Contact the service center for repair.
- When cleaning the product, unplug the power cord and scrub gently with a soft cloth to prevent scratching. Do not clean with a wet cloth. Or spray water or other liquids directly onto the product. An electric shock may occur. (Do not use chemicals such as benzene, paint thinners or alcohol)
- Keep the product away from water.
  - Fire or electric shock accident can occur.
- Avoid high temperatures and humidity.
- Do not put or store flammable substances near the product.
  - There is a danger of explosion or fire.
- Keep the product clean at all times.
- Take a comfortable and natural position when working with a product to relax the muscles.
- Take a regular break when working with a product for a long time.
- Do not press on the panel with a hand or sharp object such as nail, pencil or pen, or make a scratch on it.
- Keep proper distance from the product and rest from time-to-time.
  - Your vision may be impaired if you look at the product too closely or fpr too long.
- Set the appropriate resolution by referring to the User's Guide.
  - Your vision can be impaired.
- Keep small accessories out of the reach of children.
- Leaving a fixed image on the screen for a long time may cause damage to the screen and cause image burn-in. Make sure to use a screen saver on the product. Burn-in and related problems are not covered by the warranty on this product.
- Spray water onto a soft cloth 2 to 4 times, and use it to clean the front frame; wipe in one direction only. Too much moisture may cause staining.



# Connecting the stand base or Removing the stand base

1. Place the monitor with its front facing downward on a cushion or soft cloth.



Assemble the Stand Base into the Stand Body.Be sure don't pull out the Stop Pin and make the Stand Base direction as shown.

#### WARNING

- The tape and locking pin may only be removed from those monitors equipped with a standing base when the base is pulled up. Otherwise, you may be injured by the protruding sections of the stand.
- Product Handling with Care: When you lift up or move the product, Do Not hold or touch the front part of LCD panel. It will damage the panel. (Please hold the Stand Body or plastic cover of the product.)

3. Use a coin on the back of the stand base and turn the screw clockwise to tighten.



- **4.** Lift and turn the monitor to face towards the front after the connection is made to the female part of the cable you're attaching.
- **5.** When you desire to disintegrate the monitor from the stand base, use a coin to turn the screw counterclockwise.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- This illustration depicts the general model of connection. Your monitor may differ from the items shown in the picture.
- Do not carry the product upside down holding only the stand base. The product may fall and get damaged or injure your foot.



 When adjusting the angle of the screen, do not put your finger(s) in between the head of the monitor and the stand body. You can hurt your finger(s).



 When adjusting the height of the screen, do not put your finger(s) in between the head of the monitor and the stand base. You can hurt your finger(s).

#### WARNING

■ You do not need to replace the Locking pin after it is removed, to adjust its height.


#### **ERGONOMIC**

It is recommended that in order to maintain an ergonomic and comfortable viewing position, the forward tilt angle of the monitor should not exceed 5 degrees.

# **Using the Pivot function**

- -The pivot function allows you to rotate the screen 90 degrees clockwise.
- **1.** Lift the monitor to its highest height to utilize the Pivot function.
- 2. Landscape & Portrait: You can rotate the panel 90° clockwise.

  Please be cautious and avoid contact between the monitor head and the Stand Base when rotating the screen to access the Pivot function. If the monitor head touches the Stand Base, then the Stand Base could crack.



**3.** Be careful with the cables when rotating the screen.




# **Connecting with the PC**

- Before setting up the monitor, ensure that the power to the monitor, the computer system, and other attached devices is turned off.
- Connect signal input cable 1 and power cord 2 in order, then tighten the screw of the signal cable.
  - A Connect DVI-D(Digital signal) Cable
- Connect Audio Cable
- B Connect D-sub(Analog signal) Cable

#### NOTE

- This is a simplified representation of the rear view.
- This rear view represents a general model; your display may differ from the view as shown.



**3.** Press the power button on the front panel to turn the power on. When monitor power is turned on, the 'Self Image Setting Function' is executed automatically. (Only Analog Mode)




#### NOTE

Self Image Setting Function? This function provides the user with optimal display settings. When the user connects the monitor for the first time, this function automatically adjusts the display to optimal settings for individual input signals.

**'AUTO' Function?** When you encounter problems such as blurry screen, blurred letters, screen flicker or tilted screen while using the device or after changing screen resolution, press the AUTO function button to improve resolution.

### **MENU Button**

#### OSD LOCKED/UNLOCKED



This function allows you to lock the current control settings, so that they cannot be inadvertently changed. Press and hold the **MENU button** for several seconds. The message **"OSD LOCKED"** should appear.

You can unlock the OSD controls at any time by pushing the **MENU button** for several seconds. The message **"OSD UNLOCKED"** should appear.

#### **AUTO IMAGE ADJUSTMENT**

When adjusting your display settings, always press the **AUTO** button before entering the On Screen Display(OSD). (Only Analog Mode)

PROCESSING AUTO

This will automatically adjust your display image to the ideal settings for the current screen resolution size (display mode).

The best display mode is

When two input signals are connected, you can select the input signal (D-SUB/DVI) you want. When only one signal is connected, it is automatically detected. The default setting is D-Sub.


The power indicator stays blue if the display is running properly (On Mode). If the display is in Sleep Mode (Power Saving), the power indicator is blinking blue.

## **Screen Adjustment**

Making adjustments to the image size, position and operating parameters of the display is quick and easy with the On Screen Display Control system.

A short example is given below to familiarize you with the use of the controls. The following section is an outline of the available adjustments and selections you can make using the OSD.

To make adjustments in the On Screen Display, follow these steps:



- 1 Press the discretionary **Button**, then the main menu of the OSD appears.
- To access a control, use the corresponding **Buttons**.
- Use the ◀/▶ Buttons to adjust the image to the desired level.
  Use the ♣ Button to select other sub-menu items.
- 4 Press the **EXIT Button** to exit from the OSD.

Check the following before calling for service.

### No image appears

- Is the power cord of the display connected?
- Check and see if the power cord is connected properly to the power outlet.
- Is the power indicator light on?
- Press the Power button.
- Is the power indicator flickering?
- If the display is in power saving mode, try moving the mouse or pressing any key on the keyboard to bring up the screen.
- Try to turn on the PC.
- Do you see an "OUT OF RANGE" message on the screen?
- This message appears when the signal from the PC (video card) is out of horizontal or vertical frequency range of the display. See the 'Specifications' section of this manual and configure your display again.
- Do you see a "CHECK SIGNAL CABLE" message on the screen?
- This message appears when the signal cable between your PC and your display is not connected. Check the signal cable and try again.

# Do you see a "OSD LOCKED" message on the screen?

- Do you see "OSD LOCKED" when you push MENU button?
- You can secure the current control settings, so that they cannot be inadvertently changed.
   You can unlock the OSD controls at any time by pushing the **MENU** button for several seconds: the message

"OSD UNLOCKED" will appear.

# Display image is incorrect

- Display Position is incorrect.
- Press the AUTO button to automatically adjust your display image to the ideal setting.
   If the results are unsatisfactory, adjust the image position using the H position and V position icon in the on screen display.
- On the screen background, vertical bars or stripes are visible.
- Press the AUTO button to automatically adjust your display image to the ideal setting.
   If the results are unsatisfactory, decrease the vertical bars or stripes using the CLOCK icon in the on screen display.
- Any horizontal noise appearing in any image or characters are not clearly portrayed.
- Press the AUTO button to automatically adjust your display image to the ideal setting.
   If the results are unsatisfactory, decrease the horizontal bars using the PHASE icon in the on screen display.
- Check Control Panel --> Display --> Settings and adjust the display to the recommended resolution or adjust the display image to the ideal setting. Set the color setting higher than 24 bits (true color).

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Check Control Panel --> Display --> Settings and see if the frequency or the resolution were changed. If yes, readjust the video card to the recommend resolution.
- If the recommended resolution (optimal resolution) is not selected, letters may be blurred and the screen may be dimmed, truncated or biased. Make sure to select the recommend resolution.
- The setting method can differ by computer and O/S (Operation System), and resolution mentioned above may not be supported by the video card performance. In this case, please ask to the computer or the video card manufacturer.

# Display image is incorrect

- The screen color is mono or abnormal.
- Check if the signal cable is properly connected and use a screwdriver to fasten if necessary.
- Make sure the video card is properly inserted in the slot.
- Set the color setting higher than 24 bits (true color) at **Control Panel Settings**.
- The screen blinks.
- Check if the screen is set to interlace mode and if yes, change it to the recommend resolution.

# Do you see an "Unrecognized monitor, Plug&Play (VESA DDC) monitor found" message?

- Have you installed the display driver?
- Be sure to install the display driver from the display driver CD (or diskette) that comes with your display. Or, you can also download the driver from our web site: http://www.lg.com.
- Make sure to check if the video card supports Plug&Play function.


