The memory feature enables the vehicle to "remember" the position of your driver seat and exterior mirrors (not equipped with power adjustable pedals). ## Autolock/Auto Unlock

Autolock automatically locks all vehicle doors when all the doors are closed, the ignition is in the RUN position, you shift into any gear that puts the vehicle into motion, and the vehicle is moving above 12 mph (20 km/h). 
