The Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter is a unique device that allows older analog devices to be integrated seamlessly into the modern home theater. This adapter connects component video home theater devices to HDMI compliant digital monitors. This adapter also takes analog L+R audio and encodes it onto the HDMI signal for the full HDMI video and audio effect. With the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter, legacy home theater devices and computer systems can be easily connected to any HDMI display for the full digital video and audio experience.

How It Works

Simply connect the supplied Component cable to the input side of the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter. Connect the RCA audio cables to the audio inputs of the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter, then connect the HDMI display or projector to the HDMI output of the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter. The adapter generates the compatible analog to digital conversion signals for video and audio as well as encoding the audio onto the HDMI to make the connection between the analog inputs and the digital output work.






CONNECTING AND OPERATING THE COMPONENT WITH AUDIO TO HDMI ADAPTER

How to Connect the Component With Audio To HDMI Adapter

- 1 Connect your HDMI compliant device to the HDMI female connector at the output side of the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter.
- 2 Connect the supplied Component cable between Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter input and the Component output of your source device.
- 3 Connect the supplied RCA L+R audio cable between the audio input on the Component with Audio to HDMI Adapter and the audio output on your source device.
- 5 Connect the supplied 5V DC power supply to the power input on the Component with Audio to HDMI.
- 6 Plug the supplied 5V DC power plug into the wall outlet.
