

### **Installation of Batteries**

### Installation of batteries:

Open the battery cover on the back of the Remote Controller and put two new AAA // # batteries into the battery slot according to the signs. After this, please close the battery cover.

### Notice on battery use:

This product is low power-consumed; two new batteries can last for approximately 12 months. Improper use may reduce batteries' life. Please do not use a new and an old battery together. If batteries leak, please replace them with new ones immediately. If the remote controller will not be used for a long time, please pick the batteries out and keep them apart from the remote controller.

## **Setting of Learning Keys**

There are seven learning keys on this remote controller for TV set, VOL+/VOL-, CH+/CH-, POWER and two custom design keys, C1/C2. All the other keys are for Set Top Box. Make sure that the TV set's remote controller is working properly, and then set the learning keys as following steps:

- 1.Hold the "STUDY" key down for 3 seconds. After the signal LED shines, leave it up and go to step 2;
- 2 Point the signal sender of TV remote controller to the one of this remote controller directly, and keep the two in 1 to 3 centimeters approximately. Press the key on the TV remote controller you want to learn(the POWER key, for example), the signal LED on this remote controller will flash for a while and then keep on shining after receiving this signal, and then press the key on this remote controller you want to record this signal. After the red LED flash thrice and keep on shining, this signal is recorded. Please go on to learn another key.
- 3.Set all the seven learning keys under instruction 2), and then press the "STUDY" key to finish setting.
  - 1. After setting the learning keys, please check whether this remote controller is able to control the TV set. If not, please adjust it and set again;
  - Make sure that the window of signal sender of TV remote controller points to the window of signal receiver of remote controller directly; and place the two remote controller as near as possible;



- 3. Don't move any of the two remote controllers during setting, you'd better place them on desk thus to keep them stable:
- 4. If the "STUDY" key is pressed, the process of setting will be terminated;
- 5. If there is no operation is 30 seconds, the process of setting will be terminated Automatically.

### **Solution of Problems**

If you have any problem in setting or using this remote controller, please try the following approaches:

- 1. Check whether the TV set's remote controller is working properly;
- Make sure that the window of signal sender of TV remote controller points to the window of signal receiver of remote controller directly;
- 3. Check whether the batteries are installed correctly and have enough power;
- Check whether there is no obstacle between the remote controller and Set Top Box or the TV Set.



# **Remote Controller Codes**



### How do I turn the set-top box on and off?

When you have connected your set-top box to the TV, you are ready to use it.

- 1 . Switch on the TV.
- Set the source to the input channel you have connected the set-top box (AV1, for example).
- 3. Switch on the set-top box.
- 4. The front panel window will flash green.
- 5 . Usually the first channel in the channel list will be displayed. However, if this is the first time you have connected the set-top box, your TV will display the 'No terrestrial channels found' and 'Enter menu to add channels' screen. See the topic 'How do I tune-in TV Stations' for details of how to install the set-top box at this stage.

### How do I tune-in TV stations?

In the following description 'remote controller' and 'main unit', may replace 'set-top box'.

All keys we refer to are on the remote controller.

- 1. Connect the set-top box to the TV and turn the set-top box on as we have explained on the topic 'How do I turn the set-top box on and off'.
- 2. Switch it on at the mains socket.
- 3. The front panel will flash green.
- 4. Turn on the TV.
- 5. Switch the TV to the input that the set-top box is connected to (such as AV1 or Av2).
- 6. If it is the first time you have switched the set-top box on, after a short delay your TV will show the 'No Off-Air Channels' screen, followed by 'No terrestrial channels found' and 'Enter menu to add channels' screen a few seconds later.



### How do I tune-in TV stations?


- 7. Press the Menu key.
- Your TV will display the main menu as shown below.



 Press the **DOWN** key and press **OK** key to select the channel scan function.



10 . Press the **OK** key to select the Terrestrial function and then press the **OK** key again to start scan all channels.



11 . You TV will display the Channel Scan page, and a progress bar will be displayed at the screen. The set-top box will search through channels 2 to 69 and the TV stations it finds will be listed on the page as it finds them. So the total number of TV stations it finds will be displayed on the page. The set-top box will store these stations in its memory in the order of the channel numbers. When the set-top box has finished scanning, the scan page will close and the set-top box will tune the TV to the first station in the list and display it. In case that want to stop the scanning, an **OK** key pressing just needed.



- 12 . If the set-top box couldn't find any channels, your TV screen will display the 'No terrestrial channels found' and 'Enter menu to add channels' screen.
- 13 . If this is not the first time you have switched the set-top box on, it will turn on and tune into the last channel being watched when it was last used.

### **Basic Operations**

Once channel search is completed, you can start to watch digital terrestrial TV channels and radio broadcasts. Some typical operations are given in this chapter.

#### Switch On and Off

Whenever you are not using the receiver, press the **STAND BY** key on the remote controller to put it into standby mote. And you can press the **STAND BY** key on the remote controller again to switch on.

#### **Changing Channels**

To switch between different channels, you can:

Press the CH▲/CH▼ keys to go to the previous/next channel.

Use the **NUMERIC** keys to select a channel number.



Whenever you change a channel, a banner appears at the top of the screen displaying the basic information on the current channel.

#### Adjusting the Volume

Press the VOLUME+ /VOLUME- keys to adjust the volume.



### Displaying information

To display the detailed information of the current channel while playing, press the INFO key.



### **Basic Operations**

#### View All/Favorite Channel list

You can press the **FAV** key on the remote controller to view All/Favorite Channel list, and then you switch between the Favorite Channel list and All Channel list with the **LEFT/RIGHT** keys.





### **Choosing Subtitle**

You can press the **SUBTITLE** key to select or close subtitles on the screen. The available subtitles depend on the broadcaster.



#### **Displaying EPG**

The EPG contains one-day program information of the program in the channel list.

To view the EPG provided by the content provider:

- 1. Press the **GUIDE** key and then a EPG picture of one days' program will be shown as following:
- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT keys to navigate the lists, The highlighted EPG details will be shown on the right detailed EPG screen as below:
- Press the EXIT or GUIDE key to exit the EPG, otherwise, the EPG page will timeout several seconds later.



### **Basic Operations**

#### Mute

Press the **MUTE** key to enable or disable the audio output.



#### Wide

Press the **WIDE** key to switch the Picture Shape, **FULL**, **ZOOM1**, **ZOOM2**, **or LETTER BOX**.



#### Stereo Effect:

Press the RED key to switch the Stereo Effect among SRS TruSurround, SRS TruSurround XT, SRS TruBass, SRS Focus and None.



### Switch between TV and Radio

You can press the **TV/RADIO** keys to switch between TV and Radio program. (Not avai lable )



### Audio

Press the **AUDIO** key to select the audio language.





EPG is broadcast by individual channels and is subject to the discretion of the broadcaster.

### Main Menu

The receiver features an on-screen menu providing access to a variety of setup and management controls. Use the remote controller to navigate through the menu and activate required settings.

When you are in the set-up mode of the main menu, press the **MENU** key if you want to go back a stage at any time. If you keep pressing **MENU** key you will eventually close the main menu. Press the **EXIT** key if you want to close the main menu straight away.

How to display the Main Menu:

- 1. Press the MENU key.
- 2. Your TV will display the main menu.



If you have not pressed another key for 30 seconds after pressing the **MENU** key,it will automatically close.

- lock channels


How to select the functions listed above in the edit channels function page:

Enter this function you can edit favorite channel List.


- Press the **DOWN** key until 'Favorite' is highlighted.




### **Channel Edit**





Enter to setup clock. You can change the Date & Time and Time zone.

- 1. Press the **DOWN** key until 'Clock is highlighted.

- You can press the LEFT/RIGHT keys to select an item and press the UP/DOWN keys to change the option of each item.




#### Language

- 2. Preferences


How to select the functions listed above in the **Closed Captions** function page:

- 1. Select 'Closed Captions' in the 'Main Menu'.

Enter to select closed caption service.

- 1. Press the **DOWN** key until Service item is highlighted.
- 2. Press the OK key.
- 3. You can press the **UP/DOWN** key to select an item. The services you can select are listed following: **Off, Digital-1, Digital-2, Digital-3, Digital-4, Digital-5, Digital-6, Cc1**.




### **Closed Captions**

#### **Preferences**

Enter to select closed caption preferences.

- 1. Press the **DOWN** key until Preferences item is highlighted.
- 2. Press the OK key.
- You can press the UP/DOWN key to select an item and press the LEFT/RIGHT keys to change the function option of each item. When you select the 'Set all to defaults' item all function items listed following will be set to defaults. The function items are: Size, Style, FQ Color, BQ Color, FQ Opacity, BQ Opacity and Edge.
- The closed caption preferences will be shown on the bottom of the sub-menu page after the function options are selected.



# Parental Control (V-chip)

Enter the **Parental Control page** via **Main Menu.** The **Parental Control** function lets you choose to:

How to select the functions listed above in the **Parental Control** function page:

- 1. Select 'Parental Control' in the 'Main Menu'.
- Press OK key to select the 'Password' item to input the 4-digit parental controlpassword. If the password you have entered isn't correct or you haven't entered the password, the other function items couldn't be highlighted.
- 3. Press the **DOWN** or **UP** key until the item you want is highlighted.
- Press the **OK** key.

Now, following are some introduction for each function item of Parental Control.

### **Parental Control**

#### **Password**

In this section you can **Enter Password** to set rating limits, **Change Password** and **Reset Password**.




#### **Movie Rating**

Enter to set movie rating. In this section you can allow or block different grade movies, the grades you can choose are **G**, **PG**, **PG13**, **R**, **NC-17** and **X**.



#### TV Rating

Enter to set TV rating. In this section you can allow or block different grade movies, the grades you can choose are TV Y, TV Y7, TV G, TV PG, TV 14 and TV MA.



### **Additional Rating**

Enter to set additional rating.

#### Lock

Enter to set channel as locked.
