

Caution

In order to avoid the player from any damage, please abide by following precautions:

- Make sure the grounding wire of the Player is the negative pole of its DC 12 V power supply.
- Never open the top or bottom of the Player without permission.
- Never install this Player under places under direct sunshine, too hot or too humid. Try to avoid installation at places with too much dust or exposure to water drops.
- Any change of fuse is only limited to those at power rating.
- Application of error fuse may cause function failure to the Player.
- When change the fuse, please power off the Player at first.
- In order to avoid any damage to the player, please never place 3 inch disc.

Precautions

Condensation caused by moisture may happen to the lens inside the product, it will affect the play effect in such case. Please turn off the power (unload the disc) to operate it 1-2 hours, Vaporize the condensation with the home-grown heat.


- Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.
- Do not use disc with labels or stickers attached.






- Clean the discs with dry Cleaning cloth.
 Wipe each disc from the center out.






Front Panel Buttons & Function

Loading batteries for IR remote control

Slide open battery door. Insert two "AAA" size batteries according to polarity marks "+ and "-" shown in the battery compartment. (Please point the remote control IR towards the front panel of the player to get the best response).

System Setup

Press [SETUP] button, the SETUP menu is displayed, select the preferred item by using the [◀] [▶] buttons. Press [ENTER] button. In the submenu, using the [▲] [▼] button to select. When some item be selected, press [ENTER] to enter this submenu, press [▲] [▼] to select, press [ENTER] button to confirm what you need item, at the same time the item will be highlighted.

Press [◀] to exit submenu and can executing other item. Press [SETUP] can exit system setup menu.

1. General Setup Page

- (1) Setup TV Display Mode
- A. Select Normal / PS, Screen will display full picture, but it will loose some picture in the all sides.
- B. Select Normal / LB, Screen will display full picture, no any parts of it will be lost.
- C. Select Wide, Screen will display full picture, but it will loose some picture in the life and right sides.
- (2) Setup Angel Mark

DVD Disc can record several screens which is recorded by different camera from different angel, user can prefer one of it to play.

On: Angel Mark on

Off: Angel Mark off

Note: Setup angel mark will available when disc with multi-angel mark.

(3) Set OSD language

User can select setup menu and display language on the screen.

English: All operations display English
Spanish: All Operations display Spanish







(4) Set Captions

On: Captions On Off: Captions Off

Notes: It will available when the Disc with this function.

(5) Set Screen Saver

After stop play for period of time or no any disc in the machine, the Screen Saver will start. When Screen Saver function, the screen will display black back ground and with a DVD Mark moving on the screen. This function can save the screen lift-time.

On: Screen Saver On Off: Screen Saver Off

(6) Set Last Memory

This function is to remember the position at last Play. It needs 3 seconds to function after power off.

On: Last Memory On Off: Last memory Off

2. Audio Setup Page

According to the operation of DVD System Setup Page, select what you prefer.

3. Video Quality Setup Page

The customer can carry on correspond according to the actual display quality the operation of the bright, contrast, Gamma, and is as follows: To choose among them a certain (such as the contrast degree), press to confirm the key in to regulate the menu. Pass left, right to choose among them a certain (such as the contrast), press Enter key to regulate the menu. Pass left, the right can carry on gradually decrease toward key or in creased function, press Enter key to then return the upper level menu again.

4. Set Preference Page

Note: At is in the stop stage or machine inside have no disc, press setup key to enter to preference page, is shown as diagram above.

(1) Set TV Standard

If the TV type is for PAL. Please choose the PAL. If the TV type is for AUTO, please choose the Multi. If the TV type is for NTSC, please choose the NTSC.

(2) Set PBC state

On: Open the manifestation of the disc song menu (Only the ability selects songs in the song menu appearance). While winning an election to choose to open(the song menu), pass [TITLE] the key can return the song menu.

Off: Close the manifestation of the disc catalogue menu(can press numerical key to carry on the selected songs directly).

(3) Parental

Target the function, can pass" the age control" to play to match the disc of the age grade, and match with the control with password.

This secret code is: 123456

(4) Default

If you do not want to reserve the oneself's parameter for various enactment of the function, choose reset to default. DVD machine will instauration a factory original.











5. Password Setup Page





Password Mode: To select password Mode
Password: To change password

While winning an election to settle the password options, press rightwards the direction key, at the cursor is order bright, press "Enter" key in to reorganize the password menu, input the old password 123456, choose the cursor to move to the new password, after inputting the password and confirming the password at this time, press to "Play" or "Enter" key.

Note: This secret code is 123456, if you forget the password, this password is always valid. About Program

Pressing contents in the disc the sequence that you need carries on weaving the distance, the machine play the sequence that you arrange in order automatically.

Note: The MP3 disc can't carry on weaving the distance to play. (When play MP3 disc, press the program key is to use to choose "catalogue play" or "file list play", which is two kinds of play mode.)

Basic Operation For Playing DVD

We will introduce some regular operations of different types of function, the user can perform one or more operations as you like.

Select part to be played with menu

If DVD disc to be played has menu, when PBC state is on, you can display the menu by pushing [MENU] or [TITLE], when you select a popular part to play, you can operate following procedures.

- 1. Push [Menu] the screen display menu picture, the content to be selected varies with different disc.
- 2.Push [▲][▼][◄][►] move the lighting band to the desired item or made by pushing these buttons.
- 3. Push [Enter] to confirm selecting the item. This moment the screen may display a submenu, you can also push [▲][▼][◄][►] to select, push [Enter] to confirm the selection.

Play fast forward

While playing you can push [FF] button to play fast forward. Four speeds (2X,4X, 8X, 16X, 32X) are available to play forward, press it once the speed grows by one shift, when the speed reaches maximum speed, press [FF] again to return to normal state.

Play fast backward

While playing you can push [FB] button to play fast backward. Four speed are available to play forward, press it once the speed grows by one shift, when the speed reaches maximum speed, press [FB] again to return to normal state.

Slow play

While playing, push [SLOW] to play slowly for only DVD disc at different speed. You can play slow forward or backward, three shift speed are available for either of them. Push [SLOW] once, press it once the speed decreases by one shift, finally it returns to normal state.

- Skip to next chapter / track
 While playing push [►►] button.
- Skip to previous chapter / track
 While playing push [₩] button.

Select track

There are more than one operation procedure available.

- 1. Push $[\Join]$ or $[\Join]$ to skip to the next or the previous track and play.
- For those disc with track numbered directly push number buttons to enter the No. of desired track to play. If the moment the screen display, so there may be three possible reasons:
- A. The track in the disc is not numbered.
- B. The number entered beyond the scope.
- C. Select among the song track list (refer to the next chapter).

Display the track list

For DVD disc, when PBC is on, push [MENU] to display the track list, the moment firstly push [\sim]/[\sim] to select a track then push [Enter] to play. For non-DVD disc, when PBC is on, while playing push [RESUME] to display the track list, the moment you can directly enter number to select. You can push [PBC] to change PBC state.

Attention: whether the above procedures work will be subject to the type of disc.



Other Operation

- Mute
- 1. Push MUTE button on the front panel or the remoter control to shut off the sound output.
- 2. Push it again to resume to previous volume level. Turn the volume button also can cancel the mute function
- Audio control
- Push the [VOL+] button to increase sound level.
 Push the [VOL-] button to decrease sound level.
- Audio channel

Push the [AUDIO] button on the remoter control to change the audio channel in the DVD mode.






under SEAT (rear operate)




under SEAT (front operate)




inside CONSOLE


