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Turn On / Auto Power Off

To power on the player, you will press and hold the Power On/Off button until you see the screen displays with MEIZU. Click it again to start play. When there is no button operation for about 3 minutes while the player is stopped, it is automatically turned off. To power off the player, press and hold the Power On/Off button until it finishs with shutting down procedure.





Reset Mini Player

When it is deadcaused by improper operation, you have to resetyour mini player. Disconnectit to a USBcable or ACAdapter, pressand hold on the Enter keyfor over 10sec until the screen display goesoff. Then you can restart





Sliding Touch Operation Errors

When the player is started up, system will check power level of touch keypad first. Do notput your fingers ontouch keypad during the system checking, otherwise it will possibly cause checking errorand losing control. Please restart it for proper function.

After finish copying themusic, using Main Menu-Music-UpdateMusic Library on theplayer before your listening musicso that you canorganize and assort themby artist, album or genre. Otherwise, you canonly browse the newcopied songs fromAll Songs on theplayer.



There is second layer of film covering the protection film on the back of player. Please tear it outbefore use.





Touch Keypad

Touch keypadis an important part of the player, including sliding touch controland key operations, which used forcontrolling operations of allkinds of functions of the player. Sliding touch keypad:



Clicking Key:



- 1. While HOLD islocked, any operation will be invalid.
- 2. Toofast operation will be easy to cause error.
- 3. Slide your fingeron the touch keypadup and down to reach the desired operation.
- 4. Click Enter keyor the center keypadto enter the submenu interface or excutean operation.
- 5. Clicking Menu keyto go back to the previous menu interfaceor cancel an operation.

In the playback mode, the playback progress bar shows the elapsed and remaining time of current song. Slide your finger on touch keypad up and down to adjust the volume. Click Enterkey, the sliding bar will display a diamond object in the bar. It shows the current playback position. Slide your finger on touch keypad up and down to move playback position forward or backward. Click Enterkey again, it shows the song's detailed information. Click the keyonce again and return to normal playback mode.





Connecting Mini Player

Connecting to a Computer
Connect the small endto player, largeend to PC.



1. During Power Off

Connect it to the computer using the USB cable supplied in the package during the player powered off. It will be charged using the power supply from the PC.



Connecting to a computerduring it power off, it will charge its built-in battery and appears as the left figure.

2. During Power On

Connect it to the computer using the USB cable supplied in the package during the player powered on. It will charge its built-in battery and appears as the figure.




In the normal Windowsenvironment, as soon as the cable or simple USBjack is connected, themessage "Searching for new device" appears and USB driver is installed automatically. For Windows 98SE, put the included CD-ROM in your disk drive, then follow the instructions on your PC screen to install the USB drive.

Note: While connecting to PC, tracks and operations cannot be applied. Pullingout the PC connection cable from the player before your listening to music /viewing a picture and so on.

Charging the Battery

- * Charging the Batterybefore using your player.
- * While the player is connected to the computer via USB cable, it will charge its built-in battery. The battery is fully charged in about 3 hours.
- * Check if theplayer is connected to a high-power USB2.0 port. Some low-power USB ports available in keyboards and other USB hubsmay not provide enoughpower to charge or sync theplayer.
- * If the computeris in sleep mode, the player may notbe charged.

The Remaining Battery Chargeicon indicates the remaining time the battery canbe used. The more the battery is used, the fewer the number of segments in theicon.



■ ToCharge the Playerwith ACAdapter



1. Connect the AC adapter (not provided) and the player.

To charge the player with AC adapter, USB-DC adapter is required. Connect the USB end to the player and another end to the power supply jack. The AC adapter for the player uses input voltage of 100~240V and 50/60 Hz.

2. While connecting the player and power supply, it will power on automatically.

The battery is fully charged in about 3 hours.



■ Using for the First Time

Handling





If you grab the player as picture, it is easier to handle them.

The procedures of using for the first time

- 1. Insert the installation CD in your computer and install applicable softwares. (Detail see to 21 Install Software.)
- 2. Turn on your player.
- 3. Connect the player to the computer using the USB cable supplied.
- 4. Open up the [Removable Disk] (which represents the memory of this player) on My Computer.
- 5. Transfer the desired files from PC into your player under their specified directories. You can also create folder for your need, such as Ebook.
- 6. Safely disconnect the USB cable to the player.

(All keys of the player cannot be operated during connecting to PC.)

- 7. Plug the earphone to the player.
- 8. You can now use the player to play music, video, view your favorite photographs, listen to FM radio and a lot of other features. Download from Www.Somanuals.com. All Manuals Search And Download.



If you are using Win2000 or above, you will not need to install driver. The PC will automatically recognise the player when it is connected. The video convert tool installation is required for video conversion. When installation is automatically not started, execute the setup. exe in the installation CD, and then the Manager program is automatically setup.

Operation

Access from a CDor download music, videoor picture files frominternet and transfer to your PC hard disk, then transfer them toyour player's Removable Disk. Take example for copying songs as below.









When copy files, you should save the video and photo files to specified directories of the player, video files into Movie directory, photo files into Picture directory. Otherwise, they won't be identified by Mini Player.

Saving Files and Disconnecting to your PC Copy the Files in the Player into your PC

■ Converting Video Files

The player supports .aviformat.

However, as theresolution and code vary, some .avi willnot be properly displayed on the player. Therefore it is strongly recommened that user convert everyvideo files before saving to the player.

Install the converter toolenclosed in the CDdisk

Use the program to convert your .avi and other formats of videofiles.

After the conversion, you can save the file into the video diretory in your player disk.

1. Installing Video Converter

Insert the Installation CDin the CD-ROM driver. Click [Video Converter Software] to start the installation on the displayed window





It will take you some time to finish the installation. It may pop up the warning window of installing related plugin, it possibly indicates file is existing depending on the status of the Windows. Then select "Retry" or "Ignore" to continue installation.

2. Using Video Converter

When the installation finishes, Start -> Programs -> Video Converter -> Video Converter is registered.



When the program starts, click Input [Add] button and choosethe file to convert.



Select the converting videofile from the pop-up window, click [Open].



It appears the filename and informations on the FileList.

- 1. The converted size is 320*240, the converting time is depended on the size of the original file. The quality is related to your setting values.
- 2. The BitRate of Video is 200~500, Frame is 15~20.
- 3. The subtitlefile and video fileshould be saved under the same content.
- I.e. If a videofile named Video.avi, then the subtitle should be Video.srt.

The caption file is the format of .srtas suffix. You may ignore Step 6 to Step 9 during your converting files without caption.
