Windows XP Installation

1. First, install the WN511B software.

> Insert the NETGEAR CD. If the CD main page does not appear, double click Autorun.exe on the CD.

- a. Click **Install Software**. The Check for Updates window will open.
- b. If you are connected to the Internet, click Check for **Updates**. If not, you can choose to install from the CD.
- When the Installation Complete message appears, click Next. c.
- d. On the SmartWizard screen, click **Next** to proceed with the SmartWizard setup.

2. Now, insert the wireless adapter.

- When prompted, insert your wireless adapter. a.
- b. Click **Next** to proceed. Windows will discover the adapter and continue the software installation process.
