Take the rubber cover of DC Jack



Remove the upper hinge




Take the left key module

Take the right key module




Take the membrane tail by releasing connectors

Take the PCBA




Disassemble the middle hinge




Take the rubber feet and mylar




Key cap is disassembled (with link bar)



All key caps are removed




Remove the plunger by push it through the hole, shown as the arrow




All plungers are removed

Take the membrane


