


Please read before using this equipment

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PRECAUTIONS

LOCATION

For safe operation and satisfactory performance of your unit, keep the following in mind when selecting a place for its installation:

- Shield it from direct sunlight and keep it away from sources of intense heat.
- Avoid dusty or humid places.
- Avoid places with insufficient ventilation for proper heat dissipation. Do not block the ventilation holes at the top and bottom of the unit. Do not place the unit on a carpet because this will block the ventilation holes.
- Install unit in a horizontal position.
- Avoid locations subject to strong vibration.
- Do not place the unit near strong magnetic fields.
- Do not move the unit from a cold to a hot place or vice versa.

AVOID THE HAZARDS OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK AND FIRE

- Do not handle the power cord with wet hands.
- Do not pull on the power cord when disconnecting it from an AC wall outlet. Grasp it by the plug.
- If, by accident, water is spilled on your unit, unplug the power cord immediately and take the unit to an authorised service centre for servicing.
- Do not put your fingers or objects into the TV/VCR cassette holder.
- Do not place anything directly on top of the unit.

WARNING

Moisture condensation may occur inside the unit when it is moved from a cold place to a warm place, or after heating a cold room or under conditions of high humidity. If a tape is played in a TV/VCR which has moisture, it may damage the tape and TV/VCR. Therefore when the condensation occurs inside the unit turn the FUNCTION button on and allow at least 2 hours for the unit to dry out.



VIDEO CASSETTE

This TV/VCR will operate with any cassette that has the VHS mark. For best results, we recommend the use of high-quality tapes. *Do not use poor quality or damaged tapes*.

PRECAUTIONS

- Avoid moisture. Moisture condensation may occur
 on the tape if it is moved from a cold place to a warm
 place. Before using a tape with these conditions, to
 avoid a damage of the tape and your TV/VCR, wait
 until the tape has warmed to room temperature and
 the moisture has evaporated.
- Avoid extreme heat, high humidity and magnetic fields.
- Do not tamper with the cassette mechanism.
- Do not touch the tape with your fingers.

TWO DIFFERENT TAPE SPEEDS


Before recording, select the tape speed from : SP mode (Standard Play) or LP mode (Long Play).

The table below shows the maximum recording/playback time using E-60, E-120, E-180 or E-240 tapes in each mode.


INSERTING A CASSETTE

Insert the cassette in the direction as shown. Push in gently, but continuously, on the centre-back of the cassette until it is drawn into the TV/VCR. The TV/VCR will automatically turn on.




REMOVING A CASSETTE

- 1) In the Stop mode, press EJECT button on the remote control or press STOP/EJECT button on the TV/VCR. The cassette will eject.
- 2) Pull the cassette out of the cassette compartment.
- 3) Store the cassette in its case as shown.




ERASE PREVENTION

You can prevent accidental erasing of recording by breaking off the tab on the back edge of the cassette.




If you decide to record on the tape again, cover the hole with a plastic tape




OPERATING CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS

-FRONT VIEW-



- REMOTE CONTROL VIEW -




- **1 AUDIO input jack-** Connect to audio output jack of your audio equipment or another VCR.
- **2 VIDEO input jack-** Connect to video output jack of your video camera or another VCR.
- **3 FUNCTION indicator-** Lights up in the Standby mode.
- **4 REC indicator-** Flashes during recording. TIMER REC indicator- Lights up in the Stand-by mode for Timer Recording.
- **5 FUNCTION button-** Press to turn TV/VCR on and off. Press to activate the automatic timer recording.
- 6 STOP button- Press to stop the tape motion.EJECT button Press in the Stop mode to remove a tape from the TV/VCR.
- 7 REW button- Press to rewind the tape, or to view the picture rapidly in reverse during the Play mode. (Rewind Search)
- **8 PLAY button-** Press to begin playback of a tape.
- **9 F.FWD button-** Press to rapidly advance the tape, or to view the picture rapidly in forward during the Play mode. (Forward Search)
- 10 REC button- Press to begin manual recording. OTR button- Press to activate One Touch Recording. (used on the TV/VCR only)
- **11 VOLUME △/▼ buttons-** Press to adjust the volume level.
- **12** C(hannel) △/▼ buttons Press to select the channel for viewing or recording.

P(icture) ▲/▼ **buttons-** Press to adjust the picture control. (See page 13.) (used on the remote control only)

Tracking +/- **function**- Press to minimise video 'noise' (lines or dots on screen) during the Play mode. (See page 14).

-REAR VIEW-



- **13 EARPHONE jack-** Connect to earphone (not supplied) for personal listening. The size of jack is 1/8" monaural (3.5mm).
- 14 Cassette compartment
- 15 NUMBER buttons- Press to select desired channels. for viewing or recording. To select channels 1 to 9, first press the 0 button and then 1 to 9.
 - **0/AV button-** Press to select VCR mode. (For example, press "0" then "0" for VCR mode.) To release VCR mode, press two digits to directly access any channel you choose.
- **16 PAUSE/STILL button-** Press to temporarily stop the tape during the recording or to view a still picture during playback.
- **17 MENU button-** Press to display main menu on the TV screen.
- **18 SELECT button-** When setting program (for example: setting clock or timer program), press to determine your selection and proceed to a next step you want to input.
 - Display function- Press to display the counter or the current channel number and current time on the TV screen. (See page 12).
- 19 ADD/DELETE button- Press to delete or add channel numbers in the Channel Set Up mode (See page 9). Press to cancel a setting program (for example: setting clock or timer program) (See page 20). (These functions are operative only when the menu is shown on the TV screen.)
 - **COUNTER RESET button-** Press to reset counter to 0:00:00.


- **20 COUNTER MEMORY button-** Press to set counter memory on and off. (See page 16).
- **21 TIME SEARCH button-** Press to activate Time Search mode.
- **22 MUTE button-** Press to mute sound. Press it again to resume sound.
- **23 SLEEP button-** Press to set the Sleep Timer. (See page 21).
- **24 PREVIOUS button-** Press to go back to the previously viewed channel. For example, pressing this button once will change channel display from 3 (present channel) to 10 (previously viewed channel), and pressing it a second time will return from 10 to 3.
- **25 SPEED button-** Press to set desired recording speed. (SP/LP).
- **26 POWER switch-** Press to turn TV/VCR off and Stand-by. When you do not use for a long period, press to turn off or unplug the power cord.
- **27 ANT. terminal-** Connect to an antenna or Rod Antenna.
- **28 AUDIO/VIDEO socket-** Connect to audio/video socket of a video camera or VCR.

CABLE CONNECTIONS


VHF/UHF COMBINED ANTENNA

The VHF/UHF Rod Antenna (not supplied) is detachable. Push the stem of the antenna into the hole which is located on the upper back cabinet of the unit. Connect the VHF/UHF Rod Antenna or VHF/UHF Combination Antenna to the ANT. terminal of the TV/VCR as shown in the diagram below. For the best reception, extend the VHF/UHF Rod Antenna fully and adjust its position. (Avoid handling




VHF/UHF SEPARATE ANTENNAS

In some areas it will be necessary to use an outdoor antenna.



INSTALLING THE BATTERIES

- 1) Open the battery compartment cover by pressing the cover on the remote unit in the direction of the arrow.
- 2) Insert 2 "R6/AA/SUM-3" penlight batteries into the battery compartment in the direction indicated by the polarity (+/-) markings.
- 3) Replace the cover.



EXTERNAL INPUT MODE

When using an external input signal (another VCR or camcorder), connect the player's audio/video output

cables to the AUDIO/VIDEO socket of your TV/VCR.

Then press CHANNEL \blacktriangle or

▼ button or enter "00" with number button so that "AUX" appears on the screen.



PRESET FOR USE

You can program the tuner to scan only the channels you receive in your area. You must use the remote control for the following steps.

CHANNEL MEMORY PROGRAMMING - AUTO PRESET

1 Plug the TV/VCR power cord

Plug the TV/VCR power cord into a standard AC outlet.

Press POWER switch on the back of the TV/VCR to switch to "ON".



2 Turn on the TV/VCR

Press FUNCTION button to turn on the TV/VCR.

3 Select "CHANNEL SET UP"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "CHANNEL SET UP".

Then, press SEL. button.



4 Select "AUTO PRESET"

Press SEL. button.

The tuner scans and memories all the active channels in your area.



5 After scanning

The tuner stops on the lowest memorised channel.

If you want to recall the selected channels, you can select the desired channel directly with the

remote control number button or CP ▼ or ▲



TO RETURN TO TV MODE WHEN **SCANNING**

Press MENU button in scanning mode.

TO SKIP A PRESET CHANNEL

The channels you no longer receive or seldom watch can be deleted from the memory.

1 Select "CHANNEL SET UP"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "CHANNEL SET UP".

Then, press SEL. button.

-MENU-TIMER PROGRAMMING PICTURE CONTROL SETTING CLOCK CHANNEL SET UP USER SET UP

2 Select "MANUAL PRESET"

Press MENU button to point to "MANUAL PRESET". Press SEL. button.

-CHANNEL SET UP-AUTO PRESET MANUAL SET UP

3 Enter the desired channel number

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired channel number is appeared. (You can also use the number buttons to enter it)




NOTES:

- The bands are switched as follows by pressing ADD/DELETE button. (Example: Now the receiving band is VHFL) VHFL
- When you will select the band, press MEMORY button. The mode will change VHFL, VHFH, UHF.

4 Skip it from memory

Press ADD/DELETE button repeatedly until the word "SKIP" appears on the TV/VCR screen. The channel is skipped from memory.



• To skip another channel, repeat steps [3] and [4].

5 Exit the channel setup mode

Press MENU button to returns to TV mode.

NOTES:

- To confirm that channel(s) has been deleted, press $C/P \nabla$ or \triangle button.
- Button selections for Manual Preset mode should be done within 30 seconds, otherwise Manual Preset mode will be out.

MANUAL PRESET

1 Select "CHANNEL SET UP"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "CHANNEL SET UP".

Then, press SEL. button

-MENUTIMER PROGRAMMING
PICTURE CONTROL
SETTING CLOCK
CHANNEL SET UP
USER SET UP

2 Select "MANUAL PRESET"


Press MENU button to point to "MANUAL PRESET".
Press SEL. button.

-CHANNEL SET UP-AUTO PRESET

MANUAL SET UP

3 Enter the desired channel number

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired channel number is appeared. (You can also use the number buttons to enter it)



NOTES:


- If selected channel is in "SKIP" mode, press ADD/DELETE button to set the channel range.
- When you will select the band, press MEMORY button. The mode will change VHFL, VHFH, UHF.

4 Set the receiving channel

Press VOLUME \blacktriangledown or \blacktriangle button to set the receiving channel.

NOTES:

 When you will select the band, keep pressing VOLUME ▲ or
 ▼ button. The mode will change VHFL, VHFH, UHF.



• To memorise another channel, repeat steps [3] and [4].

5 Memorising the selected channel

Press MENU button to memorise the selected channel.

CLOCK SETTING

In the example below, the clock is to be set to:

1 Select "SETTING CLOCK"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "SETTING CLOCK". Then, press SEL. button.

2 Select the month

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired month is appeared. (Example: "03" for March)

Then, press SEL. button.



3 Select the day

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired day is appeared. (Example: "01" for 1st)

Then, press SEL. button.

4 Select the year

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired year is appeared. (Example: 1996) Then, press SEL. button.

5 Select the hour

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired hour is appeared. (Example: 17) Then, press SEL. button.

6 Select the minute

Press C/P ▼or ▲ button repeatedly until the desired minute is appeared. (Example: 40)

7 Start the clock

Press MENU or SEL. button.
Although seconds are not displayed, they begin counting from 00 when you press MENU or SEL. button. Use this feature to synchronise the clock with the correct time.

TO CHANGE CLOCK SETTING


If you want to change the clock,

- 1) Follow steps [1] and [2]
- 2) Select a digit you want to change using SEL. button.
- 3) Enter correct numbers using $C/P \nabla$ or \triangle button.
- 4) Press MENU or SEL. button to start the clock.

ON SCREEN DISPLAY

To check the Counter, Clock and Channel number on the TV screen, press SEL. button on the remote control. Each time you press SEL. button on the remote control, the TV screen will change as follows:

- In the Counter mode, after 5 seconds, only the counter remains. To clear it, press SEL. button.
- In the Clock mode, after 5 seconds, only the clock and the channel number remain. To clear them, press SEL. button.



SPECIAL FEATURES

DEGAUSSING

Magnetism from nearby appliances might affect the colour of the TV picture.

If this happens, move this unit away from the appliance. If the colour is still not correct, disconnect power cord from AC outlet then reconnect it after 30 minutes.

AUTO REWIND-EJECT

- When the end of a tape is reached during recording, playback, or fast-forward, the tape will automatically rewind to the beginning, power off and tape ejects.
- This function is operative when Auto Repeat is set to the [OFF] position.
- The tape will not auto-rewind during timer recording or One Touch Recording.
- When the tape is rewound to the preset memory position of the Counter Memory during Auto Rewind, the tape will not eject and TV/VCR will not turn off.

WATCHING A TV PROGRAM

1 Turn on the TV/VCR

Press POWER switch on the back of the TV/VCR to switch to "ON". Press FUNCTION button to turn on the TV/VCR.

2 Select the channel number

Press C/P ∇ or \triangle button to select your desired channel number.



3 Adjust the volume is you need

Press VOLUME ∇ or \triangle button to adjust the volume.



GAME MODE

This function enables you to adjust the TV screen making it suitable for use with a TV GAME.

Make sure . . .

You must use the remote control unit for the following steps:

1 Select "USER'S SET UP"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "USER'S SET UP". Then, press SEL. button.



2 Set "GAME MODE" to [ON]

Press C/P ∇ or \triangle button repeatedly until [ON] is appeared.



3 Exit the Game mode

Press MENU button repeatedly until the TV/VCR return to the TV mode.

TO CANCEL, THE GAME MODE

Repeat step [1] Then, step [2] to select [OFF]. Press MENU button to return to TV mode.

PICTURE CONTROL

The TV/VCR's picture controls - **BRIGHTNESS**, **CONTRAST**, **COLOUR** and **SHARPNESS** - are preset to the factory specification. This is usually best, but if you need to make any further adjustments adjust picture controls for a natural looking image.

NOTES:

- Procedures must be followed within 5 seconds.
 Otherwise the Picture Control mode will be cancelled.
- When setting the Picture Control, the Game mode will be automatically set to [OFF].

Make sure . . .

You must use the remote control unit for the following steps:

1 Select "PICTURE CONTROL"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "PICTURE CONTROL"

Then, press SEL. button.

-MENUTIMER PROGRAMMING
PICTURE CONTROL
SETTING CLOCK
CHANNEL SET UP
USER SET UP

2 Select item you want to adjust

Press SEL. button repeatedly until desired control is displayed.

Each time you press SEL. button, "BRIGHT", "CONTRAST", "COLOUR" and "SHARPNESS" will appear on the TV screen in sequence.



3 Adjust the picture control

Press C/P ∇ or \triangle button to adjust the picture control to your desired level.

	C/P ▼	C/P▲
BRIGHT	to decrease brightness	to increase brightness
CONTRAST	to decrease contrast	to increase contrast
COLOR	to pale	to brilliant
TINT	to purple	to green
SHARPNESS	to soft	to clear

NOTE: "TINT" will appear on the TV screen, only when an external input signal is used and a NTSC recorded tape is played back.

NORMAL PLAYBACK

Make sure . . .

Power must be turned on.

1 Insert a prerecorded tape

If the erase-protection tab has been removed, the TV/VCR will start playback automatically.

2 To begin playback

Press PLAY button.




3 To stop playback

Press STOP button when playback is completed.



TRACKING ADJUSTMENT

- Tracking adjustment will be set automatically (Digital Tracking function) when you start playback.
- When playing pre-recorded tapes or tapes recorder on units other than your own, noise lines (black and white streaks) may appear on the playback picture. If this occurs, adjust the tracking control by pressing C/P ▼ or ▲ button until the streaks disappear. To return to the DTR function, stop the tape once and start playback again.



PICTURE SEARCH

This feature is useful in finding or skipping over a particular scene on a tape. In this mode, the sound will be muted.

 You may view a video tape at a high speed in either a forward or reverse direction by pressing F.FWD or REW button.

NOTE: When searching a pre-recorded tape, it may cause a noise bar on the TV screen and the picture may revert to Black and White. This is normal.

2) For normal speed, simply press PLAY button.

STILL PICTURE

You can view a still picture on the screen during playback (the Still mode). Press PAUSE/STILL button during playback.

Press PLAY button to return to playback.

NOTES:

- Usually there will be video "noise" lines (black and white streaks or dots) on the screen. This is normal.
 This is not a fault of the machine but merely a by-product of the technology involved in producing a TV/VCR with LP mode.
- If it is left in the Pause mode for more than five minutes, the TV/VCR will automatically switch to the Stop mode.

NOISE CANCEL (in the Still mode)

This feature allows you to reposition or reduce the noise lines of a still picture.

Press PAUSE/STILL button repeatedly so that the noise lines change position on the screen and you can see the picture in its entirety without distracting noise lines. NOTE: If you use the PAUSE/STILL button to freeze the picture during playback, the still picture may, in addition to the "noise bars", revert to black and white. This is normal.

SPECIAL PLAYBACK

Make sure . . .

• You must use the remote control for the following steps

RENTAL PLAYBACK

This function enables you to improve the picture quality when playing back worn cassettes such as those rented from a video shop.

1 Select "USER'S SET UP"


Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "USER'S SET UP". Then, press SEL. button.



2 Set "RENTAL" to [ON]

Press MENU button to point to "RENTAL".

Press C/P ▼or ▲ button repeatedly until [ON] is appeared.



3 Exit the Rental setting

Press MENU button repeatedly until the TV/VCR return to the TV mode.

4 Start playback

Press PLAY button to start playback. "RENTAL PLAY ▶" appears.

• Once you select the Rental mode, it stays in effect even after you turn off the TV/VCR.

TO CANCEL THE RENTAL MODE

Repeat steps [1]. Then, follow step [2] but select [OFF]. Press MENU button to return to TV mode.

- Power must be turned on.
- Insert a prerecorded tape.
- Before playback, follow steps below.

REPEAT PLAYBACK

The TV/VCR has an auto repeat function that allows you to repeat a tape indefinitely without using the PLAY button. There are two selections for Auto Repeat Playback.

ALL REPEAT: repeat playback from the beginning to the end of the tape.

BLANK REPEAT: repeat playback from the beginning to the blank part, which is not recorded anything for more than 10 seconds.

NOTE: All buttons except FUNCTION and STOP buttons do not work during Repeat Playback. Always set the Repeat Playback to [OFF] when not in use this function.

1 Select "USER'S SET UP"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "USER'S SET UP". Then, press SEL. button.



2 Select "ALL" or "BLANK"

Press MENU button repeatedly to point to "REPEAT PLAY"

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired selection [ALL] or [BLANK] is appeared.



3 Exit the Repeat Play setting

Press MENU button repeatedly until the TV/VCR return to the TV mode.

4 Start playback

Press PLAY button to start the Repeat Play. "REPEAT PLAY ▶" appears.

- Once you select the Repeat Play mode, it stays in effect even after you turn off the TV/VCR.
- If the Rental mode is set [ON], the "RENTAL PLAY ▶" display has priority.

TO CANCEL THE REPEAT PLAY MODE

Press STOP button to stop playback. And repeat steps [1] then follow step [2] but select [OFF]. Press MENU button repeatedly until the TV/VCR return to the TV mode.

Make sure . . .

- You must use the remote control for the following steps.
- Power must be turned on.
- Insert a tape.

COUNTER MEMORY

This feature can be used to memorise a beginning point that you want to review. And you can search it easily by rewinding or fast forwarding.

NOTE:

 If the counter is not displayed, the Counter Memory will not be activated. Press COUNTER MEMORY button so that the counter appears on the display.

1 Stop a tape at your desired point

Rewind or fast forward the tape to the beginning point

2 Reset the counter to 0:00:00

Press COUNTER RESET button.

3 Select the Counter Memory mode

Press COUNTER MEMORY button so that "MEMORY" appears on the display.



4 Begin recording or playback

Press REC or PLAY button.

Press STOP button when recording or playback is completed.

5 To activate the Counter Memory

Press REW (or F.FWD) button. The tape will automatically stop when the counter returns to 0:00:00

TO CANCEL THE COUNTER MEMORY

First, have the TV/VCR appear on the counter of the TV screen, then press COUNTER MEMORY button so that "COUNT" appears on the TV screen.



TIME SEARCH

The Time Search function makes it possible to quickly advance the tape to your desired position from any position by entering the exact amount of playback time of the part that you want to skip.

NOTES:

- Time Search is set up to 9 hours 50 minutes (9:50) by 10 minutes at a time.
- This function is not operative in recording mode.
- Counter Memory function is not operative in this mode.
- This function is not operative when a cassette tape is not inserted in the TV/VCR.


In the example below: To watch a program after 2 hour 50 minutes from present position to forward direction.

1 Select "TIME SEARCH" mode

Press TIME SEARCH button

2 Enter your desired time

Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly until your desired time is appeared. (Example: "2:50" for 2 hours 50 minutes)



3 Begin Time Search

Press REW or F.FWD button. The tape will move to the specified point.

The time counts down as the searching progresses. When 0:00 is reached, the tape will start playback automatically.

TO CANCEL THE TIME SEARCH

Press STOP button on the TV/VCR or the remote control. This will delete the selected time.

RECORDING

Make sure . . .

- Power must be turned on.
- Insert a cassette tape with its erase prevention tab in place. (If necessary, rewind or fast forward the tape to the point at which you want to begin recording.)

NORMAL RECORDING

You can only watch the same TV program that is being recorded.

1 Select the channel to be recorded

Press number buttons on the remote control or the $C/P \bigvee or \triangle$ button.




2 Select the tape speed

Press SPEED button to select the desired tape speed (SP/LP).



3 Begin recording

Press REC button. The REC indicator flashes.




4 Stop recording

Press STOP button when recording is completed.

SKIPPING SOME MATERIALS DURING RECORDING

Press PAUSE/STILL button to temporarily stop recording. The REC indicator blinks. Press PAUSE/STILL or REC button to resume recording.



NOTES:

- To prevent tape damage, after five minutes, the TV/VCR will automatically return to the Recording mode
- When in the Pause/Still mode, a display showing 5
 "■" marks will appear on the screen. Each "■" mark represents one minute of Pause time. You may refer to this display for remaining pause time available.

NORMAL RECORDING

This function enables you to set a recording length simply by pressing REC/OTR button on the TV/VCR.

Make sure . . .

- Power must be turned on
- Insert a cassette tape with its erase prevention tab in place. (If necessary, rewind or fast forward the tape to the point at which you want to begin recording.)


NOTE: This function cannot be done by the remote control.

1 Select the channel to be recorded

Press number buttons on the remote control or the C/P ∇ or \triangle button.

2 Begin OTR

Press REC/OTR button on the TV/VCR as many times as needed. The recording length will be determined by the number of times you press REC/OTR button.



Each additional push will increase the recording time by 30 minutes. It is set up to 8 hours.



HINTS:

- Recording starts immediately when the REC/OTR button is pressed.
- When REC/OTR button is pressed 18 times, the TV/VCR will switch to the Normal Recording mode.
- To stop the OTR operation, press STOP button on the TV/VCR or on the remote control.
- To show the remaining time, press SEL. button repeatedly until "OTR" appears on the TV screen.
- Recording stops when 0:00 is reached.
- If the tape runs out before the end time, the TV/VCR will switch to the Stop mode immediately, eject the tape and the TV/VCR power will be turned off.

COPYING A VIDEO CASSETTE (Requires another VCR)

Connect your TV/VCR and a Source (Playing) VCR using the following diagram.



- 1) Insert a pre-recorded video cassette into the Source (Playing) VCR.
- 2) Insert a blank video cassette or one you want to record over, into the TV/VCR's cassette compartment.
- 3) Press SPEED button to select the desired recording speed (SP or LP).
- 4) Press C/P ▼ or ▲ button repeatedly so that "AUX" appears on the screen.
- 5) Begin playback of the tape in the Source (Playing) VCR.
- 6) Press REC button on the TV/VCR.

NOTE: For best results during dubbing, use the TV/VCR front panel controls whenever possible. The remote control might affect the Source (Playing) VCR's playback operation.

AUTOMATIC TIMER RECORDING

You may set the TV/VCR to record while you are away. You can set 8 programs to record on a specific day, daily or weekly within a 1 year period.

In the example below, the timer is being set to record:

DATE: MAY 6th 1996 SETTING TIME: from 19:30 to 20:50

CHANNEL: CH36

NOTE: You must use the remote control for this procedure.

Make sure . . .


- Be sure the clock is set to the correct time and date before setting the timer.
- Power must be turn on to set automatic timer recording.
- Insert a cassette tape with its erase prevention tab in place. (If necessary, rewind or fast forward the tape to the point at which you want to begin recording.)

Avoid over lap of programs...

There is a case that a program will not be performed. when programs overlap;

- The program that the start time is set earlier has priority.
- When the earliest program has finished and the programs which should start still overlap, the recording will start in order of the program number.
- If you programmed as the illustration, the timer recording would be carried out as follows (shaded part is the carried period):

9:00AM - 10:00AM for PROGRAM 2 10:00AM for PROGRAM 1



1 Select "TIMER PROGRAMMING"

Press MENU button to point to "TIMER PROGRAMMING".

And press SEL. button.

• When you did not set the clock, "SETTING CLOCK" appears. If so, follow page 11 to set the clock and repeat from step [3].

And press SEL. button.





3 Select once, every day or weekly recording *For once recording:*

Press C/P ▲ (up) button repeatedly until your desired date is appeared. (Example: "05/06" for May 6th) and press SEL. button.



For every day recording: To record a TV program at the same time on the same channel every day.

(Example: Monday through Sunday)

Press C/P ▼ (down) button repeatedly until "EVERY DAY" is appeared. And press SEL. button.



For weekly recording: To record a TV program at same time on the same channel every week.

Press C/P ∇ or \triangle button repeatedly until your desired hour is appeared. (Example: "20" for **20**:50)

10 Exit the program mode

Press SEL. button. Program 4 is now completed. To set another program, repeat steps [1] to [10]

11 Set the timer

Press FUNCTION button to set automatic timer recording. The REC indicator lights up.

• You must turn off the TV/VCR to activate automatic. timer recording.

If power is not turned off and you continue watching TV, "TIMER REC STANDBY" starts flashing on the TV screen 2 minutes before the programmed start time.

TO CORRECT A PROGRAM

- While setting a program; press ADD/ DELETE button to go back one step, and enter correct numbers using C/P ▼or ▲ button
- After setting a program;
 - 1) Press FUNCTION button.
 - 2) Repeat steps [1] [2].
 - 3) Press SEL. button repeatedly (or press ADD/DELETE button to go back one step) until a digit you want to correct flashes and make changes.
 - 4) Press MENU button.
 - 5) Repeat step [11].

TO CANCEL AN AUTOMATIC TIMER RECORDING

- While setting or after setting a program;
 - 1) Press FUNCTION button.
 - 2) Repeat steps [1] ~ [2] and select a program number you want to cancel.
 - 3) Press ADD/DELETE button.
 - 4) Press MENU button to return to the TV mode.
- While recording is in progress;
 - 1) Press FUNCTION button.
 - 2) Press STOP/EJECT button on the TV/VCR.

If you press FUNCTION button to turn off before the end time, timer recording will continued. Repeat steps [1] ~ [2] select a program number you want to cancel and press ADD/DELETE button. Press MENU button to return to the TV mode.

TO CHECK THE START/END TIME

- 1) Press FUNCTION button so that the REC indicator goes off.
- 2) Press MENU button to point to "TIMER PROGRAMMING".
- 3) Press SEL. button.
- 4) Select a program number you want to check using C/P ▼ or ▲ button. The details of selected program appears on the TV screen.
- 5) Press MENU button. The TV screen returns to the TV mode.

HINTS:

- Make sure the channel you want to record is properly set in advance.
- It is not necessary to press REC button for timer recording.
- Recording begins automatically at the set of the Start time
- If you are recording using a Timer mode, you may not operate the unit manually.

MAINTENANCE

CABINET CLEANING

- Wipe the front panel and other exterior surfaces of the TV/VCR with a soft cloth immersed in lukewarm water and wrung dry.
- Never use a solvent or alcohol. Do not spray insecticide liquid near the TV/VCR. Such chemicals may cause damage and discolouration to the exposed surfaces.

HEAD CLEANING

 Picture playback may become blurred or interrupted while the TV program reception is clear. This does not mean that the recorded program has been erased Dirt accumulated on the video heads after long periods of tape playback, or the usage of rental or worn tapes can cause this problem. In this case, video head cleaning requires highly technical attention, therefore consult the nearest Authorised Service Centre.

Clean heads only when problems occur.

SERVICING

• Should your TV/VCR become inoperative, do not try to correct the problem by yourself. There are no user serviceable parts inside. Turn off, unplug the power cord, and take the unit to the nearest Authorised Service Centre for servicing.


