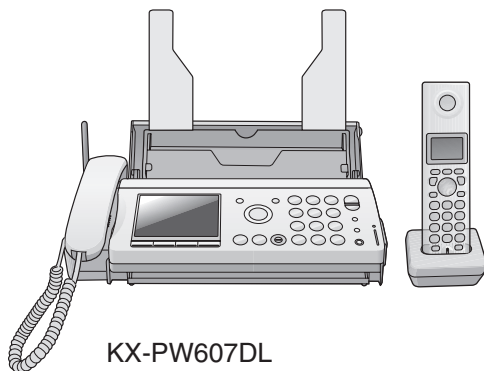

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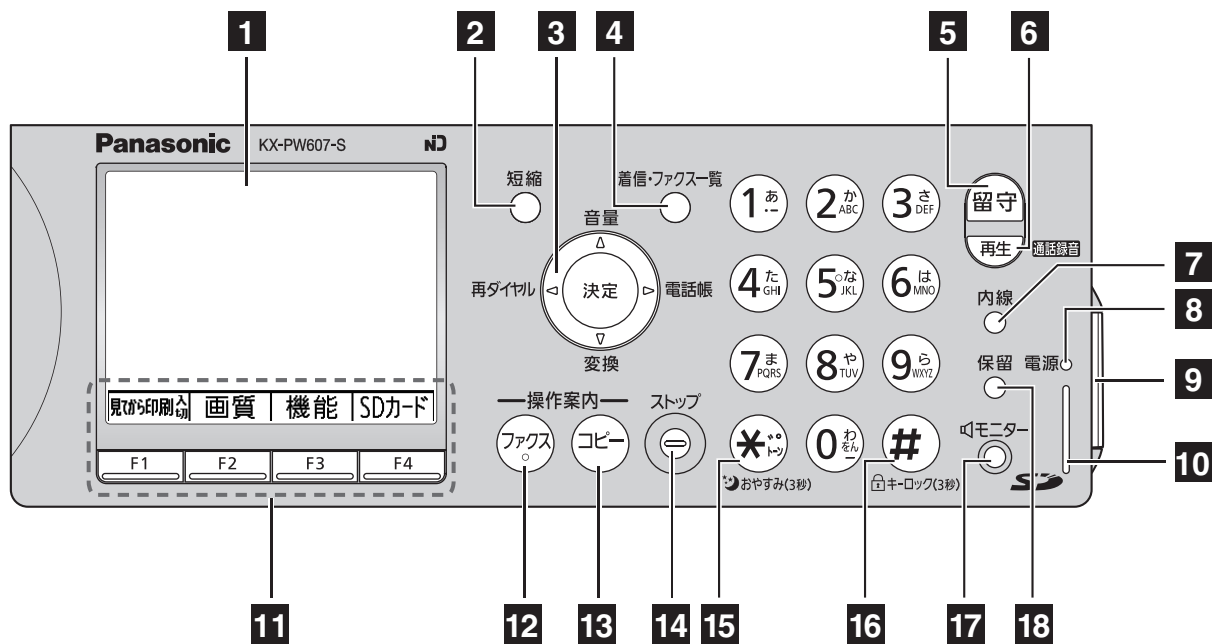

Finding the controls

Main unit




1 Liquid crystal display


- The display turns off after about 2 minutes of inactivity.
- To turn on the display, press  (Stop).

2 Speed Dialer button

3 Volume/Change/Redial/Phonebook key

- To adjust the volume.
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.

 To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.

 To use the phonebook.

 To store a parameter.

- ### 4 Call/Fax List button starts a search in
- the Number Display (Caller ID) log.
 - the fax list stored in memory.
- Call/Fax List** indicator lights when
- a call was missed. (For Number Display service users.)
 - a fax was stored in memory.

- ### 5 Auto Answer button & indicator
- light on: answering device activated.
 - light off: used as a regular telephone.

- ### 6 Playback button plays back recorded messages.

Record button records a telephone conversation.

- When an SD Memory Card is available, it is recorded in the SD Memory Card.

- ### 7 Intercom button

- ### 8 Power indicator

- ### 9 SD Memory Card cover

- ### 10 SD indicator

- ### 11 Multi-operation buttons refer to the function displayed on the display panel.

- ### 12 Fax button starts faxing.


- ### 13 Copy button starts copying.

- ### 14 Stop button

- ### 15 Tone button switches to tone dialing. Night mode button

- ### 16 Sharp button

Key lock button can lock the main unit so that no calls or settings can be made. To turn key lock on, press this button for about 3 seconds until a single beep is heard.

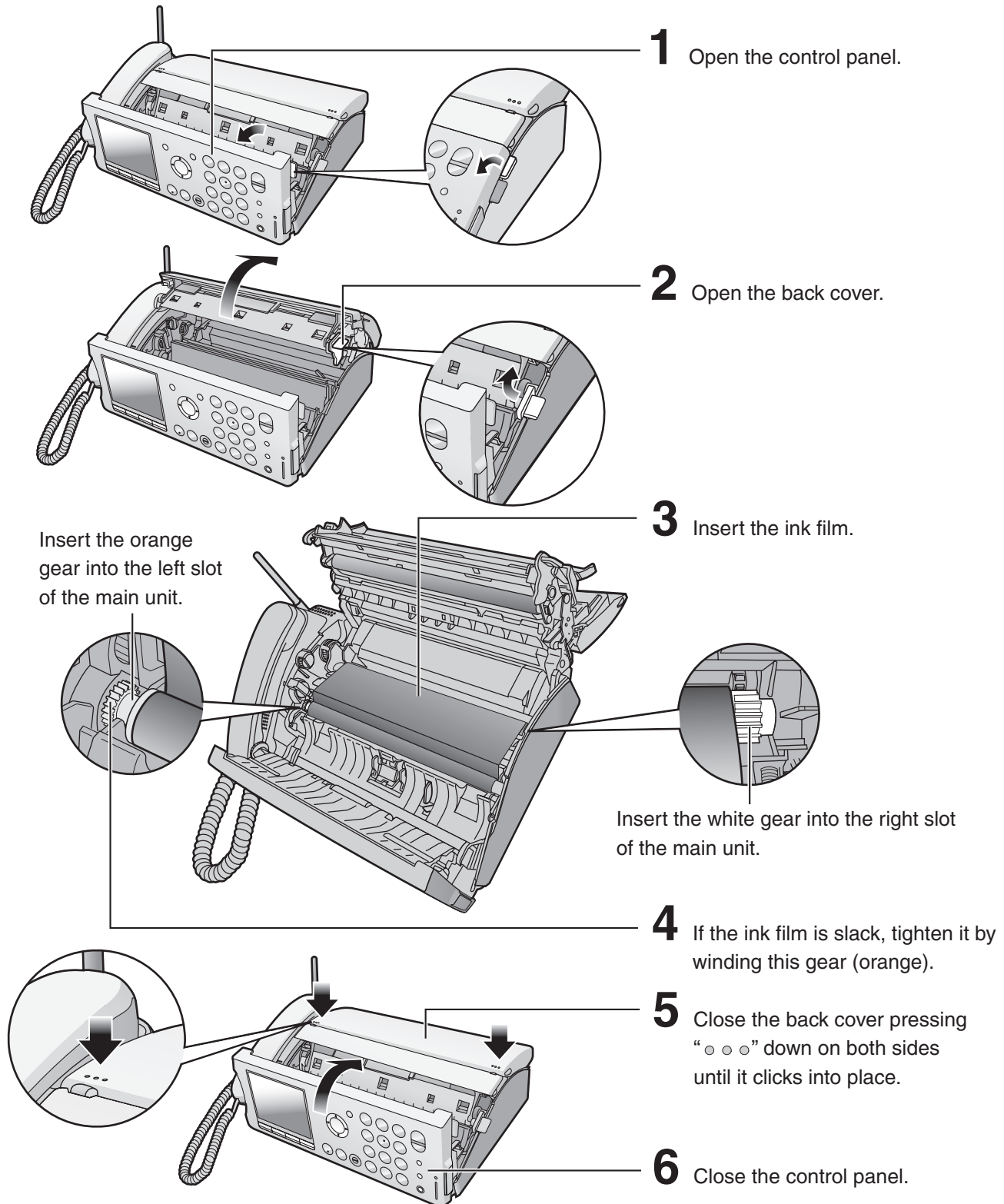

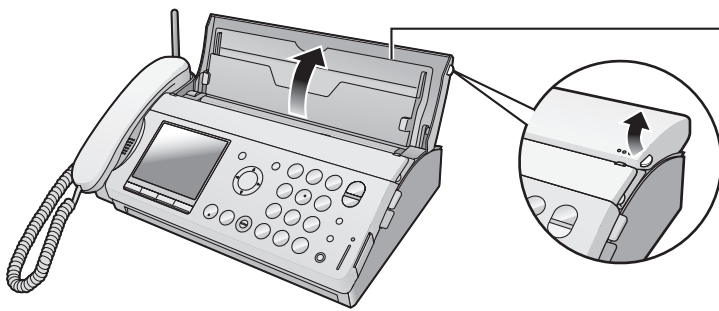

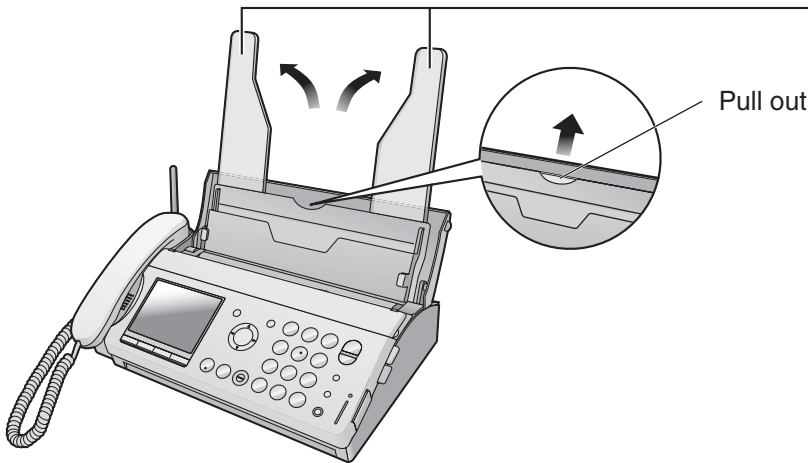

Installing recording paper (A4 size)

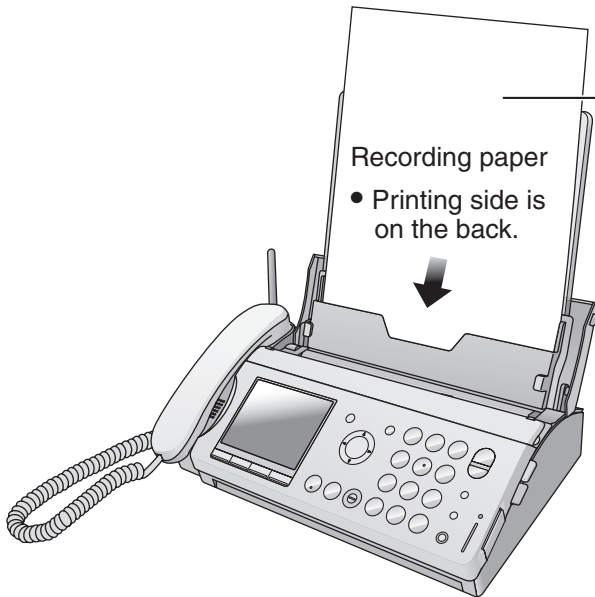


1 Open the recording paper tray.



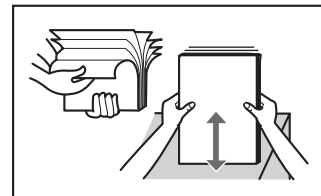
2 Set up the recording paper stands.

① Remove the recording paper and fold the recording paper stands in.

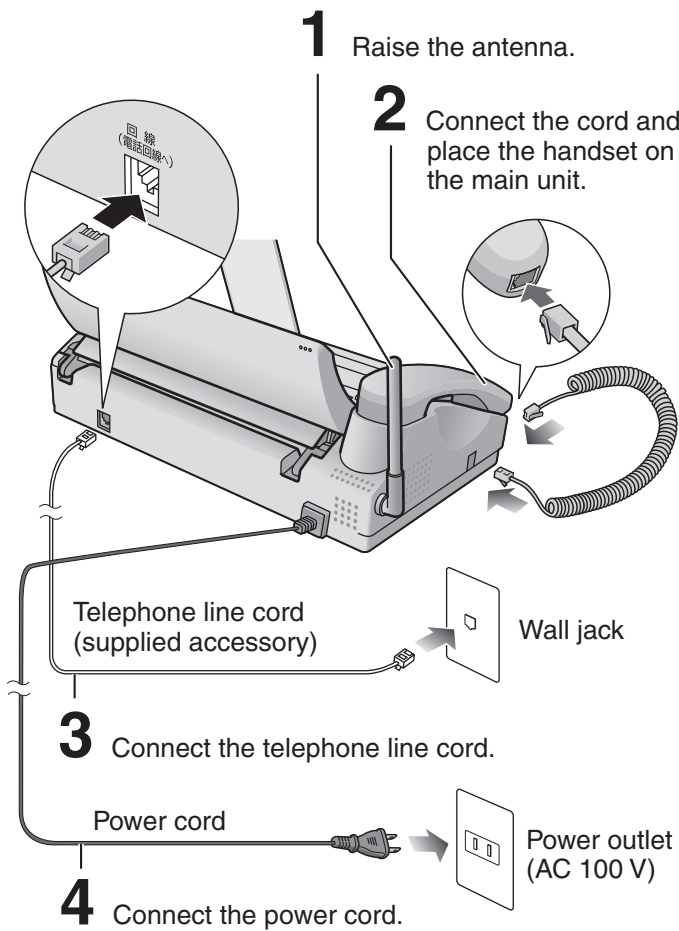

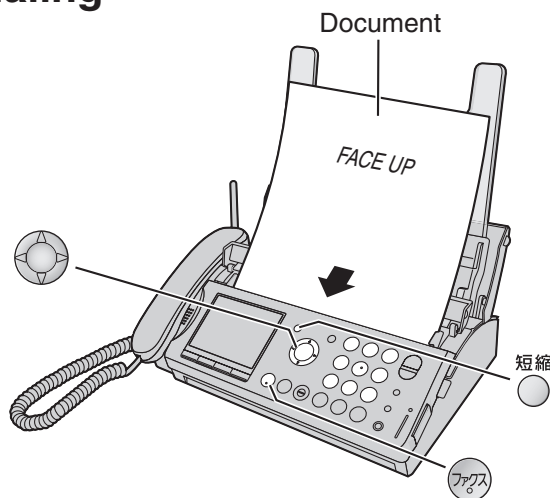
Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually






- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press  (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Press  (Fax).
- 5 Dial the fax number.
- 6 Press  (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.





Using the speed dialer

- 1 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.

 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing  (Resolution) repeatedly.

 画質=写真	(Photo) for originals containing photographs.

Receiving faxes

You can select beforehand whether to receive faxes by “Receive in memory” or “Receive on recording paper”.

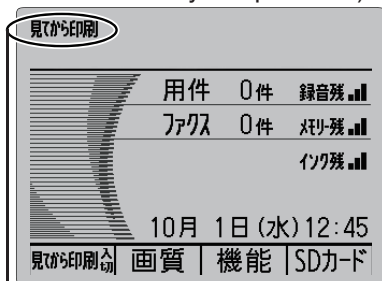
Receive in memory : The received fax will be stored in the main unit memory. You can check the contents on the display, then print them if necessary.
(Default setting)

Receive on recording paper : The received fax will be printed on recording paper.

Setting/canceling “Receive in memory”

Press (Receive in memory), then (Yes).

(Changes each time they are pressed.)

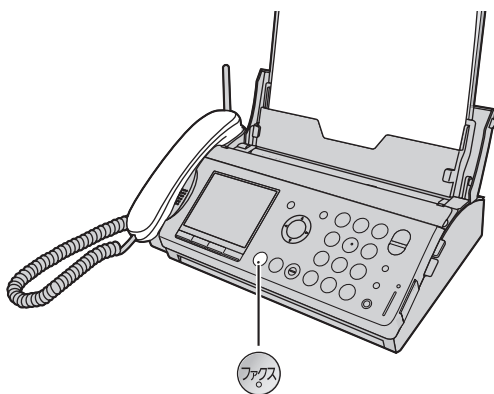

With no display: Receive on recording paper

Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



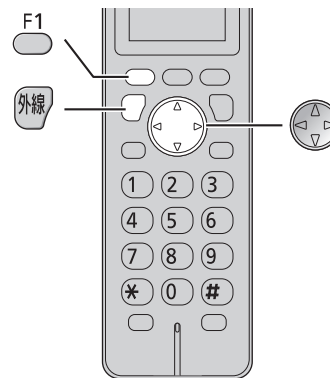
1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset to answer the call.

2 When:
– document reception is required,
– a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
– no sound is heard,

press (Fax), then replace the handset.

• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset (KX-FKN515):



1 When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.

• If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).

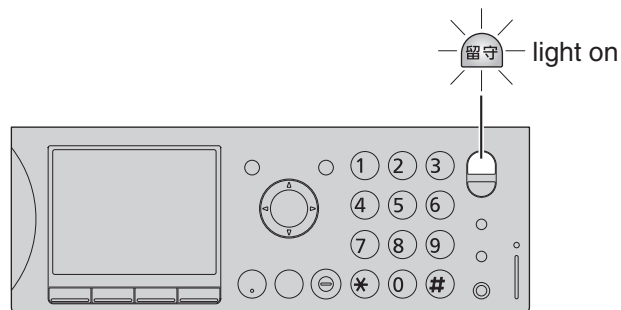
2 When:
– document reception is required,
– a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
– no sound is heard,
press .

3 Press (Search button) repeatedly until the “ファクス受信” is displayed, then press .

4 Press .

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)




1 If the (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing .

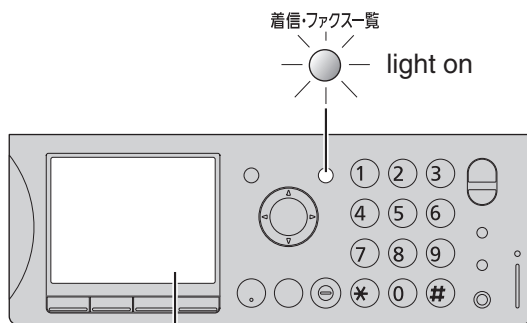
2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

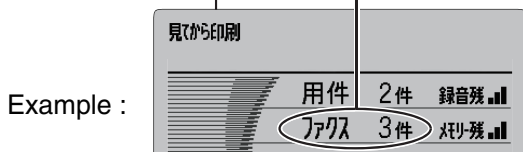
Display when faxes are received in memory

When new faxes are received in memory,  (Call/Fax list) will light on.

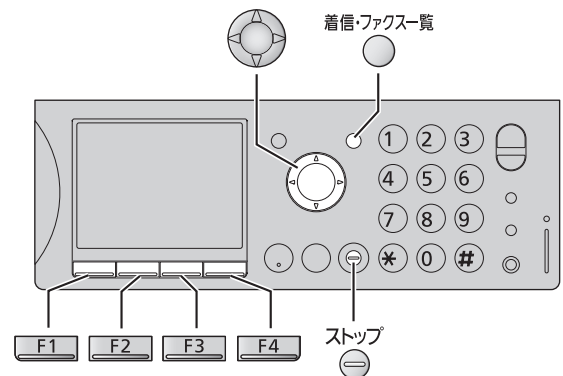
- It will also light on when a call is missed. (For Number Display service users.)
- Even if an SD Memory Card is inserted, new faxes will be received in the main unit memory. (To save the faxes to the SD Memory Card, see page 22.)





The number of faxes stored in the main unit memory is displayed.

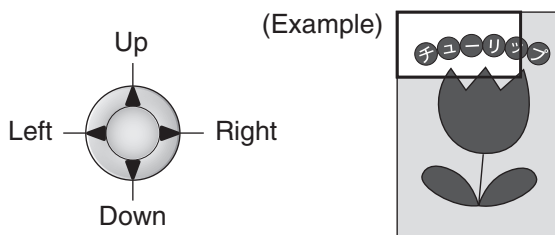

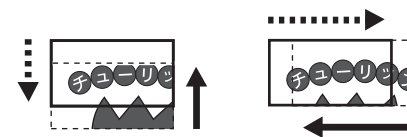

The display contents can be scrolled up, down, left and right.



■ To enlarge or reduce content

Press  (Turn/Zoom)  (Zoom) to enlarge or reduce the display content in the following order:

Normal → Enlarge(double size) → Reduce(half size) → Normal...

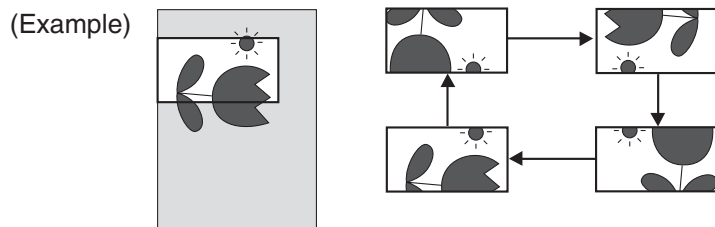
■ Scroll pages

To show the next page: Press  (Scroll page)  (Next page).

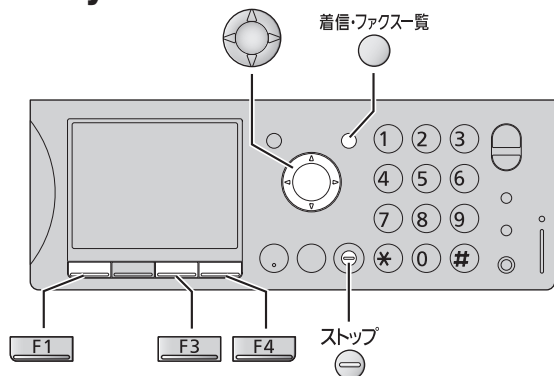

Receiving faxes

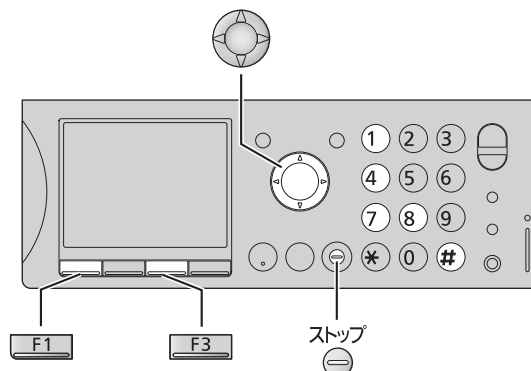

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1 Press **機能** (Function).
- 2 Press **# 1 4 7**.

- 5 Press **開始** (Start) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.
- 6 Press **終了** (End) or **ストップ** (Stop) and replace the handset.
 - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

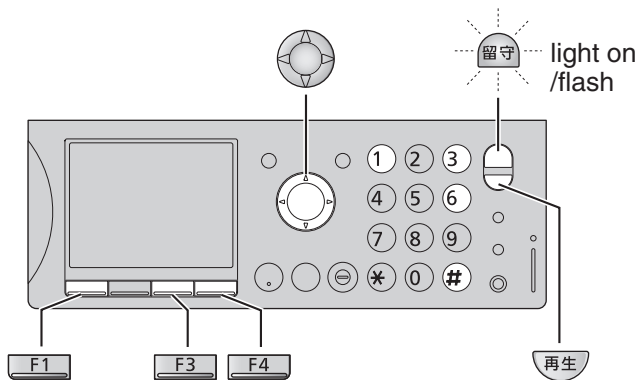

- 1 Press **機能** (Function).
- 2 Press **# 1 4 8**.

Activating the answering device



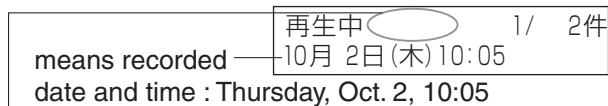
If an SD Memory Card is available (inserted), voice messages will be recorded to the SD Memory Card. (See page 22.)

- 1 Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on by pressing **留守**.
- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
 - To record your own greeting message, see page 18.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the **留守** (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press **留守** to listen to recorded messages.

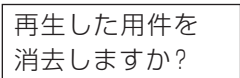


If an SD Memory Card is inserted, the following variations may occur:

- (SD)** : Playing a message in the SD Memory Card.
- (未保存)** : Playing a message in the main unit that is not saved to any SD Memory Card.
- Blank** : Playing a message in the main unit that has been saved to an SD Memory Card.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press **はい** **F1**.
- To save the messages, press **いいえ** **F4**.

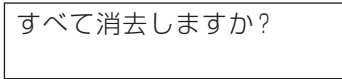


Listening to all of the recorded messages

Press **再生** (Playback) when new messages are not recorded.

- When new messages are recorded, only the new messages will be played back.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.



- To erase the messages, press **はい** **F1** (Yes).
- To save the messages, press **いいえ** **F4** (No).

Erasing a specific message

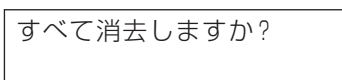
Press **用件消去** **F4** (Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press **はい** **F1** (Yes).

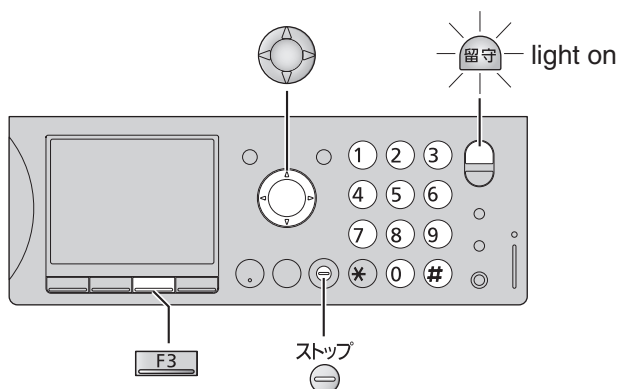

Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

1. Press **F3** (Function).
2. Press **# 0 0 6**.
3. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except * or #.

4. Press **決定** (Set).
5. Press **ストップ** (Stop).

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

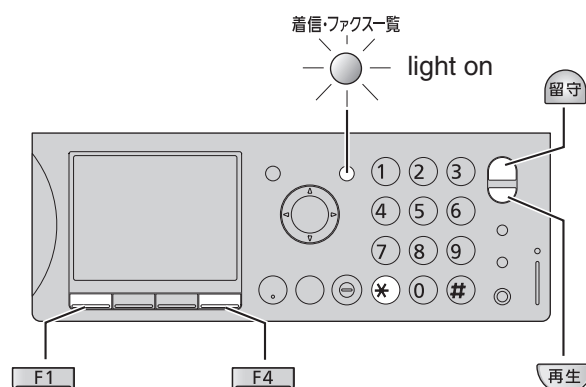
Turn the **留守** (Auto answer) light on before you go out.

Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

1. Call your unit.
2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
3. Press **2** or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press **4** after the new messages have been played back.

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press ***** (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- “**おやすみ**” is displayed and **留守** lights on.
- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.

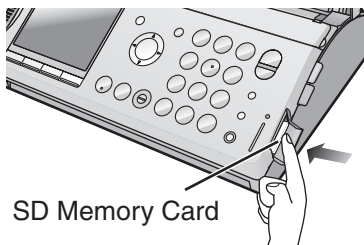
