



Finding the controls

Main unit



- 1 Liquid crystal display
- 2 Speed Dial button
- Function button initiates programming.
 Resolution button selects the resolution when faxing or copying.
- 4 Volume/Change/Redial/Phonebook key



- To adjust the volume (see below).
- To change Hiragana into Kanji.
- ■To adjust the **ringer volume** when the unit is on stand by

(Set) → (Select "呼出音量変更") → (Set) → (press repeatedly) → ストップ

- ■To adjust the **receiver volume** while talking, press repeatedly.
- ■To adjust the **speaker volume** while listening to the recorded messages or using the monitor, press repeatedly.



To redial the phone numbers in the redial list. The last 10 phone numbers dialed are stored in memory.





How to use **buttons**

Secure button

- While the portable handset is ringing, press this button. The portable handset announces a message to the caller . The message is announced in Japanese and means "This unit is currently set to Caller Verifying mode. Could you please speak out your name?"
 - ■To talk to the caller, press (外線).
 - ■To hung up, press (*



Mute button

 To mute your voice to the other party by pressing this button for about 2 seconds. (To release the mute, press this button again.)

- Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE UP until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press repeatedly to select the desired resolution while "画質=" is displayed (see below).
- 4 Press 77% (Fax).
- **5** Dial the fax number.
- Fress (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution





press [77] (Fax), then replace the handset.


When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger, then press (Talk) to answer the call.

- a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
- no sound is heard,
 press ←

- 4 Press 51.

• The main unit will start fax reception.


Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- **1** If the 留守 (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing 留守.
- When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Operating the built-in answering device

Recording your own greeting message



You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- **5** Press (Set) and speak your greeting message after a beep, up to 16 seconds, to the handset.

 - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

Activating the answering device

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the \Box (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press 留守 to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

- To erase the messages, press ※.
 To save the messages, press #.




Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the 留守 (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

- 1. Call your unit.
- 2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
- 3. Press 2 or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press 4 after the new messages have been played back.

Night mode

Turn on the night mode



Press (Night mode) for about 3 seconds.

- "梦" is displayed and 留守 lights on.
- When a call is received during night mode, the unit will handle the call silently, either by storing the received fax into memory or by recording the caller's message.
- Night mode allows you to select a block of time during which the unit will not ring for outside calls or make sounds when you change the settings. This feature is useful when you do not want to be disturbed, for example, while sleeping.





For Number Display service subscribers

• If you subscribe to Number Display service, the message heard by the caller will change according to the caller's situation.

Example : If the caller requested not to send caller's information, the message heard by the caller will change to mean "Your phone number is blocked by service provider. Please call again with adding '186' to the beginning of the phone number."

•When the following is displayed after blocking an incoming call, you can set the unit to block the call from the same telephone number.
