

DESCRIPTION

The UA™ 5 is a high quality utility amplifier ideally suited for a majority of installation requirements. The continuous 5 watt capability of the UA 5 can handle most audio situations for driving headphones, small monitor speakers, and a broad range of line amplification.

The level control is a convenient rotary device and is located near the input/output terminal strip. The input may be accessed via phone jack or screw terminals and a pilot light is provided to indicate that electrical power is being supplied to the unit.

Applications: The UA 5 finds excellent acceptance as a low-level line amplifier. In this configuration, the 600 ohm balanced output or the 8 ohm output can be used to drive the input of other power amplifiers remotely located from the music source.

Telephone facilities with provision for music/messageon-hold usually require either 600 ohm or 8 ohm inputs to their cards and both are provided with the UA 5. (See diagram on back.)

The UA.5 may be used as a driver/amplifier for several sets of headphones.

WALL OR SHELF MOUNTING

The UA 5 can be mounted on a vertical or horizontal surface using the brackets formed on the bottom panel. For mounting on a wooden or paneled surface use No. 6x½" or larger wood screws. For mounting onto a masonry or drywall type surface use fasteners which are designed for this purpose.

ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SPECIFICATIONS

The utility amplifier shall be a single channel line level amplifier. The unit shall have one level control. Inputs to the amplifier shall be made via barrier strip connections or phono jack. Outputs shall be made by barrier strip connections. The unit shall be packaged in a rugged metal chassis 55% wide by 21% high by 35% deep. One-half inch mounting flanges shall be provided on each side. The unit shall operate from standard 120 Volts AC, 60 Hz power. The amplifier shall be capable of delivering 5 watts into 8 ohms at 3% or less distortion from 50 Hz to 20 kHz with hum and noise at least 80 dB below rated power (.5% distortion at 4 watts). The unit shall also provide a 600 ohm output. The unit shall be called the Peavey Architectural Acoustics Division model UA™ 5.





BLOCK DIAGRAM




