Welcome!

Thank you for buying this multi-media mobile audio system!

To operate the system correctly, please read the operational manual carefully before using the unit. Keep these instructions and retain this booklet for future reference.

About This Manual

This unit features a number of sophisticated functions ensuring superior operation. This manual will help you understand the functions and operations of the unit. This manual mainly explains remote control operation. However, in addition to those functions related with DVD/VCD/CD/MP3 operation that can only be operated by the remote control, there are also functions that can be operated by the buttons provided on the main unit.

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Notes on Installation

- The unit is designed for DC 12V, negative ground operation system only. Before installing the unit, make sure your vehicle is connected to DC 12V negative ground system.
- Be sure to connect the color coded leads according to the diagram. Incorrect connections may cause the unit to malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.
- Make sure all the connections are completely correct before turning on your unit.

- When replacing the fuse(s), the replacement must be of the same amperage as shown on the fuse holder.
- Do not block vents or radiator panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.
- After completing the installation and beginning to play the unit, (including replacing the battery), press RESET button on the base with pointed object (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

Precautions

This unit can play the following discs only:

NOTE: The unit is compatible with VCD 1.0/2.0/3.0 version and DVCD disc.

- Do not attempt to modify the unit, modifying the unit may cause an accident.
- Stop the vehicle before carrying out any operation that could interfere with your driving.
- Do not work in extremely high or low temperature. Be sure the temperature inside the vehicle is between -10° C and +60° C before turning on your unit.
- To enjoy optimum sound and images while playing, handle the discs as follows:

— Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.



Do not use your CDs with paste residue or ink attached.


——Do not use CDs with labels or stickers attached, which may leave a sticky residue while beginning to peel off. (Shown as the picture)



—Clean the discs with an optional cleaning cloth. Wipe each disc from the center out. (Shown as the picture)




Wiring Connection

Location of the Controls

Front Panel



1 POWER

Press to turn on or turn off the unit.

2 PLAY

Press to switch sequentially between playback and pause; during stop mode, you can also press to resume to playback.

③ PREV

Press to play the previous track.

4 NEXT

Press to play the next track.

(5) EJECT

Press to eject the disc.

6 STOP

Press to stop the playback.

7 RESET

Press to set the unit to initial status.

(8) REMOTE

Remote control receptor.

DISC LOADING SLOT

1 PWR(POWER)

Press to turn on or turn off the unit.

2 SETUP

During DVD playback mode, press to display system setting menu, user could select some relative constant parameters.

3 REPEAT

Press this button to activate the repeat function.

■ STOP

Press to stop the playback.

Ы PLAY/PAUSE

Press to switch sequentially between playback and pause; during stop mode, press to resume to playback.

In the system setting menu, press

[◄][▶][♠][▼] to move cursor upward,
downward, leftward or rightward,
and then press [ENTER] to execute
the entering or the selected item.

7 SHIFT

When shift function is activated, press the buttons which have two function signals on them, the upper function is valid.

S ZOOM and ►

Press ZOOM to make the picture increase in size;
Press I to play the previous track.

9 SLOW / ►

Press to slow forward or reverse during playback.

Press > to play the next track.

10 ANGLE and

11 SUBTITLE and ▶

During DVD mode, press SUBTITLE to change the sub-title language.

During playback, press

to perform faster forward.

(12) DISPLAY

During playback, press DISPLAY, the monitor will display the title, chapter, the elapsed time, and the remained time.

13 VOL+/VOL-

Press to increase or decrease volume level.

14 NUMBER BUTTON

Press to select track, or chapter.

15 ▲ EJECT BUTTON

16 MENU

During DVD mode, press to return to the main page of the root menu.

17 TITLE

During DVD mode, press to return to the main page of the title menu; during VCD mode, press to activate PBC (Playback Control) function.

18 P/N and L/R

Press P/N to adjust the system, press L/R to select the channel.

Basic Operation

1. Reset the Unit

When operating the unit for the first time or after replacing the car battery, you must reset the unit.

Press TRES button on the base with pointed object (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

Note:

- * This function can only be operated on the head unit.
- Pressing RES button will erase some memorized function.

2. Turn the Unit On/Off

Press Pwr button to turn on the unit, press it again to turn off the unit.

Note:

- Pressing POWER button on the head unit performs the same operation.
- When the unit is turned on, insert a disc, the disc will be played automatically.

3. Volume Control

Press 13 VOL+ button to increase the sound level and press 13 VOL- button to decrease the sound level.

Note:

- * The default volume level is 15. After the unit is off, if the volume level is higher or lower than this default level, it will resume to 15.
- This function can only be operated on the remote control.

4. Pause the Playback

During playback mode, press 5 ► button to switch between playback and pause; during stop mode, press it to resume to normal playback.

Note:

 Pressing button on the head unit performs the same operation.

5. Shift Function

Press button, the monitor will display

s, then press the double function
button, the above function is activated.

Press SHIFT button again, s disappears,
the other function can be activated.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

6. Stop the Playback

Press 4 ■ button to stop playing, press it again to stop completely, press

to resume playing.

Note:

* Pressing 6 button on the unit performs the same function

7. Eject a Disc

Press SEJECT on the head unit can eject the disc.

Note:

* Press 15 \(\text{\text{\text{\text{button on the remote}}} \) control performs the same operation.

8. Sensor

Infrared Sensor:

Receptor for the card remote commander.

Playing a DVD

1. Slow Motion Playback

During playback, press 7, then press 9 to play slow forward or slow reverse. Each pressing, the speed changes as followings:

Note

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

2. Fast Forward/Reverse

During playback mode, press 8 → button to skip reverse to the previous chapter, press 9 → button to skip forward to the next chapter.

Note:

 Pressing ③ or ⑥ button on the head unit performs the same operation separatedly.

During playback mode, press 10 ← or 11 → button to perform fast reverse or forward separately. Each time the button is pressed, the speed of fast reverse or forward changes as following:

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

3. Menu Selecting

- During prayback mode, press 16

 MENU button can go to the root menu
 of the disc. TFT shows all the chapters
 of the disc, you can use 6 or 14

 button to select desired chapter.
- During playback mode, press 17

 TITLE button can go to the title menu
 of the disc. TFT shows all the titles of
 the disc, you can use 6 or 14 button
 to select desired title.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

4. Increase Picture Size

First press 7 SHIFT button, then press 8 ZOOM button to increase the size of picture. There are 3 sizes, each press increase the size until the maximum size is reached:

$$X2 \longrightarrow X3 \longrightarrow X4 \longrightarrow No changing$$

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

5. Repeat Playing


During DVD mode, press 3 REPEAT button to activate the repeat function. Firstly press it to repeat the current chapter, secondly press it to repeat the current title, thirdly press it to cancel this function.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

6. System Selector

During playback, press 18 P/N to adjust the following systems:



During playback, press 7 SHIFT then press 18 P/N to select system, press it again to switch to channel selector.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

7. On-Screen Display

Press 12 DISPLAY, the monitor will display the current title, chapter and the elapsed time, the remained time.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control

8. Changing the Subtitle Language (Multi-subtitle)

With DVD featuring multi-subtitle recordings. During playback mode, you can firsly press (7) **SHIFT** button, then press (11) **SUBTITLE** button to switch between subtitle languages.

Selection options switch as follows:

Subtitles 1 — Subtitles 2 — Subtitles OFF

Note:

- This function can only be operated on the card remote control.
- This function only operates with DVD featuring multi-subtitle recordings.
- * The number in the "2" mark on a DVD's package indicates the number of recorded subtitle languages.

9. Changing the View Angle

With DVD featuring multi-angle (scenes shot from multiple angles) recordings, you can firstly press TSHIFT button, and then press MGLE button to switch among viewing angles during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

ANGLE 1 --- ANGLE 2 --- ANGLE 3

Note:

- This function can only be operated on the card remote control.
- This function only operates with DVD featuring multi-angle recordings.
- The "CO" mark on a DVD's package indicates it features multi-angle scenes.

The number in the "a" mark indicates the number of angles from which scenes were shot.

- You cannot switch angles during slow motion playback.
- If you press ANGLE during fast forward/reverse or pause, fast forward/reverse or pause is cancelled and normal playback resumes but the viewing angle does not change.


10. Set Up Menu


During playback mode, press 2 SETUP button, the screen will display system setting picture, your can select some relative constant parameters by moving the cursor and using 6 [4][>][A][V] buttons, and then press 6 ENTER to execute the selecting item.

Note:


- This function can only be operated on the card remote control.
- * The selections are preferred options that will be chosen if they are available on a disc. If the disc inserted does not have the preferred option then the discs own preference will be used.
- Regarding SETUP MENU, please refer to the following pages for more details.
- Some functions vary depending on the types or formats of the disc.



Playing a VCD/CD

1.Fast Forward/Reverse

During VCD/CD mode, press

■

button to skip reverse to the previous chapter; press

■ button to skip forward to the next chapter.

Note:

* Pressing 3 or 4 button on the head unit performs the same operation separately.

During VCD/CD mode, press 10 ←

or 11 button to perform fast reverse
or forward separately. Each time the button is pressed, the speed of fast reverse
/forward changes as follows:

Note:

* This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

2.Repeat Playing

During VCD/CD mode, press 3
REPEAT button to activate the repeat function. Firstly press it to repeat the current track, secondly press it to cancel this function.

Note:

- * This function can only be operated on the card remote control.
- * The default setting is Disc Repeat.

3.On-Screen Display

Press 12 DISPLAY, the monitor will display the current title, chapter and the elapsed time, the remained time.

Note:

* This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

4.Playing a VCD/CD

Insert a VCD/CD disc into (2) and then disc start the playback.

Note:

 You can eject a disc by pressing EJ button on the head unit or an on the remote control.

5. Number Button

During VCD/CD mode, you can select any track directly by using 14 Number Buttons. For example, if you need the 15th track, you can firstly press Button 10+ and then press Button 5, the 15th track will be played.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

6. Slow Motion Playback

During playback, press 7, then press 9 to play slow forward or slow reverse. Each pressing, the speed changes as followings:

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the card remote control.

7. Increase Picture Size

During VCD mode, first press 7 SHIFT button, then press 8 ZOOM button to increase the size of picture. There are 3 sizes, each press increase the size until the maximum size is reached:

$$2X \longrightarrow 3X \longrightarrow 4X \longrightarrow OFF$$

Note

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

8. PBC (Playback Control) Function

During VCD mode, pressing 17 TITLE button can activate PBC function. TFT shows "PBC ON", and the title menu appears on TFT. You can select tracks by using 14 Number Buttons. If no number button is pressed during 10s, the first track will be played. Press TITLE button again to withdraw PBC function.

Note:

- This function can only be operated on the card remote control.
- PBC playing confirms to version 2.0 of VCD disc only.

9.MENU

During VCD mode, when the PBC is on, press 16 MENU come back to the disc MENU.

Playing a MP3

1. MP3 Menu Mode

Insert a MP3 to the unit, the disc will be played automatically.

The monitor will display the tracks name of the disc. When played a disc of PIC files. Firstly press 4 ■ button, then press 6 4 ▶ ▼ ▲ to select tracks as desired.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

2.Select Tracks

Note:

* Pressing 3 and 4 on the head unit perform the same function.

3. Repeat Playing

During MP3 mode, press 3

REPEAT button to activate repeat function. Press it at first time to repeat the current track, press it again to cancel the function.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

4. On-Screen Display

During MP3 mode, press 12

DISPLAY button, the monitor will display single elapsed time and single remained time.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

5.Stop Playing

During MP3 mode, press 4 ■ on the remote control to stop playing.

Note:

 This function can only be operated on the remote control.

6.Pause the Playback

During MP3 mode, press 5 ► on the remote control to switch to play and pause.

Note:

* This function can only be operated on the remote control.

7.Fast Forward/Reverse

During MP3 mode, press 10 ← and 11 ← to play tracks fast forward and fast reverse. Each pressing changes as followings:

 2X \longrightarrow 4X \longrightarrow 8X \longrightarrow 16X \longrightarrow PLAY \longleftarrow

Note:

* This function can only be operated on the remote control.

Built-in radio frequency output mode

1.Brief function Introduction

Carrier signal of 88.5MHZ or 88.9 MHZ can be switched to radio wave which can be received by FM, the switch in the air is made by the built-in radio frequency output mode of the unit, which tune the audio signal in carrier signal by tuning stereo mode.

2.Operation of the Built-In Radio Frequency Output Mode

- ① Pull out and install the brown antenna, but not install it along the metal surface, or the signal will be affected.
- ② To insure receiving the local stations, tune the frequency in 88.5MHZ or 88.9 MHZ.
- ③ Enjoy the music of DVD, VCD or CD after tuning your radio in 88.5MHZ or 88.9MHZ (stereo frequency modulation radio is the best.)

Maintenance

Replacing the Fuse


Make sure the amperage matches the specified value when replacing the fuses. If the fuse is blown, check the power connection and replace with a new one. If the same problem occurs, it would be subjected to the malfunction. In such cases, please consult to the nearest service dealer.

Warning


Never use the fuse with the rated amperage more than that supplied to your unit, otherwise it will damage the unit.

Replacing the Battery


When the range of the operation of the card remote control becomes short or no functions while operating. Replace the lithium battery with a new button cell (CR2025). Make sure the battery polarity before replace.



Put the button-type battery with mark(+) upward into the Battery Holder.



Insert the Battery Holder into the Remote Control.



Precautions on Using Lithium Battery

- Always keep the lithium battery beyond children9s reach. In case swallowed, see a doctor immediately.
- Cleaning the battery with a dry cloth, to ensure its perfect connected.
- Make sure the proper polarity when loading with the battery.
- To prevent short circuit, do not use metal tweezer to clip the battery.






Detach the Unit (for Installation Method2)

1. Remove the outer trim frame.



 Insert the keys supplied with the unit at both sides of the unit as shown in figure until they click. Pulling the keys makes it possible to remove the unit from the dashboard.

The following checklist can help you to solve some problems when using the unit. Please double check and make sure if the connection and the procedure of the operation are proper before using the cheklist below.

Problem	Cause/Solution	
No power.	 Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown, replace with the proper value if necessary. 	
No function when pressing the button.	Press RESET button.	
A CDs cannot be loaded.	 A CDs is loaded in the mechanism. 	
Sound skips.	The CDs is dirty or damaged.	
No Images.	 The Video line from main unit to the TV is not connected properly. 	
lmages skip.	 Improper setting of the color system. Set the color system to "PAL" or "NTSC" according to the connected television.
