
2.1 How to install your Car Kit


Before you use for the first time, please plug the provided car charger into the cigarette lighter to charge the batteries for 6 hours.

After the first time, you can fully charge your low batteries in 4 hours (Fig. 1)









3 How to establish Bluetooth Link with Car Kit 3.1 Pairing with mobile phone (Fig.8)

Before making connection with the mobile phone, a pairing process should be done as follow:


