
What's in the box







1. Place the base station in a central location near the telephone line socket and electricity socket.





Configure your phone (if necessary) After charging your phone for a few minutes, a Welcome screen may appear depending on the country where you live. If the Welcome screen appears:

- I. Press (m) to display a list of countries.
- 2. Scroll () to find your country.
- 3. Press OK to confirm your selection.

Set date and time

- 1. Press in idle mode, scroll (a) to CLOCK/ALARM and press OK, press OK to enter DATE & TIME.
- 2. The last stored date is displayed. Enter the current date (DD/MM) and press OK.
- 3. The last stored time is displayed. Enter the current time (HH:MM) and press (CK to confirm.

A validation tone is emitted and your phone is now ready for use.

Make a call

Dial the number (maximum 24 digits) and press 🕒 key. OR Press 🔍 key to take the line and dial the number (maximum 24 digits). Answer a call When the phone rings, press 🕒 key. End a call To end a conversation, press 🛱 key.

Adjust earpiece volume During a call, press (a) to select from VOLUME I to VOLUME 3.

Set the ring melody

- I. Press we in idle mode, scroll (a) to PERSONAL SET and press WOK, press OK to enter HANDSET TONE, scroll press (menu) OK.
- 2. Scroll () to your desired melody to play the melody.

3. Press OK to set the ring melody.

A validation tone is emitted and the screen returns to previous menu.

Store a contact in the phonebook

- I. Press wey in idle mode, scroll (a) to PHONEBOOK and press OK, press OK to enter ADD NUMBER.
- 2. ENTER NAME is displayed on the screen.
- 3. Enter the name of the contact (maximum 12 characters) and press OK.
- 4. Enter the number (maximum 24 digits) and press OK. A validation tone is emitted

Access the phonebook

- I. Press $\stackrel{\square}{\checkmark}$ in idle mode and scroll $\stackrel{(a)}{\bullet}$ to browse the phonebook.
- 2. To view the details, press 🖨 key.

Switch the handset On/Off

Press and hold 🛞 key for more than 5 seconds to switch on/off the handset in idle mode

Keypad lock/unlock

Press and hold 🔅 key for I second to lock and unlock the keypad in idle mode. Paging

1. Press () key on the base station. All the registered handsets start to ring.

2. Once retrieved, press any key on the handset to end the paging.

Listen to messages recorded on the answering machine (for CD245 only)

Press $(\frac{2}{3})$ on the base station to turn on the answering machine (the LED is turned on).

Press (a) again to turn off the answering machine (the LED is turned off).

Press on the base station to play phone messages (the first recorded message will be played first).

- Press (\bullet) to skip the current message and play the next message.
- Press (I) to go back to the previous message (if pressed within I second of current message playback).
- Press (to replay current message (if pressed after I second of current message playback).
- Press (- +) to adjust speaker volume during message playback.
- Press \mathbf{x} to delete the current message.

Frequently asked questions

Solution

For more information, please refer to the User Manual that came with your phone.

- There's no dialling tone! Check the connections
 - Charge the batteries
 - · Use the line cable provided
- Caller cannot hear me Move closer to the base station clearly!
 - Move the base station at least one metre away from any electrical appliances
 - Move closer to the base station
- displayed on handset and Reset your unit and restart the handset registration
- Calller number is not displayed!
