




- Insert the plug of the power cord into the socket on the bottom of the base station.

- Plug the line cord into the line socket.



Always use rechargeable batteries.



- Place the two rechargeable batteries (included) into the battery compartment.
- Slide the battery door firmly into place.

Only use rechargeable batteries



immediately. Handset may get warm during initial charge. This is normal.

Press $igodot$ and dial the number.	Press 🕑.

Adjust the audio volume while on	line End a call

Set the handset ring melody in standby mode 1. Press and hold (spk) until you see the current melody name. 2. Select the desired melody by pressing digit keys 0 to 9.

Change the ringing volume in standby mode			
1. Press and hold (spk) until you see the current melody name.			

- 2. Press (+) or (-) to increase or decrease the volume level.
- 3. Press (spk) to confirm.

If the ringing volume level is set to OFF, 3 appears.

Save a name and a number in a direct access memory

- 1. Enter the number in standby mode.
- 2. Press and hold one of the direct memory keys (m) or (m₂) or (m₃).
- 3. Enter the name.
- 4. Press and hold the same memory key to save the name.

Save a name and a number in an extra memory

- 1. Enter the number in standby mode.
- 2. Press and hold one of the digit keys (1 to 9).
- 3. Enter the name.
- 4. Press and hold the same digit key to save the name.

To insert a pause press and hold (#), **P** is is shown.

View phonebook memory

Press one of the direct memory keys (m) or (m_2) or (m_3) OR

press and hold one of the digit keys (1 to 9).

The name and number will be shown.

Call from phonebook memory

Press \bigcirc while viewing a memory. The saved number is dialed.

If the number is longer than 12 digits, only the last 12 digits are shown on display.

Troubleshooting

Problem

- No dial tone.
- Poor audio quality.
- No symbol on the display.
- The handset does not charge.
- Caller ID does not display.

Tip

- Check the connections.
- Use the line cord provided in the box.
- Try to place the base station at least one metre away from any electrical appliances.
- Make sure the product is plugged.
- Charge the batteries.
- Check base/charger connections.
- Check that the batteries are inserted correctly.
- Caller ID service may not be activated. Check with your service provider.
