Extra-Loud Alarm Clock

Your RadioShack Extra-Loud Alarm Clock with adjustable alarm volume is an ideal timepiece for your bedroom.

Buzzer Hi/Lo Switch — lets you set the alarm to sound at a very loud or a normal level.

2-Inch Red LED Display — large digits mean the clock is easy to read.



Push Button Operation — makes the clock easy to use.

Snooze Feature — lets you temporarily turn off the alarm for about 9 minutes, so you can get a few extra minutes of sleep.

Battery Backup with Battery Sentinel® — keeps time and sounds the alarm at the set time during a power failure. It also lets you know when the battery needs to be installed or replaced.

Hi/Lo Dimmer — lets you adjust the display to suit the room's lighting.

CONNECTING TO AC POWER

Plug the alarm clock's power cord into a standard AC outlet. The display flashes **12:00** until you set the time (see "Setting the Time" on Page 3).

Your alarm clock requires a 9-volt battery (not supplied) for its back-up power system. For the best performance and longest life, we recommend an alkaline battery, such as RadioShack Cat. No. 23-553.

Caution: Use only a fresh battery of the required size and recommended type.

Note: To prevent unnecessary drain on the battery, install it only after connecting the alarm clock to AC power.

INSTALLING A BACKUP BATTERY

Your alarm clock has a back-up power system that operates the clock and alarm during a power failure. The display turns off, but the clock keeps running for at least 8 hours (depending on battery strength), and the alarm sounds at the alarm time.

The Battery Sentinel indicator, a small red dot at the bottom right of the display, appears if the battery is not installed or needs to be replaced.

1. Push the battery compartment cover in the direction of the arrow and lift off the cover.
2. Snap the alarm clock's battery contacts onto the battery terminals, then put the battery into the compartment. The Battery Sentinel indicator turns off.
3. Replace the cover and slide it in the opposite direction to snap it into place.

Replace the battery when the Battery Sentinel indicator lights.

Warning: Always dispose of an old battery promptly and properly.

SETTING THE DIMMER

Set **DIMMER** to **LO** in low-light conditions, or to **HI** for bright light.

While holding down **TIME**, press **HOUR**. The hour digits advance by 1 with each press. (Hold down **HOUR** to continuously advance the digits.)

Note: The PM indicator appears on the left side of the display during PM hours.

While holding down **TIME**, press **MINUTE**. The minute digits advance by 1 with each press. (Hold down **MINUTE** to continuously advance the digits.)

While holding down **ALARM**, press **HOUR**. The hour digits advance by 1 with each press. (Hold down **HOUR** to continuously advance the digits.)

The PM indicator appears on the left side of the display during PM hours.

While holding down **ALARM**, press **MINUTE**. The minute digits advance by 1 with each press. (Hold down **MINUTE** to continuously advance the digits.)

To display the preset alarm time at any time, press **ALARM**.

Note: You can press **ALARM**, **HOUR**, and **MINUTE** at the same time to set the alarm to 12:00 AM.



WAKING TO THE ALARM

To wake to the alarm, set **ALARM ON/OFF** to **ON**. The ALARM indicator lights. At the preset alarm time, the alarm sounds, then automatically turns off after 1 hour, 59 minutes. To turn the alarm off sooner, slide **ALARM ON/OFF** to **OFF**.

Using Snooze

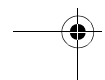
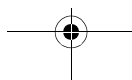
To silence the alarm but have it sound again in about 9 minutes, press **SNOOZE** after the alarm sounds. You can press **SNOOZE** as many times as you like.

If you do not turn off the alarm, it automatically resets to sound at the same time the next day.

Set **BUZZER** to **HI** for an extra-loud alarm or to **LO** for a normal alarm sound level.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To enjoy your RadioShack Extra-Loud Alarm Clock for a long time:

- Keep the clock dry. If it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.
- Handle the clock gently and carefully. Don't drop it.
- Use and store the clock only in normal temperature environments.
- Keep the clock away from dust and dirt.
- Wipe the clock with a damp cloth to keep it looking new.

Modifying or tampering with the clock's internal components can cause a malfunction and might invalidate your clock's warranty. If your clock is not working properly, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance.
