- 3. Click when you finish recording.
- 4. To listen to your recording, click ▶.

- 1. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Sounds and Multimedia.
- 2. Choose the Audio Tab.
- 3. Select the appropriate option in Sound **Playback** to play sound by audio card.
- Click **OK** when finished.

## Sound Recording

1. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Sounds and Multimedia.

- 2. Choose the Audio Tab.
- 3. Select the appropriate option in **Sound** Recording to record.
- 4. Click **OK** when finished.

#### For Windows XP

Go to Start > Control Panel > Sounds and Audio **Devices** > **Audio** > **"Volume"** of sound recording. Select Options > click Advanced Controls. Click Advanced > unselect 1 AGC > Close.
