



Telescoping Antenna — extend for the best FM reception

Note: The AM antenna is built-in. For the best AM reception, rotate the radio.

TUNING — rotate to select your favorite station


FM/AM — switch to select the band

VOLUME — rotate to turn the radio on and off and adjust the volume
