

Please refer to the specification sheet on page 21 for the character of this TV set. Do not break the earth pin of the plug, if the plug can not fit the electrical outlet, please turn to the professional for help.

Please unplug the TV power cord when the following conditions occur:

- --When there is a thunder storm (Please pull out the power cord and antenna)
- --When Cleaning the TV set
- --When the TV set not used for a long time.
- Do not use corrosive depurative when cleaning the TV set.
- Do not put the TV set under direct sunlight or near to the heat.
- Do not put the naked light, for example, the lighting candle or the heater, on the top of or near to the TV set.


Leave plenty of space (at least 1.0cm) around the TV set for ventilation


- Put the TV set away from where it can be ruined by the rain or water, (for example, near the window.)
- Do not put the container with liquid (like a vase) on the top of the TV set.
- Don't move away the TV set when turning on the power.
- Don't touch, push and scratch the surface of TV set with hard stuff.
- When the TV surface is dirty, please use the wetting cotton cloth or soft cloth with non-corrosive cleanser to clean it carefully. Don't use the acetone, toluene or alcohol to clean the TV sets.
- Be careful of the hydrosphere coagulation due to the temperature changing. The coagulated hydrosphere will damage inner electronic components. When the coagulated hydrosphere disappears, the TV screen may appear blur or spot.
- Be sure to ask technicians to install the TV sets on the wall. The incorrect installations will
 put the TV sets into the unsafe situation.
- Don't let the children climb up the TV sets or play near it in order to avoid being spilled from the TV sets or the TV sets damaged the children when falling down.
- Don't hit the panel with hard objects (Such as high-speed football or other objects) to prevent the panel from damages.
- Don't cover the TV sets with quilts or other objects when it is working. Keep the heats dissipate and keep away from the fire.


INSTALLATION

STANDARD INSTALLATION

■ The TV can be installed in various ways such as on a wall, or on a desktop etc.








■The TV is designed to be mounted horizontally.

Ensure that you connect the earth ground wire to prevent possible electric shock. if grounding methods are not possible, have a qualified electrician install a separate circuit breaker.



Do not try to ground the unit by connceting it to telephone wires, lightening rods or gas pipes.

a. Desktop Pedestal Installation


This is the default installation way of the TV.

b. Wall Mount: Horizontal installation

(1) Secure the wall brackets with the bolts(not provided as parts of the product, must purchase separately) on the wall. Match the height of the bracket that is mounted on the wall. The wall bracket is of nomal dimension. Please see the position of the wall brackets bolts as follow picture. The actual dimension of the wall brackts bolt should according to the products.







(2) Remove the table stand of the TV when install the TV on a wall as follow:



(3) For proper ventilation, allow a clearance of 10" on each side from the wall.









NOTES OF WALL INSTALLATION

- (1) Keep the TV stand for may be future use.
- (2) Don't set the TV set on shelves, carpets, beds, or closets.
- (3) Don't cover the TV with curtain or paper.
- (4) Leave ventilation space to avoid the following:



Front/Back panel diagram



- (4) Return to the previously viewed program.
- (5) **CH** +/-: Press to scan through or to select a channel.

Remote Controller

When the DVD menu or system menu display on the

TV screen and wait for selection, press these buttons to select an item in a menu. Moves an enlarged picture up/down/left/right.

Press this button to confirm a selection.




Battery Installation:

Remove the battery compartment lid on the rear of the remote control by sliding the lid down, then off. Put two AAA batteries inside the battery compartment with their + and - ends aligned as indicated. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries Replace the battery compartment lid. Slide the lid until you hear it click into place.

Using the Remote Control:

Unless stated otherwise, the remote control can operate all the features of the TV. Always point the remote control directly at the remote sensor in the front of the TV.


Install and connect TV




Set your TV

To put your TV in a firm place which can bear the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please don't expose the TV near water or heating place (such as light, candle, heating machine), do not block the ventilation at the back of TV.





Turn On TV

3. Press the power button of the TV the indication light will turn to green. If the indicator is in standby mode (thelight is red), press the power button on the remote control or top of the TV.

NOTE Picture for reference purposes only.

Description of Operation

1. Power on/off

After power is connected, press power on/off button, and the power indicator will be on; if the indicator is red, it indicates that the TV set is in the standby state. Press "Power" button on the remote control, and the power indicator will turn green, so the TV set is on. Please disconnect power supply before leaving the TV out of use for an extended period of time.

Note:

- (1) In the TV signal mode, when there is no signal for 5 minutes or more, the TV set will automatically access the standby state. If restart is required, please press "power" button or CH " ∇/Δ " button on the remote control.
 - (2) Try not to repeat switching on/off the unit repeatedly within a short time.

2. Input switching

Press "**Source**" button to select the input signal with the switching sequence as TV - AV (AV1 - AV2) - S-VIDEO - YPBPR - DVD - HDMI - PC

3. Volume control

Press the functional buttons on the panel or "VOL ▲ or VOL ▼" button on the remote control to increase or decrease Volume. The volume control menu will be displayed on the screen.

4. Mute

Press "Mute" button on the remote control to switch off sound, and the mute mark will be displayed on the screen; press "MUTE" button or VOL▲ button once again to cancel mute.

5. Screen display of input signals

Press "DISPLAY" button on the remote control, and the current input signals will be displayed on the screen. In several seconds, such display information will disappear automatically.

6. Sleep timer

Press "SLEEP" button on the remote control to be able to set the waiting time for the TV set to automatically turn to the standby state. The current sleep time will be displayed on the screen (unit: minute); to repeatedly press "SLEEP" button, you can select different times, with the switching sequence as:

7. Picture mode

Press "P.MODE" picture mode button on the remote control to be able to select from different picture modes, at the sequence of Normal – Soft – Dynamic – User.

8. Fast review

While watching TV, press "RECALL" button on the remote control to be able to return to the TV program you previously watched. If you select no other program after the unit is switched on, it will be invalid to press this button.

9. Operation menu

This TV set allows you to adjust any settings by selecting from the menu screens. *Menu button*



Press this button to display main menu, including **Picture**, **Sound**, **OSD**, **Function**, **Channel** menu. You can select them by pressing the "◀ / ▶" buttons, and enter the submenu by pressing "▲ / ▼" key. The selected item will change to highlight colour. Press Menu to exit sub-menu.

Picture menu



When the source input is "TV", "AV", "S-Video", "YPbPr", or "HDMI", the **Picture** menu appears . You can choose **Contrast,Brightness,Tint**, **Sharpness** and **Tint**(in NTSC system) items by pressing "▲/▼" Buttons. You can adjust the item selected by pressing "◄/▶".

In **Color Temp.** item: you can switch between items as "Normal", "Warm", "Cool"

In **PICTURE MODE** item: you can choose "Normal", "Soft", "Dynamic", "User".

In ASPECT item: you can choose "16:9", "4:3".

SOUND



Enter this menu, you can select **Bass, Treble, Balance, Sound Mode** and **AVC** items by pressing

"▲ / ▼" Buttons. you can adjust the item selected by pressing "◄/▶".

In **Sound Mode** item: you can switch between items as following.

Normal-----News-----Music-----User

In AVC item: you can switch between On and Off.

TUNE menu





In this menu you can complete the tune function. Select the Auto Scan item and press "◀ / ▶" button to begin search program. After finished search, the program will go to Channel NO.1. The picture will appear and the sound will be out.

1 Channel

You can select the channel by pressing "◀ / ▶" button.

2. Auto Scan

Press "◀ / ▶" button to start search program automatically from V-L to UHF, the searched program will be stored orderly.

3. Add / Erase

Channel No. is available when this item is set to Add.

4. Source

In this item, you can set source amount Air, CATV-STD, CATV-IRC, CATV-HRC.

FUNCTION menu





Enter this menu, you can select **Sleep Timer**, **Advance**, **Subtitles**, **Parent Control** items by pressing "▲ / ▼" buttons.

1. In **Sleep Timer** item, You can select different times, with the switching sequence as:

While you select **Parent Control** item in **Function** menu, the correct password is needed to enter the sub menu. Usually, the default key is the num "0000". Once you input correct password.

Change Password item: select this item to enter Change password menu.

V-CHIP item: switch between On and Off.

Change Password



Change password menu:enter new password then press Enter button to enter confirm item.

Osd menu



Enter this menu, you can select OSD Language, OSD H-Position / OSD V-Position and Duration items by pressing "▲ / ▼" buttons.

Language item: You can select different language displayed on OSD.

H-position item: Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the OSD Horizontal position.

V-position item: Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the OSD Vertical position.

Duration item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select duration item , press" ◀ / ▶" button to adjust the duration of menu.

Halftone item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select halftone item, press "◀ / ▶" button to adjust the halftone of menu.

Memory Recall item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select halftone item, press "◀ / ▶" button and reset to default setting automatically.

PC menu



Specially when you set the source input as "PC", the first Menu Page will appears, named PC menu . You can choose **Brightness**, **Contrast** items by pressing "▲ / ▼" Buttons. You can adjust the item selected by pressing "◀/▶".

1. In **Aspect** item: Press "◀/▶" button to adjust the aspect of picture, which can choose "**16: 9**" or "**4:3**" modes.

Color TEMP




Color Temp menu: Press "◀/▶" button to select the Color.Temp item , which can choose "NORMAL , WARM, COOL, USER" modes.

User-R: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust red of picture.

User-G: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust green of picture.

User-B: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust blue of picture.

Geometry



This menu is only for PC monitor mode (VGA input).

1. H-Position / V-Position

Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the picture Horizontal and Vertical position.

2. Clock

Press the "◀ / ▶" to adjust the sampling ratio of picture. It can affect the display size of picture.

3. **Phase**

When necessary, you can adjust the sampling phase of picture. It can make the picture clear.

4. Auto Adjust

Select auto Adjust to adjust the screen position automatically. It will take a few seconds.

Note:

- **1.** If the set is cold, there may be a small "flicker" when the set is switched on. It is normal. There is nothing wrong with the set.
- **2.** Some dot defects may appear on the screen, like red. green or blue. Spots, However, this will have no impact or effect on the monitor performance.
- **3.** Do not press the LCD screen with your finger for a long time as it may incur some damage to the screen.

Overview of Remote Control

DVD Mode

Press the DVD Setup button to activate the DVD player OSD menu, the DVD setting menu by the romote control the bottom section arrow buttons and ENTER button. press the Left/Right arrow buttons to move between the different sub-menus; press the Up/Down arrow buttons to highlight the prefered option confirm with the D.ENTER button. Press the DVD setup button to exit the OSD menu.

When in DVD mode, use the arrows in the bottom section of the remote to operate the menus etc.

EJECT BUTTON(▲)

Press the OPEN/CLOSE button whenthe power is on the disc will eject. Put the disc in the slot slightly, with the data side facing towards you. Press OPEN /CLOSE button again the disc is pulled in automatically, and the unit starts playing automatically (Without auto play function for JPEG discs).

MENU/PBC BUTTON

Press MENU/PBC button and the screen will display "Root Menu" select item according to your preference. (This button is valid to DVD disc possessing multilayer Menu). PBC button lets you play Video CDs,interactiv-ely. If PBC is on, you can use the number buttons to select tracks in the menu. If PBC is off, you can select the tracks directly.

AUDIO BUTTON

When play DVD, by pressing this button, you can change the audio language from the one selected at the initial settings to a different language, available.

REPEAT BUTTON

Press the REPEAT button one time, it repeats the chapter. Press it again and it repeats all chapters of the disc. Press REPEAT button one more time and the repeat function cancels.

A-B REPEAT BUTTON

Press the A-B button once to set point A Press . the A-B button a second time to set point B. After setting the program repeat playing from A to B. Pressing the A-B button a third time will cancel the repeat.

TITLE BUTTON

Press TITLE button, there will have an screen indication "TITLE"

Press the direction or numeric buttons to select your favourite title. Will play from the first chapter of the selected title.(for DVD disc only)

D.ENTER: Validation key. (bottom section of D.ENTER button for DVD function only)

ARROW BUTTONS (◀/►/▲/▼):Use to move cursor up/down/left/right. (direction buttons of bottom section for DVD function only)

SUBTITLE: This function may enable you to select multi subtitle languages (as many as 32 kinds only for the discs with multi subtitles encoded). Press the SUBTITLE button to get desired display.

DISP: Press DISP buttom to show the the information of the DVD player.

GO TO BUTTON

Press this button to go to desired position . The player provides 3 search mode.



On the remote control, the bottom section ARROW BUTTONS (◄/►/▲/▼):Up and down buttons of the OSD menu, to change the OSD menu items; Left and right buttons of the OSD menu, to select the OSD menu items. (only for DVD function)

When the above items are showed on LCD screen, you can input numbers to locate desired sector.

The number you input is invalid if it is beyond the track's capacity.

PLAY AND PAUSE BUTTON(►/।)

Press this button to start playback. Press this button again to pause playback.

STOP BUTTON(■)

Press STOP button once to stop. Press ▶I button to resume from where you stopped.

Press STOP button Twice to stop. Press Nutton to start from beginning. In order to protect the disc, press STOP button then press OPEN/CLOSE button to take the disc out. When the disc is ejected, hold the disc edge to prevent scratches.

When not using the DVD function (in standby mode or using others modes for a long time), please take out the disc to protect the DVD loader and the disc.

PREV/NEXT BUTTON(I◄◄/▶►I)

When playing a DVD disc, press PREV to play the previous chapter. when playing a SVCD, VCD, CD disc, press PREV to play the previous track.

When playing a DVD disc, press NEXT to play, the next chapter. when playing a SVCD, CD disc, press NEXT to PLAY the next track.

REV/FWD BUTTON(◄◄/►►)

To Use Fast Forward or Fast Reverse:


- When playing a DVD, press FWD buuton to fast forward through the disc. Press REV button to fast reverse through the disc.
- 2. Press PLAY button to resume normal playback.

SETUP BUTTON

Press this button to get the setup menu . you can select the setting as you like .

PROGRAM

1. In DVD Mode, press PROG to enter programming and the TV will display as follows:



Use number key enter the title No. and the cursor will move to the chapter, enter the chapter No. by press number key again

Select "Start" and press D.ENTER to play programmed chapter

Select "Next" and press D.ENTER to turn to next page

Select "Exit" and press D.ENTER to quit program

2. In CD,VCD and SVCD play mode, press PROG to enter programming and the TV will display as follows:



Use number key enter the track No. and Select "Star" and press to play programmed chapter to play programmed track Select "Next" and press D.ENTER to turn to next page

Select "Exit" and press D.ENTER to guit program

For VCD、SVCD、DVD discs, it can program 20 items mostly, when finish the first 10 programs please move the cursor to "Next" and press D.ENTER to turn to next page, please go ahead to program. If you want to change the programmed items please move the cursor to that item and use direction key to move to the location where you want to amend, enter the correct track No. Title No. or Chapter No.

- ◆The track No., Title No. or Chapter No. might be different as per different discs.
- ◆Please enter valid track No., Title No. or Chapter No. when programming.


ZOOM

Press ZOOM to view different kindly of zoomed pictures.


Each time the when press ZOOM, it can be viewed 2X、3X and 4X zoomed pictures. You can move, enjoy the parts of the picture when the picture zoom in.

ANGLE OF CHOICE

Press "ANGLE" then you can enjoy the picture with different angle when you play multi-angle picture. Multi-angle means that take a photo from different scene. as follows:

DVD Setup Menu Interface Function

General Settings page



 TV Shape: Set the ratio of output to the television signal options are: Normal/ PS, Normal/LB, Wide 16:9, the current default settings is Wide 16:9

Note:

1. Normal/PS

Normal Pan and Scan is used for most normal television broadcasts and it is the default setting. It has an aspect ration of 4:3. If you select this setting when viewing a DVD the picture will fill the screen, but you will not see the left and right edges of the picture.

2. Normal/LB

Normal Letter Box will show the DVD in its original aspect ratio so depending on the size of your television screen you may see black borders above and below the picture.

3. Wide 16:9

Choose this setting if you have a widescreen television.

4. The DVD must be stopped when setting system.

- 2. OSD Lang: Set the OSD language options.
- 3. Save the last set to open with the related options are: On/ Off.

If this function is enabled, it allows you to continue the playback of a film (DVD) even after switching off or remove of a disk. The player stores all settings like play position or used language and continues playback with these settings after the disk is reinserted.

This function will be enabled or disabled via the setup-menu of the DVD-player.

Audio Setup Page



STEREO: Select this to set the sound output to Stereo mode.

Preference Setup Pages





1. TV Type: This product supports output of various system, including Multi, NTSC, PAL.

PAL: Choose this settings if your DVD player is connected to a PAL TV. The default setting is NTSC. Choose this settings if your DVD player is conn -ected to a NTSC TV. Multi: Choose this settings if your DVD player is connected to a multi-system TV.

For more information of output format, refer to the instruction of your DVD player.



 Subtitle: This player provides English etc. languages as the built-in subtitle language, when playing DVD, user may hide the subtitle or choose any of them as the present subtitle language.

 Parental: Playback for discs with rating, you can select the rating setting according to your p reference. Rating restriction is divided in eight different categories from KID SAFE to ADULT. Notes: Only editable when password is unlocked. Can only function when password is locked. It does not, however, reset either the Password or the PARENTAL setting.

Video disc contains high-density compressed data that needs proper handling.

- 1. Hold the disc with fingers by outer edge and/or the center spindle hole. Do not touch the discs surface.
- 2.Do not bend or press the disc.







3.Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or heating sources, Stere discs in cabinet vertically, and in dry condition.

Prevent exposure to:

Direct sunlight

Heat or exhaust from a heating device

Extreme humidity

Clean the disc surface with a soft, dry cleaning cloth, Wipe the disc surface gently and radically from center toward the outer edge.

Do not apply thinner, alcohol, chemical solvent, or sprays when cleaning. Such cleaning fluids will permanently damage the disc surface.
