IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Keep the cord away from the heated surfaces. Do not wrap the cord around the appliance.
- Never use while sleeping.
- Never drop or insert any object into any of the appliance's openings.
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used, or where oxygen is being administered.
- Do not use an extension cord.
- This appliance is hot when in use. Do not let eyes or bare skin touch heated surfaces.

- Do not place the heated unit directly on any surface while it is hot or plugged in.
- The plug on this appliance has one blade wider than the other, it is a polarized plug. As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit contact a qualified electrician.
- Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.
- Always store this appliance and cord in a moisture-free area. Do not store it in temperatures exceeding 140°F (60°C).
- This appliance is for household use only.
- Do not plug or unplug this appliance when your hands are wet.



This styler is equipped with automatic shutoff. This safety feature turns the unit off after 60 minutes, in case you accidentally leave it on after styling your hair.

- (A) Teflon® plus black ceramic coating
- (B) Ionic conditioning
- (C) ON/OFF switch
- (D) Swivel cord
- (E) Closing lock



Usage Tips

Straightening Your Hair

- 1. Hair should be dry and free of tangles before using the straightening iron.
- Plug the straightener into an electrical outlet. Slide the ON/OFF switch to the ON position. The ready light will glow.
- Divide hair into manageable sections and clip the upper layers on top of your head and out of the way. Work with underneath layers first.
- Take a small section of hair and pull hair down and away from your scalp, and hold it taut.
- 5. Starting at the roots, clamp hair firmly between the plates and run the styler down the entire hair strand, from root to tip, in one smooth stroke. Do not hold it in one area for a long period of time.
- Repeat with all sections of your hair, working with the underneath layers first, then the top and sides.
- When you are finished styling, slide the ON/OFF button to turn the unit off, unplug it, and allow it to cool before storing.

How to Use

Folding for Storage

- Allow the iron to cool before folding.
 Flip the closing lock and press until it
- clicks to lock the iron closed.

 3. Press the two swivel hinge buttons with one hand while rotating the handle to fold the styler in half.
- Insert the folded styler hinge end first into the storage pouch, leaving the cord <u>outside</u> the pouch. Press the pouch opening closed.
- Loop the cord loosely and secure to the outside of the pouch with the attached Velcro strap.

Closing Lock

This professional flat iron has a closing lock to make the unit easier to store. To lock the iron, simply squeeze the plates together and flip the switch down to the locked position. To unlock, flip the switch up in to the unlocked position. NOTE: Do not heat the unit in the locked position.

Maintenance

Cleaning

Make sure the unit is unplugged and cool. Use a damp cloth to clean the plates and the outside of the power handle. No other maintenance of the unit is required.

Storage

Unplug the unit whenever it is not in use.

Never wrap the cord around the appliance, since this will cause the cord to wear prematurely and break, thus voiding warranty. Handle the cord carefully and avoid jerking, twisting, or straining it, especially at plug connections.
