Welcome to the *Operation and Installation Guide* for the Rosen R5500-series DVD Player. The Rosen DVD Player is designed to provide you with flexibility. It can be used as a component of your vehicle or home entertainment system.

This manual will guide you through the operation and installation of the following Rosen DVD players:

- R5500 DVD player with TV tuner
- R5501 DVD player without TV tuner
- R5502 DVD player with AC adaptor (no TV tuner)

OPERATING THE DVD PLAYER

Precautions

- Use this DVD player only after proper installation by a qualified installer.
- If the internal temperature of the vehicle is extremely high, allow a short cooling down period before operating the unit.
- If the unit shows signs of overheating or malfunction, power off the unit and consult your dealer immediately.
- Do not open the unit; there are no serviceable parts inside.

Switching On

Use the DVD player when your vehicle is running or the ignition switch is in the "accessory" position.

To avoid a dead battery, do not use the DVD player for long periods of time without the engine running.

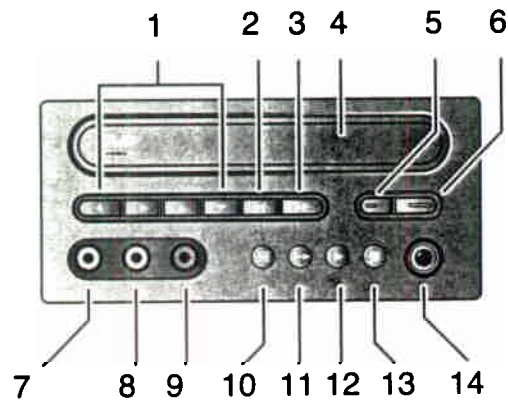
What You Can Play

This unit is designed for use with DVD, VCD, CD, CD-R, and CD-RW with MP3 or MPEG-1 file recordings. Functions will vary depending on the features available on the disc you are playing.

Note: LDs are not compatible.

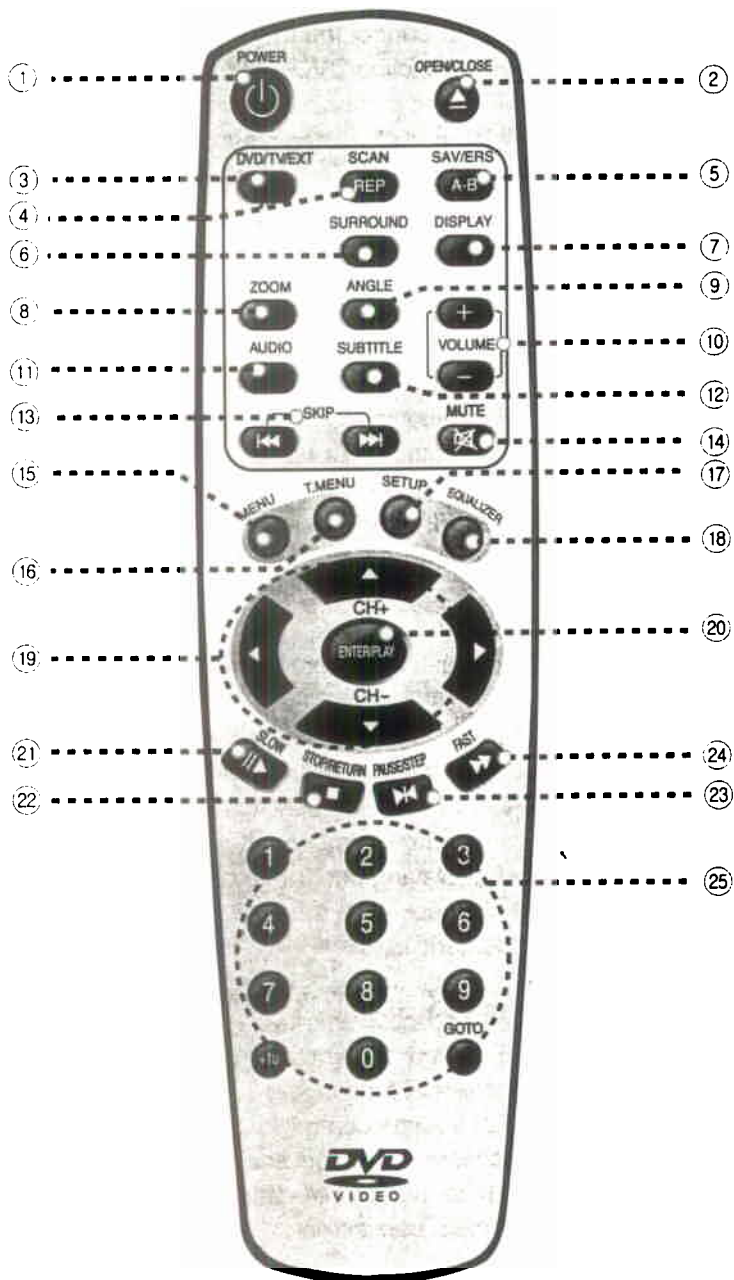
Front Panel Controls

Backlighting on the front panel controls indicate when power is on.



- 1 Arrow buttons—Highlight selections.
- 2 Previous track—Select previous chapter, title, or track.
- 3 Next track—Selects next chapter, title, or CD track.
- 4 Front door
- 5 Power—Powers the system on and off.
- 6 Eject—Ejects a disc.
- 7 Aux input—Video input, yellow.
- 8 Aux input—Left channel audio input, white.
- 9 Aux input—Right channel audio input, red.
- 10 Menu—Accesses main menu (DVDs only).
- 11 Enter—Confirms a selection.
- 12 Play—Begins or resumes playback.
- 13 Stop—Stops playback.
- 14 Internal infrared sensor—Activates the remote control (performs the same function as the remote "eye" sensor.)

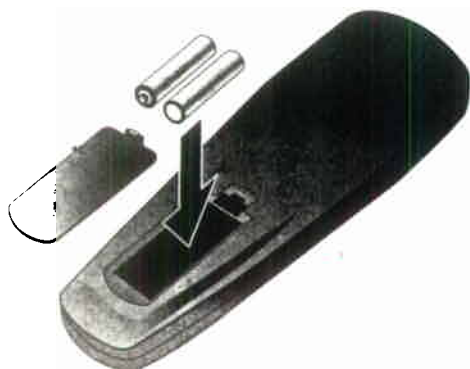
Remote Control Buttons

- 1 POWER - On/Off
- 2 OPEN/CLOSE - For control the tray
- 3 DVD/TV/EXT - For selecting DVD, TV or External input
- 4 REPEAT - For repeated playback of disc title, chapter, track
- 5 A-B - For specifying and repeating playback of a section
- 6 SURROUND - For stereophonic sound effect .
- 7 DISPLAY - For checking the current disk status
- 8 ZOOM - For magnifying the screen .
- 9 ANGLE - For viewing with a different frame angle
- 10 VOLUME - For volume control in a CD or VCD
- 11 AUDIO - For selecting the audio language
- 12 SUBTITLE - For selecting the subtitle language .
- 13 NEXT/PREV - For skipping to the next previous chapter of track
- 14 MUTE - For volume mute on or off.
- 15 MENU - For displaying the menu contained in the disc
- 16 T.MENU - For displaying the title menu contained in the disc .
- 17 SETUP - For initial user setting.
- 18 EQUALIZER - For equalizer function on or off and/or graphic mode display
- 19 UP,DOWN } For selecting item on menu or

Replacing the Batteries



Battery life is approximately six months depending on how often the remote is used. Use the two size-AAA batteries. Replace both batteries at the same time.

To avoid damage from battery leakage and subsequent corrosion:

- Insert the batteries matching the "+" and "-" on the batteries to the "+" and "-" in the battery compartment.
- Do not use an old battery with a new one, or different brands of batteries together.
- Remove the batteries when the unit is not being used for long periods of time.
- DO NOT charge the batteries.

If battery leakage occurs, replace all the batteries with new ones after cleaning the battery compartment.

Using the Remote Control

When using the remote control, always aim at the remote infrared "eye" sensor or the internal infrared sensor on the front panel.

This unit is designed for use with DVD, VCD, CD, CD-R, and CD-RW, and with MP3 or MPEG-1 file recordings. Functions on the remote control will vary depending on the features available on the disc you are playing. If a function is unavailable on the inserted CD, VCD, or DVD, the following symbol appears on the on-screen display:



If a disc is incompatible with the unit or if the disc is loaded incorrectly, you may see one of the following on the on-screen display:

- "No disc" - Check to see that the disc is loaded with the **label side up**.
- "Smart navigation" screen - The DVD player may be trying to read an incompatible disc. Check disc compatibility.
- Another error message indicating the disc is either incompatible or loaded incorrectly.

BASIC FUNCTIONS

Inserting or Ejecting Discs

Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to insert or eject a disc.

Playback

To play a disc:

- 1 Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the DVD player.
- 2 Load the disc **with the label side up**.
- 3 Press **OPEN/CLOSE** again.
"Disc loading" appears on the on-screen display. The disc commences playback automatically.

Note: DVD playback varies from disc to disc. Options include:

- DVD playback begins automatically when you insert the disc.
- DVD playback begins automatically, but proceeds only until a menu of options appears. To continue playback, highlight an option using the arrow buttons then press **PLAY/ENTER** on the remote control.
- The DVD displays a menu of options before proceeding. To continue, highlight an option using the arrow buttons then press **PLAY/ENTER** on the remote control.

Stop

- 1 Press the **STOP** button to stop playback. The DVD player saves in internal memory the exact position where it stopped and will playback again from that position.
- 2 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to resume normal playback.

Note: For some VCDs, the Stop function can be enabled by pressing the **NEXT** button.

Pause

- 1 Press the **PAUSE** button to pause playback of the disc.
- 2 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to resume playback.

Mute

- 1 Press the **MUTE** button once to mute the sound.
"Mute" appears on the monitor.
- 2 Press **MUTE** again to restore sound.

Volume Up/Down

For audio CDs and VCDs:

- Press the **VOLUME +/-** buttons on the remote control to adjust the audio.

For DVDs:

- Adjust volume using the amplifier or the TV volume controls.

Adjusting Stereo Sound

Stereo sound is available when "Audio Setup" is set to 2CH. To access "Audio Setup" press the **SETUP** button. See "Advanced Functions" for additional information.

To adjust stereo sound:

Press the **3D** button on the remote control repeatedly to toggle stereo sound on and off. The following options appear:



Non-stereo sound.



Stereo sound. Press **3D** to increase volume.

Graphic Equalizer

- 1 Press the **EQUALIZER** button.
(Graph appears in the upper part of the screen)
- 2 Press Enter Button to choose the desired preset equalizer.
(personal, standard, classic, jazz, rock pops, ballad, dance)
- 3 Press the **EQUALIZER** button.
(Graphic motion appears on the upper part of the screen)

- 4 Pressing EQUALIZER button one more time would make the graphic bar disappear while have the equalizer function on.
- 5 Pressing EQUALIZER button once more would terminate the function.

Note: Setting the preset equalizer on "personal" allows user to personalize the setting through using the up,down, right, and left buttons.

Fast Forward and Reverse Searching

- 1 Press the **FAST** button during playback to fast forward. "FF 2x" appears on the monitor.
- 2 Press the right and left arrow buttons to adjust the direction and speed of the search. Options include 2x, 4x, 6x, 8x, 12x, 16x, 32x, and 64x.
- 3 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to resume regular play.

Slow Forward and Reverse Searching

- 1 Press the **SLOW** button during playback to slow forward. "SF 2x" appears on the monitor.
- 2 Press the right and left arrow buttons to adjust the direction and speed of the search. Options include 1/2x, 1/4x, 1/8x, and 1/16x.
- 3 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to resume regular play.

Note: Slow forward is not an option when playing audio CDs.

Searching One Scene or Track at a Time

- 1 Press the **PAUSE** button to pause playback of the disc.
- 2 Set the direction of the scene-by-scene search by using the right or left arrow button.
- 3 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to resume regular play.

Searching by Chapter or Track Number

To search a VCD or DVD:

- 1 Press the **GOTO** button. "Title x/y Chapter x/y" appears.
- 2 Press the left and right arrow buttons to highlight the current title or chapter.
- 3 Use the numeric keys to input the desired title or chapter and press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection.

Note: You can also use the numeric keys to enter the desired track without entering Search mode.

To search an audio or MP3 CD:

- 1 Press the **GOTO** button.
"GOTO --:--" appears.
- 2 Use the numeric keys to enter the desired track number.
Press the **PLAY/ENTER** button to play the selected track.

Note: You can also use the numeric keys to enter the desired track without entering Search mode.

Searching by Next or Previous Chapter or Track

- Press the **NEXT** button during playback to skip forward to the next track or to the next title/chapter.

For VCDs and DVDS- "Chapter x/y" appears on the monitor, where x is the current chapter and y is the total number of chapters.

For audio CDs - "Next" appears on the monitor.

Note: For MP3 discs, if the disc is stopped, press the up and down arrows instead of the **NEXT** or **PREVIOUS** buttons to select a song.

- Press the **PREVIOUS** button during playback to skip backward to the previous track or to the previous title/chapter.

For VCDs and DVDS- "Chapter x/y" appears on the monitor, where x is the current chapter and y is the total number of chapters.

For audio CDs- "Previous" appears on the monitor.

Repeating a Track or Chapter

The DVD player will repeat a track or chapter, or an audio disc.

Press the **REP** button on the remote control to cycle through the following on-screen display options.

For DVDs:

- "Chapter repeat on"- The current chapter will be repeated.
- "Title repeat on"- The current title will be repeated.
- "Repeat off"- Repeat mode is off.

For audio/video CDs:

- "Rep one"- The current track will be repeated.
- "Rep all"- The current disc will be repeated.
- "Repeat off"- Repeat mode is off.

Note: For MP3 CDs, press the **REP** button to change the play mode.

Repeating a Section of Your Choice

The **A-B** function allows you to specify and repeat playback of a section.

To specify and repeat a section:

- 1 Press the **A-B** button on the remote control ("A to B set A" appears) to select the beginning of the section to be repeated.
- 2 Press the **A-B** button again ("A to B A-B repeat" appears) at the end of the section you wish to repeat.
- 3 The section repeats until you press the **A-B** button and select "A to B cancelled".

ADVANCED FUNCTIONS

Customize Settings

Use the Setup menu to personalize operation of your DVD player. Setup includes options for various Language, Display, Audio, and Parental Control features. The features are described below.

- 1 Press the **SETUP** button. The Setup menu appears.
- 2 Use the arrow keys to highlight your selection and press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection.
- 3 Press **SETUP** again to begin playback.

Language Setup

- "OSD Language"- Selects language used in Setup menu.
- "Audio"- Selects the language of DVD audio.
- "Subtitle"- Selects the caption language.
- "Disc menu"- Selects the DVD menu language.

Note: Audio, Subtitle, and Disc menu can only be adjusted when playback is stopped.

Display Setup

- "TV display"-
 - "Pan & Scan": When viewing a 16:9 image on a 4:3 screen the sides are cropped.
 - "Letter Box": When viewing a 16:9 image on a 4:3 screen, a black bar appears on the top and bottom of the screen and the complete image is shown.
 - "Wide": Use when connecting to a wide-screen TV.
- "TV type"-
 - "Multi": Outputs the original PAL or NTSC signal recorded into the title. Select this option only when the TV supports both PAL and NTSC.
 - "NTSC": Changes image signal to NTSC.
 - "PAL": Changes image signal to PAL.

- "Pic mode"-
"Auto": Automatically adjusts screen.
"Hi-resolution": Enhances screen image.
"Anti-flicker": Prevents screen trembling.
- "Angle mark"- When playing DVDs that can be viewed from different angles, a camera icon appears on the upper part of the screen.
- "Captions"- Turns on or off subtitles.
- "Screen saver"- Activates screen saver after 10 minutes of inactivity. After 1 hour the DVD Tuner enters stand-by mode.

Audio Setup

- "Digital out"- Adjusts the output for the digital audio terminal.
- "Dynamic range"- Dolby Digital sound. Use when it is difficult to hear dialogues through the stereo or TV. This feature is only supported by DVD titles with DRC properties.
- "Downmix"- Controls stereo and two channel audio.
"2CH": Select for two channel audio.
"LT/RT": Select when the amplifier has Dolby Pro Logic support.
"Stereo": Select when listening to general stereo sound.
"VSS (Virtual Surround System)": Select when listening through VSS.

Parental Control

- "Parental"- If the current disc has a parental code, it is possible to skip or substitute various scenes not suitable for young children.
- "Password"- Create and change password necessary for parental control feature.
- "Default"- Returns DVD player to default settings. The user must know the current password to do so.

The Parental Control feature interacts with the DVD rating, if available, to enable parents to limit DVD playback.

To access the rating system:

- 1 Press the **SETUP** button. The Setup menu appears.
- 2 Use the up and down arrows to highlight "Parental Control" on the on-screen display and press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection.
- 3 To set a parental control level, press the right arrow and then use the up and down arrows to highlight the desired level of control.
- 4 Press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection. "Input pwd" appears, prompting you to enter a password.
- 5 Enter a Four -digit password and press **PLAY/ENTER** to confirm your selection.
- 7 Press **SETUP** to exit the Setup menu and begin playback.

DVD Menus

Most DVD discs have unique menu structures. DVD menu contents and operation may differ from disc to disc.

To use DVD menus:

- 1 During DVD playback, press the **MENU** button. The DVD menu available on the disc appears in the monitor.
- 2 Use the up, down, left and right arrows to select the preferred menu option.
- 3 Press **PLAY/ENTER** when the desired option is selected.

Title Menu

Some DVD discs also include more than one title.

To change titles:

- 1 During DVD playback, press the **T.MENU** button. A list of the titles available on the DVD appears in the monitor.

- 2 Use the up, down, left and right arrows to select a title.
- 3 Press the **PLAY/ENTER** button when the desired option is selected.

Display Menu

The **DISPLAY** function enables you to view the status, current title number, track number and the total playing time of the disc on the monitor.

To display status information for VCDs and DVDs:

Press the **DISPLAY** button repeatedly to cycle through the following information on the monitor:

- "Title x/y and Chapter x/y"- Title elapsed time, where x is the current chapter or title and y is the total number of chapters or titles.
- "Title remain"- Title remaining time.
- "Chapter elapsed"- Chapter elapsed time.
- "Chapter remain"- Chapter remaining time.

To display status information for audio CDs:

Press the **DISPLAY** button repeatedly to cycle through the following information:

- "Single elapsed"- Track time.

- "Single remain"- Track remaining time.
- "Total elapsed"- Disc time.
- "Total remain"- Disc remaining time.
- Display off.

Viewing Options

Camera Angle

Some DVD discs contain scenes with more than one viewing angle. For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from a different angle by using the **ANGLE** button on the remote control.

To view a scene from another angle:

- 1 During DVD playback, press the **ANGLE** button. "ANGLE x/y" appears in the monitor, where x represents the current camera angle and y represents the total available camera angles.
- 2 Press the **ANGLE** button again to cycle through all available camera angles until the preferred angle is selected.

Note: This function is only available on DVDs that contain multiple viewing angles.

Zoom

Some DVD discs contain a zoom option. For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from different magnifications by using the **ZOOM** button on the remote control.

- 1 Press the **ZOOM** button during playback to toggle between the following options: x1.5, x2, and x4.
- 2 Press the arrow buttons to shift the magnified section of the screen.
- 3 Press **ZOOM** until "Zoom off" appears to resume normal playback.

Language Support Options

Some DVDs offer a variety of language options for DVD audio, DVD menu text, and DVD subtitles. Features vary depending on the DVD you are viewing.

If DVDs and VCDs contain multiple audio tracks, the same video can be viewed with different audio.

To change the audio on a DVD:

- 1 During DVD playback, press the **AUDIO** button on the remote control.

"AUDIO x/y" appears in the monitor, where x represents the current audio stream and y represents the total available audio streams.

- 2 Press the **AUDIO** button to cycle through all available audio streams until the preferred audio is selected.

To change the audio on a VCD:

- During VCD playback, press the **AUDIO** button until the desired audio is selected.

Subtitle Language (DVD)

Some DVDs include subtitles in one or more languages.

To change subtitles to a different language:

- Press the **SUB.T** button on the remote control to cycle through the following on-screen display options: "Subtitle off" and "Subtitle x/y: language" where x represents the current subtitle, y represents the total available subtitles, and language shows the subtitle language.

Note: In some cases, the subtitle change is not immediate.

SPECIAL FEATURES FOR DVD PLAYER WITH TV TUNER (MODEL 5500)

Using the TV and External Modes (CD/VCD/DVD)

Note: If the on-screen display is not visible on the TV, press the **SUB.T** button.

Press the **DVD/TV/EXT** button on the remote control to toggle between DVD, TV, and EXTERNAL modes. The following options appear on the on-screen display:

- "DVD Mode"- Use when playing DVD or CDs.
- "TV Mode"- Use when watching television.
- "External Mode"- Use when playing video games, camcorders, or other external video units.

Note: When playing a DVD using DVD players without the TV tuner (models 5501 and 5502), the **DVD/TV/EXT** button toggles between playback and pause.

Searching for TV Channels

- Press **PLAY/ENTER** to show channel information.
- When no channels are stored, use the number keys to select channels.
- Press the **REP** button (SCAN-CH) and then press the left or right arrow button to conduct an automatic channel search.
- If channels are stored, press the up and down arrow buttons to search for stored channels.

Save/Delete Channels

- Press the **A-B** button (SAV/ERS) to save/erase a channel.

Clear Screen

- Press the **SUB.T** button to view the on-screen display.
- Press again to clear the screen.

USING GAMES AND CAMCORDERS

You may use video games, camcorders, and other portable video units by connecting the unit to the color-coded auxiliary inputs located on the front panel.



Auxiliary inputs

- Right channel audio input - red.
- Left channel audio input - white.
- Video input - yellow.

To switch between DVD and other video sources, press **DVD/TV/EXT** on the remote control.

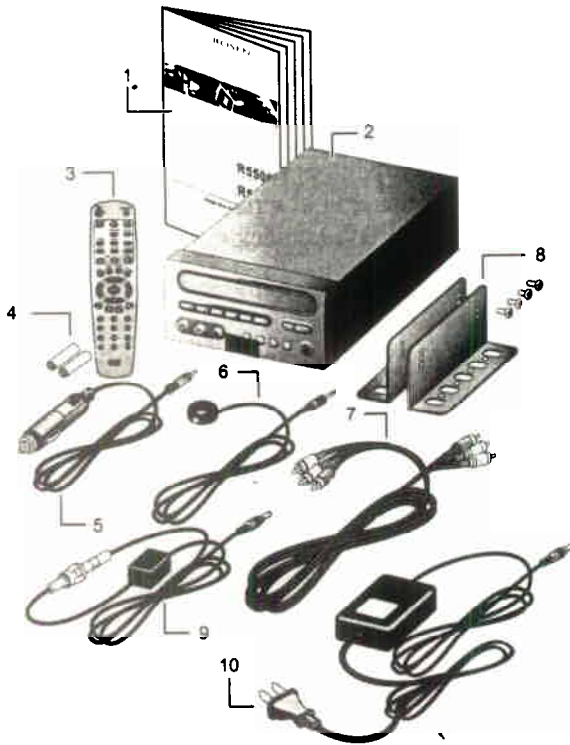

Mounting the DVD Player

Use the correct fasteners and connecting cables during installation to avoid possible product damage, electrical short-circuits, and risk of fire. This product was designed to be installed horizontally or vertically.

- 1 Select the desired location and position for the DVD player.

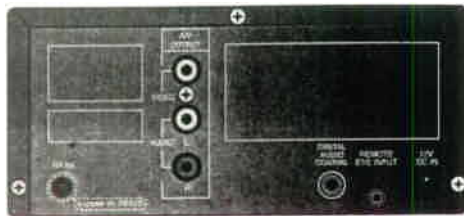
Note: Do not install this product in a position that may interfere with safety restraints or standard operation of the vehicle. Do not install this unit in a position that may cause injuries to passengers during an accident.

- 2 Attach the mounting brackets to the DVD player using the four screws supplied.



- 3 Attach the DVD player to the vehicle or home location.

Connecting the Cables and Remote Eye Sensor



- 1 Connect the audio/video cable to the audio/video outputs on the back of the DVD player and to your desired device(s).

Connection to a monitor/TV only: Attach all three audio/video connectors to the TV audio/video terminals. If there is only one TV audio input terminal, connect to either L1 or R1.

Connection to TV and Amplifier: Attach the white and red audio connectors to the amplifier's audio input terminals and the yellow video connector to the video input terminal on the TV.

Connection to TV and Dolby Pro Logic support amplifier: Attach the white and red audio connectors to the Dolby Pro Logic support amplifier's audio input terminals and the yellow video connector to the video input terminal on the TV.

Connection to TV and Dolby Digital support amplifier: Attach the digital audio coaxial cable to the support amplifier terminal (and DVD player) and attach the yellow video connector to the video input terminal on the TV.

- 2 Connect the remote eye sensor (optional). Peel the adhesive tape off the sensor and stick the sensor in an easy-to-use location for operating the remote control, such as near or on the monitor.

- 3 *For R5500 DVD Player with TV Tuner Only:* Connect the TV tuner antenna cable (not included) to the DVD player and TV tuner.
- 4 Connect the power cable.

For in-car use: Connect the 12-Volt DC power connector to the DVD player and the cigarette lighter in your automobile dash.

For in-home use: Use the optional AC adapter.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Power

- Check the power cord.
- Check the remote control batteries.

Disc Will Not Play

- Check disc is loaded **label side up**.
- Check if the disc has parental control viewing restrictions.
- Check that the disc has the applicable regional code. The region number on the disc must correspond to the region number of the DVD player.
- Check if the disc is compatible.
- Check whether the DVD player has been affected by adverse environmental conditions such as condensation or heat. If so, wait for 1 hour before playing the DVD.

No Sound

- Make sure the DVD player is not in slow or fast playback mode.
- Make sure the **MUTE** button is not on.
- Check that the audio/visual cord is properly connected.
- Check the Audio setting in the Setup menu.

Poor Functioning

- If the DVD player has been affected by adverse environmental conditions such as condensation or heat, wait for 1 hour before playing the DVD.
- Static electricity can affect operation. Turn off the DVD player and turn it back on or wait until the DVD player is no longer in an area with static electricity.

Long Wait After Pressing PLAY/ENTER

- After using the setup menu or after pressing many buttons in rapid succession, the DVD player motor will take longer than normal to begin playback.

Remote Control Does Not Work

- Check batteries.
- Check the distance or angle from the infrared sensor on the DVD player or the remote eye sensor.

Setup Menu Does Not Work

- Setup menu cannot be accessed when the disc is loading.
- Audio, Subtitle, and Disc menu in the Language Setup menu can only be adjusted when playback is stopped.
- The Setup menu includes features which may not be available on all discs.
