

- If the remote control no longer works or you have misplaced it, you can use the controls on the panel of the television.

Connection Panel (depending on the model)

> The product color and shape may vary depending on the model.

Rear Jack

Whenever you connect an audio or video system to your television, ensure that all elements are switched off. Please be sure to match the color coded input terminals and cable jacks.

Audio/Video Output Jacks

Connect to the audio/video input jacks of a recording VCR.

Audio/Video Input Jacks

Connect to the audio/video output jacks of VCRs, DVD players and similar devices.


Connect to Audio-L, when using the mono equipment.

③ Component Video Input Jacks (Y, P_B, P_R)

Connect to the Component video outputs of a DVD or DTV set-top box. 480i video signal input is available. When using the Component Video input, connect audio jacks to "AV IN 2 (AUDIO-L/R)".

ANT IN

Connect to an antenna or to a cable TV system.



Please be sure to match the color coded input terminals and cable jacks. When both the side and rear jacks (AV IN 2) are connected to external equipment, the side receives priority.

Audio Input Jacks

Connect audio signals from a camcorder or video game.

Video Input Jack

Connect a video signal from a camcorder or video game.

Headphone Jack


Connect a set of external headphones to this jack for private listening.

Remote Control (depending on the model)

> Operation of remote control may be affected by bright artificial light near to the TV.



MUTE

Used to switch the sound off temporarily. To turn the sound back on, press the MUTE, VOL+ or VOL- button

- Numeric buttons Used to select channels directly.
- **6** INFO

Used to view the channel information and setting status you selected.

- SOURCE Used to display all of the available video sources.
- TOOLS (depending on the model)

You can check the following selection by pressing Tools button.

- 1. Sleep Timer(Used to select a preset time interval for automatic turn off.)
- 2. Picture Mode Used to select the picture effect.
- 3. Sound Mode Used to select the sound effect.
- 4. MTS(Multi-channel Television Sound) Press to choose "Stereo" or "Mono" or" SAP"

5. Turbo Plus

Used to select the Turbo Plus option. 6. Equalizer

- Used to select the Equalizer option. 7. R.SURF
- Press to automatically return to a preferred channel after a user preset time delay.
- 8. EasyView Used to display Channel Grouping, Channel Minimizer, Channel Scheduler, Music Mode, Half Mute menu.
- ENTER

While using the on-screen menus, press the **ENTER** button to activate (or change) a particular item.

C EXIT

Used to exit from any display or return to normal viewing.

PRE-CH

Used to switch repeatedly between the last two channels displayed.

Turning the TV On and Off

Press the **POWER** button on the remote control. You can also use the **POWER** button on the TV.

Caution: One pole switch is totally not off(one line still live) if power cord is not unplugged.

Viewing the Menus

- 1 Press the MENU button.
- The main menu is displayed on the screen. Its left side has five icons: **Input, Picture, Sound, Channel,** and **Setup**.
- 2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select one of the icons. Press the ENTER button to access the icon's sub-menu.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to move to items in the menu. Press the ENTER button to enter items in the menu.
- 4 Press the ▲/▼/◀/► button to change the selected items. Press the **MENU** button to return to the previous menu.
- 5 Press the EXIT button to exit from the menu.

POWER Used to switch the TV on and off.

MENU Used to display the onscreen menu or return to the previous menu.

Used to control the cursor in the menu.

CH , CH Used to display the next or previous stored channel

VOL +, VOL -Used to increase or decrease the volume.

Installing Batteries

Remove the cover. Install two AAA size batteries, then replace the cover. When the remote control does not operate normally, check that the "+" and "-" ends of the batteries are inserted correctly or the batteries are drained.

> Do not mix battery types, i.e. alkaline and manganese.



Setup - Plug & Play (depending on the model)

When the TV is initially powered on, several basic customer settings proceed automatically and subsequently. The following settings are available.

- 1 Press the **POWER** button on the remote control. The message "Start Plug & Play" is displayed. It flickers for a little while and then Language menu is automatically displayed.
- 2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the language, then press the ENTER button. The message "Check antenna input" is displayed.
 - If any language is not selected, the language menu will disappear about 30 seconds later.
- 3 Make sure that the antenna is connected to the TV. Press the ENTER button, then the "Auto Program" is displayed.

Channel - Memorizing the Channels

Your TV can memorize and store all of the available channels for both air and cable channels. After the available channels are memorized, use the CH \checkmark and CH \checkmark buttons to scan through the channels.

This eliminates the need to change channels by entering the channel digits. There are three steps for memorizing channels: "Air/Cable", "Auto Program" and "Add/Delete".

Air/Cable

Before your TV can begin memorizing the available channels, you must specify the type of signal source that is connected to the TV (i.e., an antenna or a cable system). Select "Air" or "Cable" by pressing the ◄/► button.

Channel - Fine Tune

If the reception is clear, you do not have to fine-tune the channel, as this is done automatically during the search and store operation. If however the signal is weak or distorted, you may have to fine-tune the channel manually.

Adjust the fine tuning by pressing

R.SURF Feature (depending on the model)

This feature allows you to set the TV to return to a particular channel after a certain amount of time. For example, you may be watching a channel when commercials start. You can press **TOOLS** button to enter **R.SURF** to set the **R.SURF** to "5 minutes", then switch channels. After



minutes, the TV will return to the original channel.

Press the **ENTER** button on the remote control to set the timer in thirty second intervals, up to five minutes.

Sleep Timer

You can select a time period of between 30 and 180 minutes after which the TV automatically switches to standby mode.

You can also press the TOOLS button and enter Sleep Timer to use this function.

Scheduler

You can set the scheduler to make the TV return to a particular channel at a pre-set time.

- Upto 5 Programmes can be scheduled at a time.
- If the Clock is not set in the Time menu, a pop-up warning will flash if user tries to enter Scheduler.
- You can also use the TOOLS button and enter EazyView to use this function.

On Timer Volume

The preferred volume can be set for when the timer automatically turns on the TV.

Method:

- \checkmark : Move to the programme hour or minute.
- ▲/▼: Used to set programme hour or minute.
- ▲/▼ → ENTER : Set option of YES/ON to activate/deactivate the operation.
- You must set the clock first.
- Auto Power Off

When you set the timer "On", the TV will eventually turn off, if no controls are operated for 3 hours after the TV was turned on by timer. This function is only available in timer "On" mode and prevents overheating, which may occur if a TV is on for too long.

Setup - Caption

Your TV decodes and displays the closed captions that are broadcast with certain TV shows. These captions are usually subtitles for the hearing impaired or foreignlanguage translations. All VCRs record the closed caption signal from TV programs, so home-



recorded video tapes also provide closed captions. Most prerecorded commercial video tapes provide closed captions as well. Check for the closed caption symbol in your TV schedule and on the tape's packaging: [cc].

♦ Caption: On/Off

You can activate or deactivate the "Caption" function.

Misspellings and unusual characters sometimes occur during closed caption transmissions, especially those of live events. There may be a small delay before captions appear when you change channels. These are not malfunctions of the TV.

Blue Screen

If no signal is being received or the signal is very weak, a blue screen automatically replaces the noisy picture background. If you wish to continue viewing the poor picture, you must set the "Blue Screen" to "Off".

Melody

You can hear melody sound when the TV is powered on or off.

Music Mode

You can listen to the music/audio without video or visual distraction.

- When Music Mode is selected, only music is audible and no picture is visible. You can see music mode icon (1) on screen.
- You can also use the TOOLS button and enter EazyView to use this function.

Setup - Child Lock (depending on the model)

This feature allows you to prevent unauthorized users, such as children, from watching unsuitable programs by muting out video and audio. Child Lock cannot be released using front panel buttons. Only remote control can release

Equalizer

The television has several settings which allow you to control the sound quality.

- \succ If you make any changes to these settings, the sound mode is automatically switched to Custom.
- \succ You can select these options simply by pressing the TOOLS button on the remote control and enter Equalizer.
- MTS (Multi-channel Television Sound) Depending on the particular program being broadcast, you can listen to Mono. Stereo. or SAP.

- \succ Press the **TOOLS** button on the remote control and enter MTS to select "Stereo", "Mono", or "SAP" (Secondary Audio Program).
- Auto Volume

Each broadcasting station has its own signal conditions. and so it is not easy to adjust the volume every time the channel is changed. This feature lets you automatically adjust the volume of the desired channel by lowering the sound output when the modulation signal is high or by raising the sound output when the modulation signal is low.

Pseudo Stereo

This feature converts a monaural sound signal into two identical left and right channels. Once the "Pseudo Stereo" is set to "On" or "Off", the setting applies to the sound effects such as "Standard". "Music". "Movie" and "Speech". **Turbo Plus**

This feature suitably emphasizes both higher and lower bands of sound (and includes other effects). You can enjoy more magnificent and dynamic sound when watching music, movie, or other channels,

Troubleshooting

Remote control malfunctions

- ٠ Replace the remote control batteries.
- Clean the upper edge of the remote control (transmission window)
- Check that the "+" and "-" ends of the batteries are inserted correctly.
- Check that the batteries are drained.

A still image may cause color distortion, but with normal sound(white or highlight image).

- Switch to other channels with moving image, and check if the color turns normal after 5 minutes.
- Turn off the TV and turn it on after 30 minutes to check the color

Cleaning and Maintaining Your TV

Please follow the guidelines to get the maximum performance from your TV.

Placement

- Do not Place the TV near extremely hot, cold, humid or dusty places.
- Do not place TV near appliances with electric motor that create magnetic fields, such as vacuum cleaners.
- Keep the ventilation openings clear: do not place TV on a soft surface, such as cloth or paper.
- Place the TV in a vertical position only.

Liquids

Do not handle liquids near or on the TV. Liquid that spills into it can cause serious damage.

Cabinet

- Never open the cabinet or touch the parts inside.
- Wipe your TV with a clean, dry cloth. Never use water, cleaning fluids, wax or chemicals.
- Do not put heavy objects on top of the cabinet.

Temperature

 If your TV suddenly move from a cold to a warm place, unplug the power cord and allow at least two hours for moisture that may have formed inside the unit to dry completely.

Using Your TV in Another Country

- If you plan to take the TV with you to a foreign country please be aware of a different television systems that are in use around the world. A TV designed for one system may not work properly with another system due to differences in the TV channel frequencies.
