





## Listening to Music with yepp

First, insert a battery and connect the earphones to the player.

### **Playing Music** (Power On)

When you press the ▶/ ■ button, the yepp logo appears and a music/voice file is played.




Note . Both Power Off and Sleep modes can be set in the MENU mode.(refer to P.23)

## **Stopping Music**

(Power Off/Sleen)

When you press the ▶/■ button while playing. the music stops. If no buttons are pressed within 5 seconds, the venn automatically enters Power Off or Sleep mode.



## Setting up Volume / Hold Functions

### **Adjusting the Volume**

Press the A/ button on the side to adjust the volume while playing.



Note: Volume ranges from 00 to 30.

- Press to adjust step by step.
- Press and hold to adjust continuously.

#### **HOLD Function**

Slide the switch on the side in the direction of the arrow to change to HOLD mode



Notice: Under Hold mode, no buttons work.






## Recording Voice

#### To Record Voice

- Press the button to begin recording voice.
- Press the ▶/■button to pause while recording. Press the ▶/■ button again to resume recording.
- Press the button to stop recording. A new voice file is created.



Notice: Recording is done in the order of VI001, VI002.....

- When memory is full, recording stops automatically.
- (The available time is displayed on the right when recording begins.)
- When recording voice, make sure to record for longer than 5 seconds.



## Searching for Music/Voice Files

## Searching for Specific Parts in a Track

 Press the ◄◄/ ▶► button for longer than 1 second while playing to find the part you want to listen to.
 Release the ◄◄/ ▶► button to resume playing.



## Searching for Music/Voice Files in PLAY mode


- Press the ►► button while playing to advance to the next track.



## Searching for Music/Voice Files in STOP mode

Press the  $\blacktriangleleft \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright \blacktriangleright$  button in STOP mode to skip to the previous or next track.

Press the ►/■ button to play.



Notice: There's no sound while searching for specific parts in a voice file

Note:

- With VBR files, pressing the ◀◀ button within 5 seconds from the start may not result in the previous track playing.
- With VBR files, the actual running time may differ from that of the player display.
- VBR(Variable Bit Rate) file: MP3 file whose compression rate changes when played.

## **Loop Repeating**

### **Loop Function**

### **Starting Point**

While playing music/voice files, press the button at the beginning of the loop you want to set.

• (A) flickers in the display.

Note: Press the button to cancel the loop

### **Ending Point**


Press the button at the end of the loop.

- (AB) appears in the display screen.
- The loop is played repeatedly.

## Setting up MENU (Refer to P. 16-23)

- Press the button for longer than 2 seconds to switch to MENU mode.
- Use the ►/■button to select and the ◄◄/►► button to move.
- Press the button one more time to cancel the **MENU** mode.



- Play mode: To select track repeating mode.
- Equalizer : To use equalizer function
- File: To delete or format music/voice files.
- Setting: To change the basic setup options of the display.
- Exit menu : To exit MENU


Note: • In MENU, Go up can be used to exit the current setting.

In MENU mode, no input for 10 seconds will cancel the mode.

## Repeating Tracks

### Track Repeating Function

- In MENU, select 1.Play mode.
- 2 In PLAY MODE, use the ◄◄/ ▶► button to move to the Repeat mode you want and press the ▶/■ button to select.

## Setting up EQ

#### **EQ Function**

- In MENU, select 2. Equalizer.
- 2 In EQ, use the ◄◄/ ▶▶ button to move to the setting you want (out of the 8 settings) and press the ▶/■ button to select.





Note: • DBB is for Dynamic Bass Booster, which enhances bass response.



## **Managing Files**

### Deletina

- In MENU, select 3. File
- In File, select Delete and the mode the target file is in. (Music or Voice)
- Move to the file to delete and press the ▶/■button to select. The file is deleted

### **Formatting**

- In MENU, select 3. File
- In File, select Format → Confirm. Select Cancel to exit the mode.





#### Display → 3. Time

- 12Hours: Displays the time in the 12 hour setting

- Plug one end of the USB cable into the USB port on the back of a computer.
- Slide down the bottom cover of yepp player to plug the other end of the USB cable into the USB port on the right side at the bottom.

 Before connecting to the computer, make sure to install yepp Audio Manager. If "Add New Hardware Wizard" appears, press the [Cancel] button and install yepp Explorer.

 If USB driver is not installed automatically, refer to page 30.







## **Setting Options Function**

### PC (yepp Audio Manager)



- Click on the vepp Audio Manager → View → Options...
  - → Read CD → Record File AS Mpeg (mp3)
  - → Set the Bit Rate → Press [OK]
- Click on the yepp Audio Manager → View → Options...
- → Portable → Set the Bit Rate → Set the vepp YP-30S on Device → Press [OK]

#### How to check USB driver

"Turning on the power of vepp"→ "Connecting vepp to PC"

-USB driver is installed with a message saving that it is searching for a new device. If USB driver is not installed, try one more time after rebooting the PC. (If USB driver is not installed at the second attempt, contact your PC manufacturer.) When USB driver is installed, "SAMSUNG YP-30S" will appear in [System Properties]

→ [Device Manager] as shown in the picture on the right.



## Copying Files to yepp (PC)





## Copying Files to yepp (Mac)







## **Uploading Files (PC)**

Before uploading files, connect vepp to PC.

When in Sleep mode, press the ▶/■ button to make sure the power is on and then proceed.

Double click the yepp Audio Manager.

Select [Copy to devices].

On the right side window, select the file that you'd like to transfer to PC (check).

Click on the "Upload Form Portable".





- You cannot transfer music files back from the yepp to the PC (due to copyright protection).
  - Voice Files recorded on the player are converted into WAV when they are stored on PC.

## **Uploading Files (Mac)**

Before uploading files, connect yepp to Mac.

When in Sleep mode, press the ▶/■ button to make sure the power is on and then proceed.

2 Select [File] → [Refresh].



3 Select files to save in Mac and click [File]→[Copy to]→[Mac].



Notice: • Voice files are not supported on the Mac.

## Rearranging Files

Before rearranging files, connect yepp to PC.

When in Sleep mode, press the ▶/■ button to make sure the power is on and then proceed.

Double click the yepp Audio Manager.

2 Select the file to relocate.



Press the ►/■ button to move the file.



Note: • File transfer between directories (Music, Voice) is not allowed.

On Mac, drag and drop the selected file where you wish it to be.


