Your yepp' contains a few sample MP3 files. Insert batteries into the battery compartment, and then connect the remote controller (earphone) correctly.



MP3 files cannot be downloaded.

- Check and/or replace the batteries.
- Check the connection between the parallel port of your PC and the parallel cable.

SmartMedia Card cannot be inserted into the player.

 Make sure you are using the correct SmartMedia Card. Only 3.3V version cards will work in your yepp´™.
 5V version Cards will not function correctly.

The files on the SmartMediaCard cannot be recognized.

- MP3 files downloaded to another media card from a different MP3 manufacturer may not work in your yepp [™].
- Format the SmartMedia Card and copy files again with the yepp ´™ Explorer.
