

Before Using Your DVD player


If your TV has AUDIO/VIDEO input jacks, see the section "Connections" on pages 6–7. If not, it is still possible to connect this DVD player to your TV by using a STEREO AUDIO/VIDEO RF Modulator (commercially available.) In this case, follow the instructions below.

- Connect the AUDIO/VIDEO output jacks of this DVD player to the AUDIO/VIDEO input jacks of your RF Modulator by audio and video cables.
- The antenna input jack of your TV may have been already occupied. If so, disconnect the RF cable from your TV and then connect the RF cable to your RF Modulator (usually marked "ANT IN".)
- 3) Connect your RF modulator to your TV by another RF cable.
- 4) Set your RF modulator's channel 3/4 switch to either 3 or 4, whichever the TV channel is least used in your area. If your RF modulator has a Modulator/Antenna switch, set it according to your RF modulator's manual.
- Turn on your TV and choose the same channel as you set the RF modulator's channel 3/4 switch to.

For more details, follow the instructions supplied with the RF Modulator.

Hint

 The quality of picture may become poor if this DVD player is connected to an RF Modulator.


Functions


Operations described after this section are mainly based on the remote control use. Some operations can be carried out on the unit itself.

Playback

Before: Turn on the TV, amplifier and any other components which are connected to the DVD player. Make sure the TV and audio receiver (commercially available) are set to the correct channel.







Hint

- A "prohibited icon" may appear at the top-right on the TV screen when the operation is prohibited by the disc or this unit.
- Some DVDs may be played from title 2 or 3 due to specific programs.
- During the playback of a two-layered disc, pictures may stop for a moment. This happens while the 1st layer is being switched to the 2nd layer. This is not a malfunction.

DVD menu

DVDs may contain menus to access special features. Press appropriate number buttons or use the arrow $(\triangle/\nabla/4/\triangleright)$ buttons to highlight your selection in the DVD main menu and press the ENTER button to confirm.0

Calling up a Menu Screen during Playback

- Press the MENU button to call up the DVD menu.
- Press the TOP MENU button to call up the title menu.

Resume





Press **the STOP button**. Resume message will appear on the TV screen.
