DANGER - TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK:

- The output of this heater may vary and its temperature may become intense enough to burn exposed skin. Persons with reduced sensitivity to heat or an inability to react to avoid burns should not use this device.
- Individuals with diabetes should not use this device.
- Always unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.
- · Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- DO NOT place the heater near a bed because objects such as pillows or blankets can fall off the bed and be ignited by the heater.
- DO NOT reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Unplug it immediately.
- DO NOT use while bathing or in the shower.
- DO NOT place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- DO NOT place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- NEVER use pins or other metallic fasteners with this appliance.
- DO NOT leave heater unattended while ON.

Caution: All servicing of this product must be performed by authorized SI Products Service Personnel only.

- DO NOT use heater while sleeping.
- Keep dry DO NOT operate in a wet or moist condition.
- This appliance is designed for personal, non-professional use only.
- Do not use attachments not recommended by The Sharper Image; specifically any attachments not provided with the unit.
- Check your heater cord and plug connections.
- a) Faulty wall outlet connections or loose plugs can cause the outlet or plug to overheat. Be sure the plug fits tight in the outlet.
- b) This heater draws 12.5 amps during operation. To prevent overloading a circuit, do not plug the heater into a circuit that already has other appliances working.
- CAUTION: It is normal for the plug to feel warm to the touch; however, a loose fit between the AC outlet (receptacle) and plug may cause overheating and distortion of the plug. Contact a qualified electrician to replace loose or worn outlet.

WARNING - TO REDUCE THE RISK OF BURNS, ELECTRIC SHOCK, FIRE OR INJURY TO PERSONS:

- This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surface. If provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep combustible materials such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes and curtains at least three feet from the front of the heater and keep them away from the sides and rear.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
- Always unplug the heater when not in use.
- Do not operate the heater with a damaged cord or plug, or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Discard the heater or return to SI Products Service facility for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair.

- This heater is not intended for use in bathroom, laundry areas and similar moist indoor locations. Never locate heater where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or similar coverings. Do not route cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange cord away from traffic areas where it can be tripped over.
- To disconnect the heater, first turn controls to the OFF position, then remove plug from outlet.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.
- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surface, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
- A heater may have hot and arcing sparking parts inside. Do not use it in the areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored.
- Use this heater only for its intended use as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. Never use with an extension cord or relocate power tap (outlet/power strip).

CAUTION: Avoid the use of an extension cord because the extension cord may overheat and cause a risk of fire. However, if you have to use an extension cord, the cord should be No.14 AWG minimum size and rated not less than 1875 watts.



Main Features on the Flat Panel Ceramic Tower Heater




1. Control Panel

- 7. ON/OFF Switch



If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. DO NOT attempt to defeat this safety feature. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Insert the bottom of stand pole into the center hole of the base. Lock it into place by screwing on the nut. Make sure the nut is completely tightened.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Turning the Unit On

- Check that neither the appliance nor the power cord has been damaged .
- Place the heater on a firm level surface.
- Connect the power cord into a standard AC outlet. The heater will beep twice to confirm the connection.

1. Main switch (on the back side of the device)

- To turn the heater on, flip the main switch to the ON position. When the main switch is flipped to the ON position, the heater will initially be OFF until the ON/OFF button is pressed on the touch screen.
- The heater will beep twice indicating that the heater is ready for use.
- Press ON/OFF @ button on the touch screen.
- NOTE: Every time a command is pressed on the touch screen, the heater will emit a small beep and the appropriate symbol will light up confirming the selection.

2. On/Off and Heat Settings

- Turn the heater ON by pressing the ON/OFF button on the touch screen.
 Every time the heater is turned on it will be operating as follows: LOW heat, timer OFF, and oscillation OFF.
- Once the heater is ON, press HEAT button to select heat setting. Press HEAT button once to select HIGH heat. Press HEAT button again to return to LOW heat. Either the HIGH or LOW symbol will light up depending on the heat setting selected.
- To turn the heater OFF, simply press ON/OFF @ button.

3. Oscillation

- To activate the oscillation, press OSCILLATE button on the touch screen.
 The heater will oscillate 85 degrees side to side. The oscillation symbol
 will light up when the heater is oscillating.
- To turn the oscillation off, press OSCILLATE @ button. The oscillation symbol @ will no longer be seen on the screen.

4. Timer

There are four possible timer settings: 0.5 hours, 1 (one) hour, 2 (two) hours and 8 (eight) hours. To activate the timer and select a time setting, press TIMER ${\mathfrak O}$ button on the touch screen. Each time the TIMER ${\mathfrak O}$ button is pressed, it will switch between settings in a repeating cycle as follows: 0.5 hours, 1 hour, 2 hours.

8 hours, OFF. Press again and the cycle begins again. The selection will light up on the screen matching the time period. When the timer is OFF, no selections will be lit.

5. Tip-Over Auto Shut Off

If you tilt the heater at least 40 degrees to the side, you will hear a click sound. This is the Auto Shut Off safety feature that will power the heater OFF if it is knocked over. Once the heater is again positioned upright with the base on a firm, flat surface, the heater will resume power.

6. Overheat Protection


The heater is equipped with a resettable heat fuse, which is activated and powers the heater OFF if it overheats. If this occurs, disconnect the heater from the AC power outlet. As soon as the heater cools down, connect it to the AC power outlet and you may turn it on again.

This heater is also equipped with a non-resettable heat fuse in case first heat fuse malfunctions. If the non-resettable heat fuse has been activated, operation cannot be resumed. The heater will need to be repaired by authorized SI product service personnel.


Using the Remote Control

Battery Installation

One CR2032 3V battery is included with the remote control. To activate the remote control functions, pull out the plastic pull tab protruding from the remote control housing. To change the battery, remove the battery drawer at the bottom back of the remote by squeezing the side and pulling the drawer out. Please insert the battery into the remote with the positive side up as shown on the drawer. NOTE: Always keep the battery and remote control out of the reach of children.



Remote Control Features



- Only use CR2032 3V battery with this remote control.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (ni-cad, ni-mh, etc) batteries.
- Batteries may pose a choking hazard. Do not let children handle batteries.
- Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- After opening battery door, be sure the door is properly closed and clicks shut.
- Remove used batteries promptly. Dispose of used batteries immediately.
- If the unit is not going to be used for a long period of time, remove batteries to prevent damage due to possible battery leakage.
- Please dispose of used batteries per local regulations.

Cleaning and Storage

We recommend that the heater be cleaned at least once a month and before off-season storage.

- Turn the heater OFF at the main switch and unplug it. Allow it to cool.
- Use a dry cloth to clean the external surfaces of the heater.

DO NOT USE WATER, WAX, POLISH OR ANY CHEMICAL SOLUTION

- Clean your heater using the above-mentioned steps, then disassemble and pack the heater in its original container and store it in a cool, dry place.
- The motor is factory lubricated and will require no further lubrication.

Air Filter

- Dirt and dust may be caught on the air filter, affecting the function of the device.
 Clean the air filter regularly.
- To clean, turn unit OFF and unplug unit from outlet, then remove the Back Grill Cover on the back of the heater. Remove the air filter from the grill.
- Wash the filter by hand in a lukewarm solution of water and detergent. Rinse the
 filter in clean water and allow it to dry thoroughly. Place the clean, dry filter back
 into the back grill and close the back grill cover.
- Do not use the device without the filter and back grill cover secure.

Troubleshooting

If the Heater Fails to Operate

- Be sure it is plugged in and that the AC outlet is working. Check circuit breaker in case of a blown circuit.
- Check for any obstruction. If you find an obstruction, press ON/OFF main switch
 to turn the heater OFF. Unplug the heater and wait at least ten minutes for it to
 cool. Carefully remove the obstruction. Plug the heater back in and restart it as
 described under OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS.
- If the heater still does not operate, remove the power cord from the AC outlet and have the heater service by authorized SI product service personnel.
