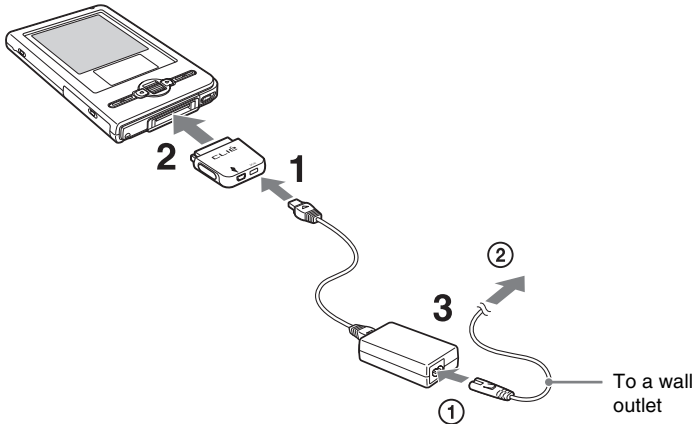


Setting up your CLIÉ™ handheld

The following operations are required before use.

Step 1: Charging your CLIÉ handheld

Before using your CLIÉ handheld for the first time, make sure you fully charge the battery.



- 1** Connect the AC power adapter to the DC IN connector of the plug adapter.
- 2** Connect the plug adapter to the interface connector of your CLIÉ handheld .
- 3** Connect the AC cord to the AC power adapter (①). Then, plug the AC cord into a wall outlet (②).
The POWER LED of your CLIÉ handheld turns on when charging starts.

It takes about four hours to fully charge your CLIÉ handheld for the first time. The POWER LED turns off when charging is complete.

Tip

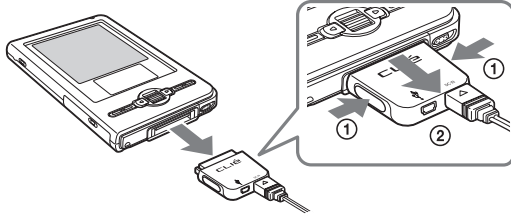
Subsequent charges will require less time if you charge your CLIÉ handheld frequently.

Note

If the battery of your CLIÉ handheld is completely discharged, all user data stored on your CLIÉ handheld will be lost.

How to remove the plug adapter

Remove by pressing the plug adapter on both sides as illustrated.

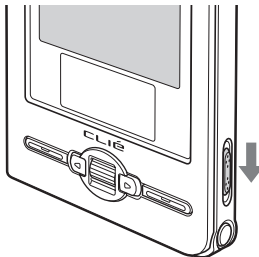


Step 2: Performing the initial setup after turning on your CLIÉ handheld for the first time

The first time you turn on your CLIÉ handheld, you need to make some initial settings. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup and to become familiar with operations of your CLIÉ handheld.

1 Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch.

Your CLIÉ handheld turns on, and the **Setup** screen is displayed.



Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch

Note

When you slide and hold the POWER/HOLD switch for more than 2seconds, the backlight of the LCD display switches on or off.

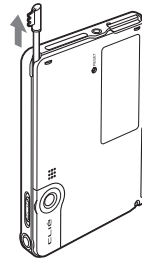

2 Take out the stylus.

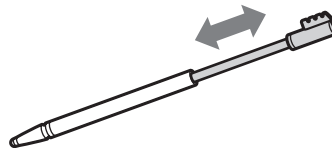
You can use the stylus to enter text or to select applications.

You can extend or shorten the stylus, as shown in the illustration.

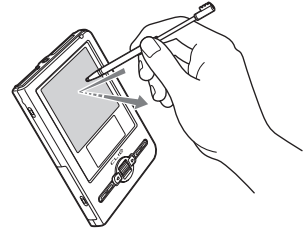
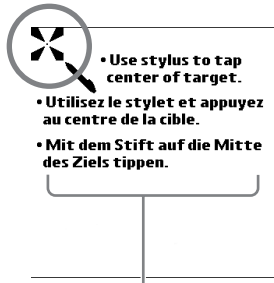


Notes

- Never use a writing pen, pencil, or other sharp object instead of the stylus to write on your CLIÉ handheld, as the screen may get scratched.
- When you put the stylus back in its holder, push it in into place completely.

3 Following the on-screen instructions. Tap exactly in the center of the displayed mark.

Tap the next targets, which are displayed at the bottom right and then in the center of the screen.



Press lightly on the screen (Tap)

The display in the screen depend on what country or region your CLIÉ handheld was purchased.

If the stylus digitizer is not configured correctly, the scroll bar may not operate properly, “tapping” may not work as expected, or other problems may occur.

Tap each box to set the hour and minute.



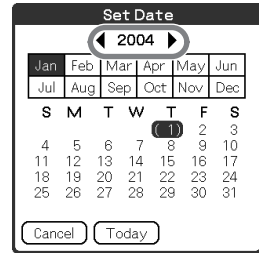

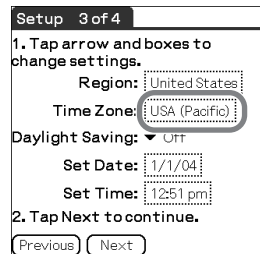


- 10** Tap ◀ or ▶ to select the current year.



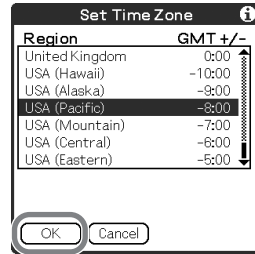
- 11** Tap the current month, then tap the current date.

Using your CLIÉ™ handheld with your computer

Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ stored on the supplied Installation CD-ROM must be installed on your computer. The software is used for data transfer between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, and handling data on your computer such as **Address Book**.

When **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** is installed on your computer, **CLIÉ Manuals** is also installed on your computer.

➔ For details on **CLIÉ Manuals**, refer to “Using CLIÉ Manuals with your computer” (page 42).

Step 1: Installing the software on your computer

Do not connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer before installing the software. Otherwise, the software may not be installed properly.

Notes

- Do not simply copy the Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ folder from the supplied Installation CD-ROM to your computer. To install the software properly, follow the installation procedure described below.
 - If you use Windows 2000 Professional or Windows XP, log on with a username in the Administrators group before installing the software.
 - If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld and an older version of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** has already been installed on your computer, follow the installation procedure below to upgrade to the new version.
 - * If you are using PEG-N710C Series or PEG-S300 Series, refer to your CLIÉ handheld support website. (Refer to the URL shown on the back cover of this manual.)
- ➔ For details, refer to “Transferring data from another CLIÉ™ handheld” in the “Handbook” (PDF format).

- 1 Quit all applications running on Windows®.
- 2 Insert the supplied Installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.
The **Installation CD-ROM** window is displayed.
- 3 Select your language.
(Only available for certain models or areas.)
- 4 Click [Next] or [CLIÉ Basic], then click [Install] to install **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ**.
The setup program starts and the **InstallShield Wizard** window is displayed.

Note

If you try to install **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** when an older version of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** has already been installed on your computer, a dialog box appears on your computer window.
Follow the instruction of the dialog box to install the new version of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIE** supplied with your CLIÉ handheld.

- 5 Click [Next].
The **InstallShield Wizard** window for [Setup Type] is displayed.
- 6 Select the setup type, [Complete] or [Custom].
When you select [Custom], you need to specify which software you want to install and where to be installed.
The following steps explain when you select [Complete].
- 7 Click [Next].
The **InstallShield Wizard** window for [Select User] is displayed.
- 8 Enter a user name and click [Next].
The **InstallShield Wizard** window for [Ready to Install the Program] is displayed after entering any user name you prefer.

Note**If you have more than one CLIÉ handheld**

Enter a user name that is different from the one you use for another CLIÉ handheld.
If you set an identical user name for multiple CLIÉ handhelds, errors will occur.

9 Click [Install].

Installation of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** starts.

“InstallShield Wizard Completed” message is displayed in the **InstallShield Wizard** window when the installation is complete.

10 Click [Finish].

The **Sony CLIÉ Handheld Registration** window is displayed for models for the U.S.A., Canada, and Europe only.

If you do not want to sign up for the customer service, click to deselect [Register your CLIÉ].

Installation of Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer is complete.

Step 2: Registering your CLIÉ handheld

You can register your CLIÉ handheld after installing **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** by following the on-screen instructions.

All of the information you provide is confidential.

Note

Step 3: Connecting your CLIÉ handheld and computer via the USB cable

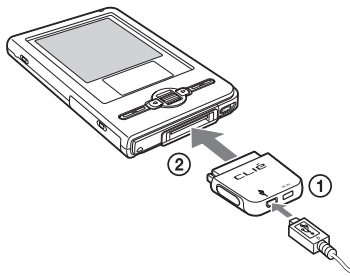
You can synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer by connecting them with the supplied USB cable after installing **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ**.

About the USB cable

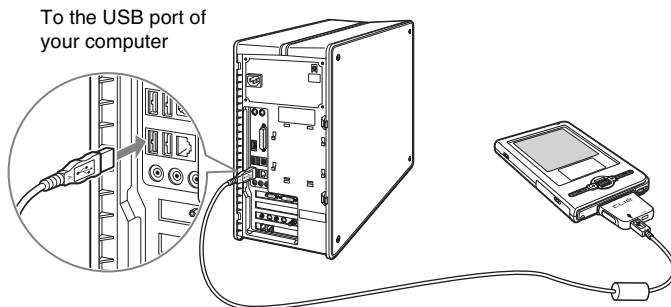
The supplied USB cable has two connectors. Connect the “A” plug to the USB port of your computer and the mini “B” plug to the plug adapter.



- 1 Connect the mini “B” plug of the USB cable to the plug adapter (①), then connect the plug adapter to the interface connector of your CLIÉ handheld (②).




- 2 Connect the “A” plug of the USB cable to the USB port of your computer.




Note


Make sure you connect the USB cable directly to a USB port of your computer. If the USB cable is connected to a computer via another device, such as a USB hub, the HotSync® operation may not work properly.

Step 4: Entering a user name for your CLIÉ handheld

- 1 Rotate the Jog Dial™ navigator to select  (HotSync) on the CLIÉ Launcher and press the Jog Dial™ navigator. The **HotSync** screen is displayed.

Tip

You can also tap  (HotSync) to display the **HotSync** screen.

- 2 Tap  (HotSync) in the **HotSync** screen.

The HotSync® operation starts. The Applications required for setup are installed automatically.

- 3 Click [OK] when your user name is displayed in the **Users** window of your computer.

A beep is heard and the HotSync® operation starts.

Your user name entered for **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** is also registered in your CLIÉ handheld.

When the setup is complete, “HotSync operation complete.” will be displayed on your CLIÉ handheld.

- 4 Click [Finish] in the **Installation CD-ROM** window of your computer.

The setup is complete.

Installing the supplied applications on your CLIÉ™ handheld

You can install applications from the supplied Installation CD-ROM by following the procedure below.


You must install **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ** on your computer, before installing the supplied applications on your CLIÉ handheld. Your CLIÉ handheld must be connected to your computer via the USB cable.

Note

The supplied applications are designed to operate on your CLIÉ handheld only. Compatibility with other CLIÉ handhelds or Palm OS® PDAs is not guaranteed.

..... Installing the applications from the supplied Installation CD-ROM

- 1** Quit all applications running on Windows®.
- 2** Insert the supplied Installation CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.
The **Installation CD-ROM** window is displayed.
- 3** Select the type of application you want to install, such as [CLIÉ Utilities].
- 4** Click [Install] to install the application.
Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 5** To install the application on your CLIÉ handheld, tap  (HotSync) in the **HotSync** screen.
The HotSync® operation starts and the selected application is transferred and installed on your CLIÉ handheld.
- 6** Click [Finish] in the **Installation CD-ROM** window of your computer.

Tip

You can also install applications on your CLIÉ handheld using the function of **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ**.

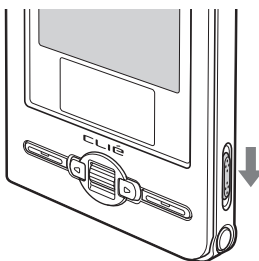
This chapter explains how to turn on and off your CLIÉ handheld, start an application, enter text, and perform a reset.

Turning on/off your CLIÉ™ handheld

Turning on your CLIÉ handheld

Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch.

Your CLIÉ handheld turns on, and the last screen you viewed is displayed.



Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch

When you slide and hold the POWER/HOLD switch for more than 2 seconds, the backlight of the LCD display switches on or off.

Tip

If you cannot turn on your CLIÉ handheld

To turn off your CLIÉ handheld

Slide down the POWER/HOLD switch again.

Starting an application

To work with your CLIE handheld, you need to start an application.

The following explains how to start applications from the CLIE Launcher using the Jog Dial™ navigator.

Using the Jog Dial™ navigator and ◀/▶ (the Left/Right buttons)

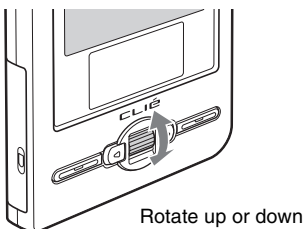
❶ Displaying the CLIE Launcher

- 1 Tap  (Home) (page 74).
The CLIE Launcher is displayed.

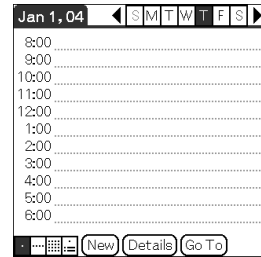
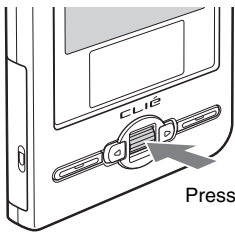


❷ Selecting an application

- 1 Rotate the Jog Dial™ navigator to select an application to start.
An application is selected.





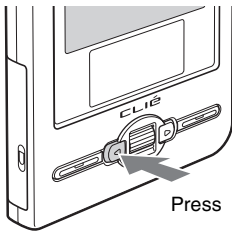
- 2** Press the Jog Dial™ navigator.
The selected application starts.



Tip

To select an application by CLIE Launcher groups

If you press  (the Left button) while the CLIE Launcher is displayed, you can select the CLIE Launcher groups in the left side of the screen. Rotate the Jog Dial™ navigator to select a CLIE Launcher group, and then press  (the Right button) to select an application in that CLIE Launcher group.

3 Quitting the application

On your CLIE handheld, most applications save files automatically, but some applications do not. In this cases, save the file manually

- For details, refer to “CLIE Application Manual” (HTML format).

To switch from one application to another, perform one of the following:

- ▶ **Return to the CLIE Launcher by tapping**



(Home) and start another application.

- ▶ **Press an application button (page 26) to start another application (only the application that is assigned to the application button).**

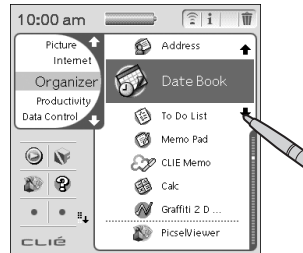
Other ways to start an application

You can also start an application using the stylus or application buttons.

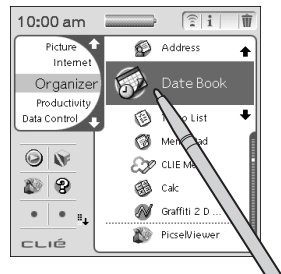
Using the stylus

Start the application by pressing the screen directly with the supplied stylus.

- 1 Tap **↑** **↓** on the CLIE Launcher to display the application you want to start.



- 2 Tap the application icon.
The selected application starts.

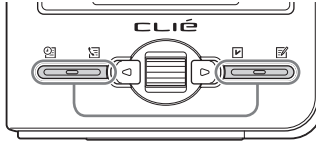


Pressing the application buttons

You can also start the applications by pressing the application buttons.

The default setting of the application buttons are:

 **Date Book**,  **Address Book**,  **To Do List**, and  **Memo Pad**.



Tips

- Even when your CLIÉ handheld is off, you can start an application by pressing one of the application buttons.
- You can assign your favorite applications to the application buttons.

Entering text

Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text

Graffiti® 2 is a unique writing method for quickly and easily entering text into CLIÉ applications such as **Date Book** or **Memo Pad**. Text is entered in the Graffiti® 2 writing area using the supplied stylus. Graffiti® 2 recognizes your handwriting and immediately converts it to typed text.

Using the Graffiti® 2 writing area of your CLIÉ handheld

Write strokes in the Graffiti® 2 writing area in the lower screen of your CLIÉ handheld to enter text. The Graffiti® 2 writing area is divided into two parts.

Write lower-case letters here



Write numbers here

Division mark

Write strokes in the left side of the Graffiti® 2 writing area for lower-case letters, the right side for numbers, or write the strokes across the division marks for upper-case letters. Activate “Symbol mode” to write symbols in the Graffiti® 2 writing area.

..... Entering text

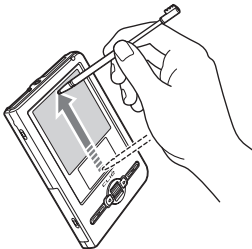
You need to start an application and display the screen in which you want to enter text.

Follow the steps below to enter text.

- 1** Start an application, such as **Date Book**, in which you want to enter text.
- 2** Tap the line where you want to enter text.
- 3** Write the Graffiti® 2 strokes in the Graffiti® 2 writing area.

Displaying the on-screen Graffiti 2 Help

To assist with the Graffiti® 2 writing, you can display the on-screen Graffiti 2 Help by dragging the stylus from the Graffiti® 2 writing area in the lower part of the screen, to the top of the screen. Graffiti 2 Help opens a series of screens that show the character set of Graffiti® 2 writing.



Other ways to enter text

There are other ways to enter text into your CLIÉ handheld. You can use whichever is the most comfortable for you.

● Handwriting system

There is another way of using the handwriting system besides **Graffiti® 2**.

Decuma Input (for PEG-TJ37 only)

You can enter text using **Decuma Input**, which converts your handwriting into typed text as you write.

● On-screen keyboard

You can enter text by tapping the on-screen keyboard.

Synchronizing data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer (the HotSync® operation)


What is the HotSync® operation?

The HotSync® operation allows you to synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, back up data from your CLIÉ handheld to your computer, and install add-on applications.

Performing the HotSync® operation

The following procedure explains how to synchronize data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer, using **Date Book** as an example.

- 1** Turn on your computer.
- 2** Enter a new schedule event in **Date Book** of your CLIÉ handheld.
 - ➔ For details on entering schedule events in **Date Book**, refer to “CLIÉ Application Manual” (HTML format).
- 3** Connect your CLIÉ handheld and computer via the supplied USB cable (page 19).
- 4** Rotate the Jog Dial™ navigator to select  (HotSync) on the CLIÉ Launcher and press the Jog Dial™ navigator. The **HotSync** screen is displayed.

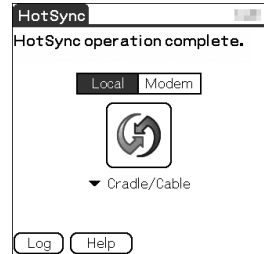
Tip

You can also tap  (HotSync) to display the **HotSync** screen.

- 5 Tap  (HotSync) in the **HotSync** screen.

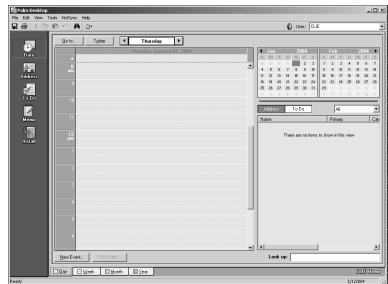
The HotSync® operation starts.

When the HotSync® operation is complete, the following screen is displayed.



- 6 Double-click  (Palm Desktop for CLIÉ) on the Windows desktop.

Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ starts and the Date Book window is displayed. If you select the same date you entered in Step 2, you will see the schedule for that day.



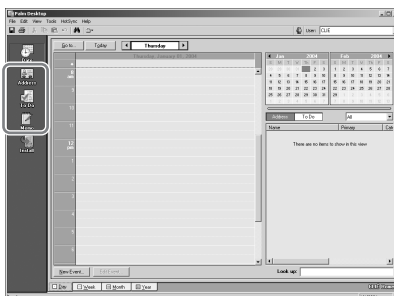

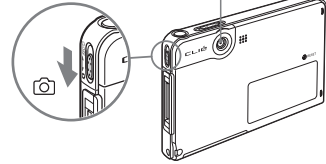

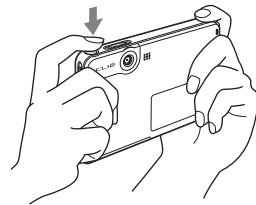

3 Slide the Lens Cover Lever up.

The lens cover is closed.

Notes

- By taking pictures, hold your CLIÉ handheld firmly with both hands and press the CAPTURE button slowly.
- After the CAPTURE button is pressed when the viewfinder blacks out, your CLIÉ handheld captures an image. At this moment, do not move your CLIÉ handheld, otherwise the picture will be blurred.
- Your CLIÉ handheld is equipped with a flicker control feature. However, flicker may occur under certain conditions. To minimize flicker if it occurs, avoid using under fluorescent lighting.
- Since the brightness and color of the screen are in adjustment for the first 2-3 seconds after starting **CLIE Camera**, be sure to check the image on-screen before shooting.

Viewing pictures

You can view the last picture taken by tapping  on the **CLIE Camera** screen. You can also view other pictures using **CLIE Viewer**.

Start **CLIE Viewer** by tapping  (CLIE Viewer) on the **CLIE Camera** screen.

Restarting your CLIÉ™ handheld

Normally, you do not need to reset your CLIÉ handheld. However, if your CLIÉ handheld does not turn on or respond, performing a soft reset may solve the problem.

To reset your CLIÉ handheld, follow the procedure below.

..... Performing a soft reset

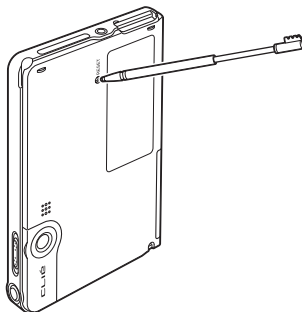
All records and add-on applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld are retained even after performing a soft reset.

Gently press the RESET button with the stylus.

The system shuts down and your CLIÉ handheld restarts.

After restarting, you will see on the screen displays “palm POWERED”

followed by “SONY”, “CLIÉ”, and then the **Preferences** screen for setting up the time and date.



Notes

- After the RESET button is pressed, it takes a while before the **Preferences** screen is displayed. Do not press the RESET button again while resetting.
- Do not press the RESET button with anything other than the stylus, as a malfunction may occur.
- Do not press any other buttons when you press the RESET button.

Performing a hard reset

If the soft reset does not solve the problem, you may need to perform a hard reset to restart your CLIÉ handheld.

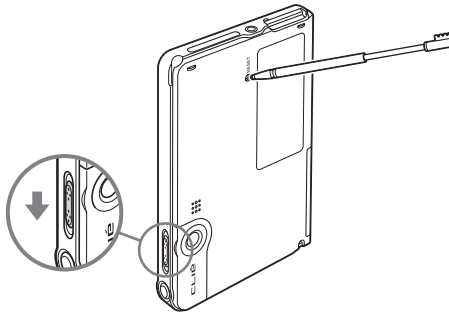
Notes

- **All records and add-on applications stored on your CLIÉ handheld will be erased by performing a hard reset.**
 - Perform a hard reset only if a soft reset does not solve the problem. However, you can restore the data if you have made a backup on your computer via the HotSync® operation*.
 - * Note that some data cannot be backed up.

- 1** Slide down and hold the POWER/HOLD switch.
- 2** Press the RESET button gently with the stylus, and then release the stylus.

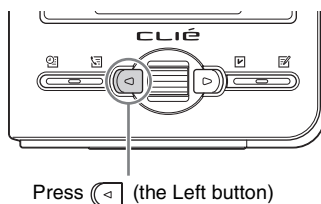

- 3** Continue holding the POWER/HOLD switch in the on position until “palm POWERED” is displayed on the screen.
A message “Erase all data?” is displayed.

If you want to cancel the hard reset, press any button other than  (the Left button).

The hard reset is performed.

After restarting, your CLIÉ handheld displays “palm POWERED”, “SONY” and “CLIÉ”, followed by the **SETUP** screen. Refer to “Step 2: Performing the initial setup after turning on your CLIÉ handheld for the first time” on page 9 for the initial setup.

After a hard reset, only the current date and time are retained. Formats, Preferences, and other controls revert to the factory settings.

Notes

- After the RESET button is pressed, it takes a while before the **Setup** screen is displayed. Do not press the RESET button again while resetting.
- If  (the Left button) is not pressed long enough, the hard reset may not be performed.
- (Only available for certain models or areas.) In order to change the language settings, you need to perform a hard reset.

However, the erased data and applications can be restored with the next HotSync® operation.

Notes

- Some add-on applications (not installed at the factory), and some application data and settings may not be backed up using the HotSync® operation. However, a complete backup of all data on your CLIÉ handheld can be made with **Memory Stick Backup**. Use **Memory Stick Backup** often to make complete backups.

Note

When HOLD mode is active, if you try to turn on your CLIÉ handheld using the Applications or CAPTURE buttons, or the Lens Cover Lever, the POWER LED blinks 3 times, but the power is not turned on.

- ▶ Has the battery power of your CLIÉ handheld run out?
Connect your CLIÉ handheld to the AC power adapter with the plug adapter, then allow it to be charged for a few minutes before turning it on. If it turns on, continue charging for approximately four hours and then perform a soft reset.
- ▶ Is the connector between your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter dirty?
You cannot charge your CLIÉ handheld if the connector is dirty. Connect and disconnect your CLIÉ handheld and the plug adapter several times to clean the connector.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button at the back of your CLIÉ handheld (page 35).

The screen is not displayed even though the POWER LED is on

- ▶ Is the POWER/HOLD switch of your CLIÉ handheld in HOLD mode (page 71)?
The screen is not displayed when the POWER/HOLD switch is in HOLD mode. Make sure you release HOLD mode.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button at the back of your CLIÉ handheld (page 35).

My CLIÉ handheld does not respond

- ▶ Is the POWER/HOLD switch of your CLIÉ handheld in HOLD mode (page 71)?
Your CLIÉ handheld does not operate when the POWER/HOLD switch is in HOLD mode. Make sure you release HOLD mode.
- ▶ Is your CLIÉ handheld placed near the IR port of your computer?
Move your CLIÉ handheld away from the IR port of your computer except when performing the IR HotSync® operation, as a malfunction may occur. You can also disable the IR feature by selecting [Off] next to [Beam Receive:] in [General] of the **Preferences** screen.
- ▶ Perform a soft reset by pressing the RESET button at the back of your CLIÉ handheld (page 35).

My CLIÉ handheld keeps turning itself off

- ▶ Your CLIÉ handheld is designed to turn itself off after a period of inactivity (Automatic power-off). You can set the automatic power-off time by selecting time for [Auto-off After:] in [General] of the **Preferences** screen.

- The maximum idle time is 3 minutes.

- ▶ Did you set [After a preset delay] from [Auto Lock Handheld:] in the **Security** screen? If you set [After a preset delay] from [Auto Lock Handheld:], your CLIÉ handheld may turn off after a shorter period even if you set the automatic power-off time.

My CLIÉ handheld does not produce any sounds

The backlight does not turn on when I adjust the brightness level

- ▶ If the brightness is set to the lowest level, the display may be illegible. However, this is not a malfunction.

The LCD display cannot be viewed properly

- ▶ Depending upon the angle of vision, the brightness may be uneven, however, this is not a malfunction. You can adjust the brightness level in the **Adjust Brightness** dialog box displayed by tapping  (page 74) at the bottom left of the Graffiti® 2 writing area. If the backlight is off, you can turn it on by sliding down the POWER/HOLD switch and hold it for more than two seconds.

Applications do not operate properly after a soft reset is performed

- ▶ If you encounter application problems (such as improper operations, unusual display, or freezing during a soft reset) after you performed a reset, the reset may not be completed properly. In such a case, perform a soft reset once again (page 35). If you still cannot solve your problem, try a hard reset (page 36).

Note on performing a reset

Error messages


An error message appears repeatedly

- ▶ If there is insufficient memory space in your CLIÉ handheld or “Memory Stick” media, applications may not work properly. Delete any unnecessary data/files.

Tip

You can check the memory space in your CLIÉ handheld or “Memory Stick” media by tapping  at the top right of the CLIE Launcher and select [(All)].

I cannot enter text properly

My CLIÉ handheld does not recognize handwritten characters (when using Graffiti® 2)

- ▶ To have your CLIÉ handheld recognize handwritten characters entered with the stylus, you must use Graffiti® 2.
 - For details, refer to “Entering text on your CLIÉ™ handheld: Using Graffiti® 2 writing to enter text” in the “Handbook” (PDF format).
- ▶ Make sure you enter the Graffiti® 2 strokes in the Graffiti® 2 writing area (page 75).
- ▶ Make sure you enter the Graffiti® 2 strokes for letters in the left side of the Graffiti® 2 writing area and numbers in the right side (page 75).

- ▶ Check that Graffiti® 2 is not shifted into Symbol mode.

 - Delete any unnecessary data/files and then perform the HotSync® operation again.
- ▶ Are you using the same user name that is used for another CLIÉ handheld?
 - Change the user name.

Verifying your computer

Note

Upgrade versions of operating systems are not supported.

- ▶ If you are using Windows 2000 Professional or Windows XP, log in as an “Administrator.”
- ▶ Is the USB cable properly connected to your computer (page 19)?
- ▶ Is  (HotSync) displayed in the task tray (Notification area) at the bottom right of your computer window?
If not, click [Start], select [Programs] ([All Programs] for Windows XP)-[Sony Handheld], and click [HotSync Manager] to start **HotSync Manager**.
- ▶ Is [Local USB] in the shortcut menu selected? (You can display this by clicking  (HotSync) in the task tray (Notification area).)
If not, select [Local USB].

Check whether the USB port works normally by connecting another USB device, such as a USB mouse.

I cannot start the HotSync® operation by tapping (HotSync) on the HotSync screen

- ▶ Is the application set not to synchronize files?
Click  (HotSync) in the task tray (Notification area) at the bottom right of your computer window and select [Custom...] from the shortcut menu. Check that the application is set to synchronize files.
- ▶ Is third party backup or synchronization software installed on your computer or CLIÉ handheld?
In such a case, you may not synchronize some applications using **Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ**.
- ▶ Is there sufficient memory space in your CLIÉ handheld?
Delete unnecessary data/files and then perform the HotSync® operation again.
- ▶ Is private data hidden in the **Security** screen?

I cannot back up some data using the HotSync® operation

If you cannot solve your HotSync® operation problem by following the troubleshooting tips in this manual, follow the procedure below.



Note

This “Unknown device” may appear in the Device Manager only while your CLIE handheld tries to connect to your computer. After your CLIE handheld has timed out and displayed an error message on a window, it disconnects from your computer and this “Unknown device”, if it was present, will disappear and you will not see it.

Check if any “Unknown device” is listed in the Device Manager on your computer.

The **System Properties** window is displayed.

- 2 If you are using Windows 2000 Professional/Windows XP, click [Hardware].
- 3 Click [Device Manager].

A device with such mark is not operating normally. Contact the manufacturer of the device to get information on the latest device drivers.

You cannot perform the HotSync® operation before you install Palm™ Desktop for CLIE on your computer

If you perform the HotSync® operation before you install the CLIE handheld drivers on your computer, other drivers may be installed on your computer and a problem may occur in your computer system.

Make sure you install **Palm™ Desktop for CLIE** before performing the HotSync® operation.

Do not use a USB hub

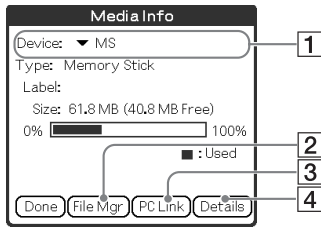

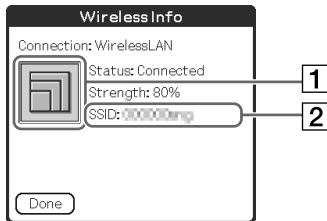

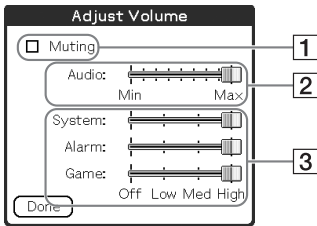

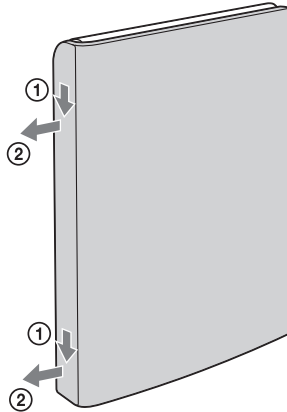

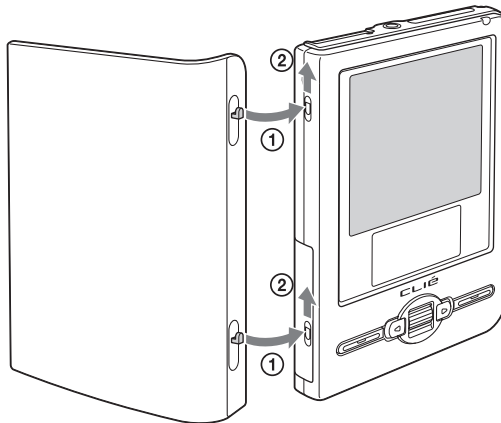
Removing the protective soft cover from your CLIÉ handheld
