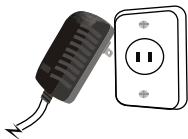

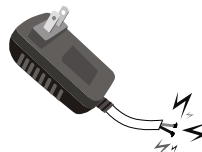

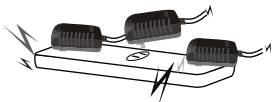

06. Disconnect the power supply during inclement weather conditions that include thunder and lightning. Failure to do so could result in fire.



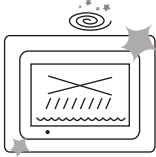

Electronic Frame:

Front side

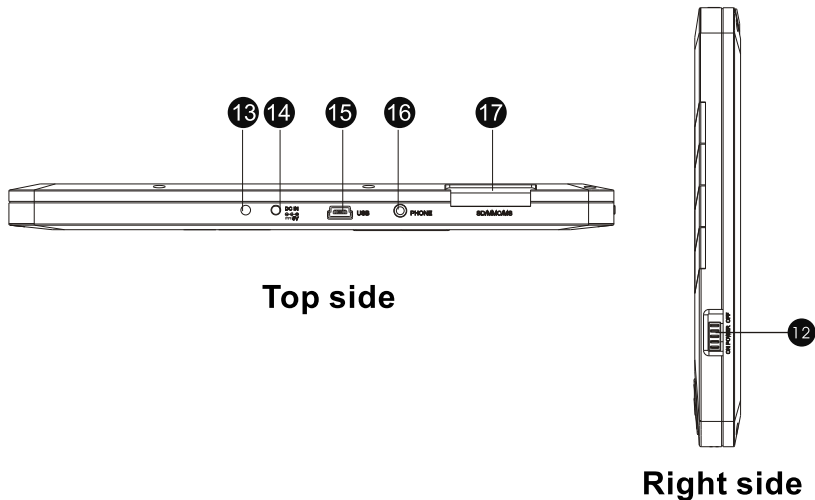


Front side:

1. **TXT:** Press to enter the E-book reading interface directly
2. **MOVIE:** Press to enter the video playing interface directly.
3. **MUSIC:** Press to enter the audio playing interface directly.
4. **PHOTO:** Press to enter the photo show interface directly.
5. **OK:** Press to enter or confirm (Please find special use for OK in Chapter 3)
6. **Directional buttons:** Press to move up/down/left/right
7. **Set up:** Press to set up slideshow time, transition effect, repeat mode, display mode, brightness, contrast, saturation, default.
8.  : Press to enter the book page that you have read last time
9.  : Photos can be zoomed by pressing this key.
10.  : Press to exit from the present interface
11.  : Press to skip to the previous or next file(page or video or audio)

Parts and components



Right side:

12. **Power off/on:** Press down the button to turn on, press up to turn off.

Top side:

- 13. **Indicator:** When the eReader is connected to the power, the red indicator will light up.
- 14. **DC IN:** Insert the DC power adapter to the eReader .
- 15. **USB:** Connect to the USB cable from the eReader to PC.
- 16. **Earphone:** Insert for earphone use
- 17. **Memory cards:** Insert SD/MMC/MS card

Chapter 2 Connection

Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN 5V jack on the eReader.
2. Plug the AC Adapter to a power jack to supply power to the eReader and charge up the built-in battery.



Tip:

1. When charging up the battery, the indicator beside the DC IN 5V jack will light up as red light, after charging up the battery for about 5.5 hours, the indicator will turn to green light, which means that the electrification for the eReader has been finished.
2. If there is power in the built-in battery, you can use the eReader directly.
3. Please don't unplug the power adaptor when the duration of charge is less than 30 minutes, or it may cause a white screen.

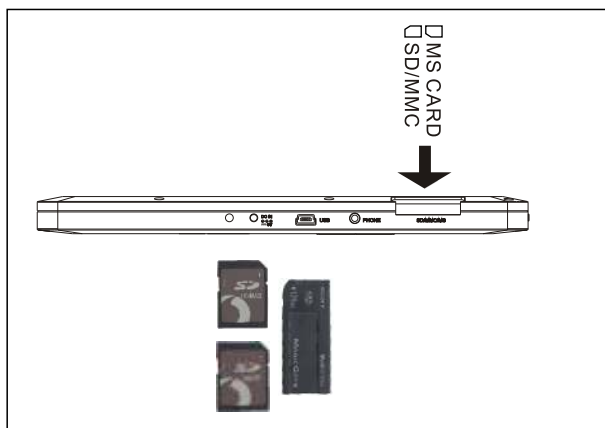

Cards Connection

Insert a kind of memory card

Insert card in the direction indicated by the arrow on the top of the card.(the side of the memory card on which sticker is affixed should face the frame)

SD,MMC and MS cards are compatible with this unit. Aligning the memory card upside down may cause user-error damage. This may nullify the warranty.



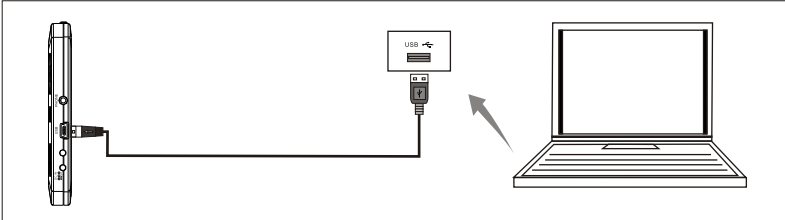
Removing the memory card

When removing a memory card from eReader,pull the card straight away from the unit. Avoid bending the card.

Chapter 2 Connection

PC Connection

Use the supplied USB cable to connect your eReader to your PC.



Note: The ASSP in the internal memory is a software developed by Sungale to manage the picture and audio files to optimize the utilization of the source of the memory.

The ASSP is inapplicable to manage e-book and video files.

To manage e-book and video files, just use the unit as a regular storage device after connecting the unit to the PC.

Tips: 1. If your PC has set as auto-run, you will enter into the ASSP interface directly, no operation needed.

2. The PC installed the anti-virus software or other hold-up software will make the "autorun.inf" invalid. In this situation, the file is set as hidden file. If you want to autorun the ASSP, you can set your PC to display hidden files.

Use ASSP

1. Click "Add File", your computer's files and folders will appear, double click the file or photo to add them to your eReader.

2. Hold on "Shift" or "Ctrl", you can download multi files or photos to your eReader. In this way, the photos downloaded will be stored at 1024X768 pixels to suit your eReader's screen and the MP3 files will be transferred into WMA file. When you have finished the operation, please safely remove the USB cable from your PC.

Tip: You also can take the eReader as a regular storage device, select the photos from your computer, then paste them in the eReader's internal memory. In this way, the photos will be stored without compression. If you want to optimize your internal memory, you can select the photos, then click the "Convert".

Attention: You may find a series of files named "WMEncoder.exe", "FileConverter.exe", "encoder.exe", "Autorun.inf" and "gdiplus.dll" in the internal memory of the unit. It is the ASSP software, and not a virus. You can use it according to the instruction above.

Attention: Once you format the internal memory of your eReader, the ASSP software will be deleted.

In this situation, you can still use the eReader as a regular storage device, you can copy, paste and delete files after connecting your eReader to the PC.


Photo

Locating to the photo directory

Tip 1. Press the shortcut button “PHOTO” in front of the eReader to display the photos directly.



Main menu

1. Select the storage in the main menu and press OK to confirm.
2. Select the PHOTO icon and press OK to enter into the Browsing Mode.
3. Select the desired photo and press OK to display in slide show mode.
4. Press "  " to skip to the previous/next picture.

Background Music

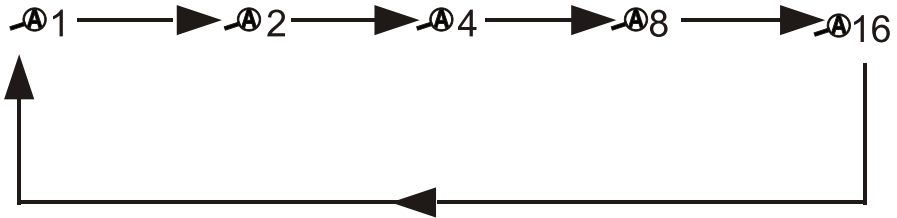
In the slideshow mode, press the shortcut button “MUSIC” to start background music, press the navigation buttons left/right to adjust the volume, press the “MUSIC” button again to stop the background music.

Photo

Zoom

Press the  button to zoom out your pictures. After 16 times zoom in, the picture will be restored to the original state and paused, press OK to continue slideshow.



EXIT

Press the  button to photo browsing mode, and again to the interface including five choices (Movie/Music/Photo/TXT/File), and again to the main menu interface.

Chapter 3 Usage

Music

Locating to the Music Directory

Tip 1. Press the shortcut button “MUSIC” to enter the music playing interface with music file lists. (Exception: In the picture slideshow mode, please exit first, and then press the shortcut button “MUSIC”)

1. Select the storage in the main menu and press OK to confirm.
2. Select the MUSIC icon and press OK to enter into the music file list.
3. Select the desired music and press OK to play the music.



Pausing a song

When the music is playing, press the OK button to pause or play the song.



Adjusting the volume

When the music is playing, press the left/right navigation button to turn down/up the volume.


EXIT

Press **↩** button to return, press three times to the main.

Movie

Locating to the Movie directory

Tip 1. Press the shortcut button MOVIE to enter movie playing interface.
Press “” to play the previous or next video.

1. Select the storage in the main menu and press OK to confirm.
2. Select the MOVIE icon and press OK to enter into the movie file list.
3. Select the desired movie and press OK to play.




Adjusting volume

Press the left/right navigation button to decrease/increase the volume under movie playing mode.

Exit

Press  to return (press three times to the main menu)

Tips

If your video format is not supported by this eReader, the screen may turn to black, at this time, please press  to play another video.

Chapter 3 Usage

E-book

Locating to the E-book Directory

- Tip 1: Press the shortcut button TXT to enter the E-book reading interface.
- Tip 2:
1. Select the storage in the main menu and press OK to confirm.
 2. Select the TXT icon and press OK to enter into the E-book file list.
 3. Select the desired E-book in TXT format and press OK to read.

Upper row/Next row:

Press the navigation button “up” or “down” to skip to the upper or next row.


Press  to turn pages directly.

Rotate


In the E-book reading interface, turn your eReader to horizontal or vertical angel, the text would rotate automatically to fit the screen angel.



Bookmark

In the E-book reading interface, press  button to set the present page (for example: Page 315) as a bookmark, when you enter the E-book reading interface next time, the bookmark page (Page 315) would appear automatically.

EXIT

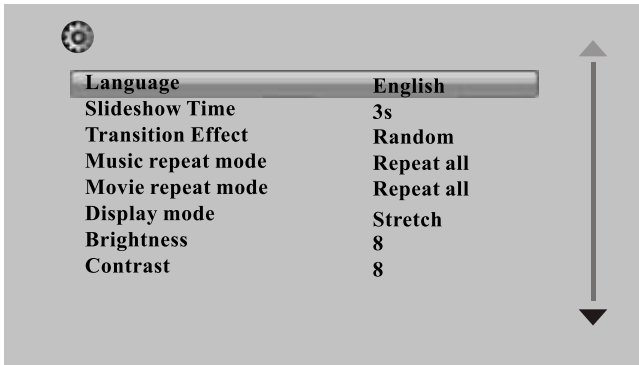
Press  key to exit. (press three times to the main menu)

Chapter 4 Settings

SETUP

Tip1: In the photo slide show mode, press Exit button to enter the main menu mode and select the Setup menu.

- Tip2: 1. Press the shortcut button SETUP or press the SETTINGS icon in the main menu to enter the setup interface.
2. Press the up/down navigation button to select the desired item, and press the left/right navigation button to change the value.
3. Press OK to confirm operation.



Language

The OSD language is English

Slideshow Time

You can set the photo slide show interval time from 3s to 1 hour.

Transition Effect

You can set the photo slide show interval effect as below: Random, Sequential, Bottom-to-top, etc.

SETUP

Music repeat mode

There are three music repeat mode for choice: Repeat all, repeat off, repeat one

Movie repeat mode

There are three movie repeat mode for choice: Repeat all, repeat off, repeat one

Display mode

There are 3 choices: stretch, cinema, crop. Select the Stretch mode to display entire photos after cropping; select the Cinema mode to display entire photos without cropping, or Crop mode to display photos in original size

Brightness/Contrast/Saturation

You can select the item to adjust the brightness/ contrast/saturation.

Default

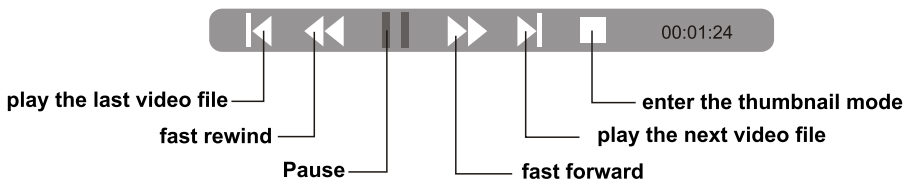
Press to restore all the settings to the original state.

Special Use for OK button

Setup movie playing

In the video playing mode, press “OK” for more than 3 seconds until there are icons in a row appear on the screen, from left to right, the function of these icons are as follow:



Note:

Fast Forward and Fast Rewind: Press the navigation buttons(left/right) to select the fast rewind/fast forward icon(the selected icon may turn to blue). Press OK once, you will get double speed to rewind/forward, press twice to tripled speed, and press the third time, it will be four times speed to rewind/forward.

Play and Pause: press the left/right navigation button to select the pause icon, press to playing normal and press again to pause the video.

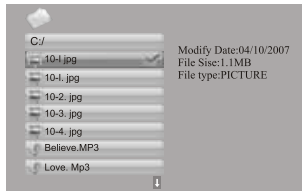
Special Use for OK button

Enter the File List

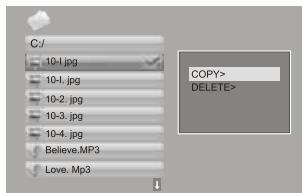
1. Select the storage in the main menu, press OK to confirm.
2. Press the navigation buttons to select the FILE icon, select the folder and press OK to enter the file list.

Copy Function

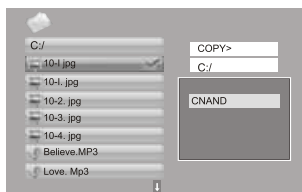
1. In the file list, press the navigation buttons to select the file you'd like to copy and press right navigation button to make a mark for the desired file.



2. Hold OK button for more than 3 seconds, there will be two choices appeared on the screen: COPY and DELETE.



3. Press the right navigation button to select the COPY icon, press OK to select the location of storage. (internal memory or memory cards)
4. Press the right navigation button to confirm, use the up/down navigation button choose the desired folder.



5. Press OK to confirm copy operation.

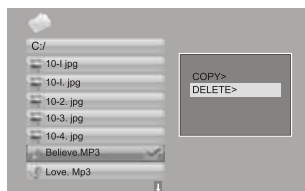

Delete function

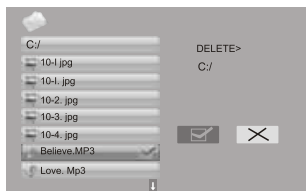
1. In the file list, Press the navigation buttons to select the file you'd like to copy and press right navigation button to make a mark for the desired file.



2. Hold OK button for more than 3 seconds, there will be two choices appeared on the screen: COPY and DELETE.




3. Press the right navigation button to select the DELETE icon, and press OK to delete the desired file.
4. Press the left/right navigation button to select the "  ", and press OK again to confirm delete operation.

This chapter will attempt to troubleshoot common problems that one may experience with the Multimedia eReader. If this guide does not solve your problem, do not dismantle the machine yourself.

Question	Answer
What are the supported formats of photo, video and audio?	Photo: JPG Audio: WMA (MP3 to WMA convertible) Video: avi
Does the eReader have a built-in memory?	Yes, the eReader has an internal memory to store media files. Please don't rename the memory's name.
Can I insert multiple memory card?	Yes, you can insert one of SD, MMC and MS cards each time.
Why doesn't the picture cover the entire screen?	The resolution of the picture to cover the entire screen must be greater than 800×480 pixels.
Can the eReader player connect with all computers?	No. The USB port of the PC must be USB2.0 and the PC must have Windows 2000 or above.
Why machine does not display picture quickly after inserting memory cards?	If your picture is of high pixels, please wait a minute. Or switch your picture by using ASSP tool.
Why eReader does not read E-book?	The eReader's support format is TXT, please make sure that the format is correct.
Why nothing appears when I choose to play movie?	1. The eReader might be powered off 2. The video format is not supported, please press the  button to watch another video
Where to get ebooks?	Click www.sungale.com and find FAQs, there are a list about where to get ebooks. Make sure download ebooks in TXT format.
How to convert PDF or HTML into TXT files?	Click www.sungale.com and find FAQs, there are methods to convert PDF or HTML into TXT files.
What is the ASSP software?	The ASSP is a software in the internal memory to manage the picture and audio files to optimize the utilization of the source of the memory. It is inapplicable to manage ebook and video files.
How to put the ebook or video files into the memory?	Just use the unit as a regular storage device, copy and paste the files from the PC to the internal memory.

Troubleshooting

If you are having problems with your unit, please consult the trouble shooting guide below. Some simple checks or minor adjustments may restore proper operation.

No power

1. Ensure that you are press and holding the power button for at least 2 seconds
2. Ensure the power outlet is operational
3. Ensure the power cord is not damaged.
4. Ensure the power plug is connected firmly to the outlet.

Can not read the card

1. Check the card for damages.
2. Check the card is connected to the eReader correctly.
3. Pull out the card, and then insert again

The eReader is not working

Turn off the power, and then turn it on again.
