Press **POWER** to turn on/off the player. Press **PLAY/PAUSE** to play or pause. Press **STOP** to stop playing.

Press I to skip to the previous title/chapter/track/picture.

Press ►► to skip to the next title/chapter/track/pic.

2. Top side

A/V OUT: Audio and Video output.

USB HOST: Manage your files in the frame by connecting the USB cable to a PC.


MS CARD/SD/MMC/XD: Insert MS/SD/MMC/XD card.

DC IN: Insert the DC power adaptor to the DPF player.

Remote Control



Power:

Turn the player on and off.

(16:9/4:3)

Switch the ratio picture between original and optimal.

Music:

p_{lay songs}.

Slide Show:

Continually cycle through all of the pictures in the device.

(Step Show:)

Display a single picture; each press will advance one picture at a time.

Note: The SLIDE SHOW and STEP SHOW keys will only be valid when a memory card insert in the DPF.

Note: Remove Insulating Tab to activate battery.

(Navigation Buttons:)

Move the cursor to the desired icon.

Enter:

Enter or confirm.

EXIT:

Stop the current action and return to the previous menu.

(ROTATE:)

Rotate the picture, These operations is available when a picture is playing normally.

ZOOM:

Repeatedly to zoom out/in the picture.

OSD:

Display the state of the playing file.

VIEW:

View the photos in thumbnail mode. Use the up/down/left/right buttons to select the picture and press enter to confirm.

MENU:


Return to the main menu.

(VOL+/-:)

Adjust the player's volume.

Connection

Power Connection




- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC 5V jack at the left side of the product.
- 2. Plug in the power cable.
- 3. Slide the Power switch to power on, then the product will turn on.

Note: When the product is on, this frame can only recognize one of the external device.

Connect to USB Port

USB: Insert various USB portable flash driver as an extra source.




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Connection

Memory Card insertion

Insert card in the direction indicated by the arrow on the top of the card. (The side of the memory card on which the sticker is affixed should face to the front)

Aligning the memory card upside down or to the reverse side may cause damage that is the sole responsibility of the user. (Use SD, Memory Stick, MMC cards, XD card enabled)



- Note: 1. MS Duo isn't compatible alone. But it can be supported with the help of MS Duo adapter.
 - 2. It is recommended that a full format be performed before using a memory card for the first time.
 - 3. This device will read USB only and will not recognise the memory card if you insert a memory card and extra USB memory together at the same time
- **Note:** The product will display the images stored in the external devices first and will not display the images in the internal memory if you insert an external devices.

Photo

The screen will display the main menu automatically when power on the unit.




Displaying photos

- **Step 1.** Select **PHOTO** item in the main menu and press ENTER button to enter the slide show.
- Step 2. Press EXIT button to enter the Thumbnail mode.

Note: Please set up the photo browser on Thumbnail mode first.

Step 4. Press ENTER button to view this photo in full screen





Note:

- 1. For best display, you can crop the photos to the size: 540x302 pixels.
- 2. After inserting a card, press the SLIDE SHOW button repeatly to select Slide On/Off to play the photos automatically/manually.

Rotating a Photo

During photo playing mode, press the **ROTATE** button to rotate(clockwise) the photo to the desired position.





Zoom

During photo playback, Press ZOOM button to magnify the image as follows:

→ 25% → 50% → 100% → 150% → 200% ¬




Movie

Playing a movie

Step 1. Select MOVIE icon in the main menu and press ENTER button to play a movie directly.



Step 2. When playing a movie, press EXIT button to enter into the video file list.



Step 3. Select a movie in the file list and press ENTER button to play the movie.

Adjusting the Volume

During playback ,use the (+) VOL (-) buttons to adjust the volume.



Music



Playing a song

Step 1. Select MUSIC icon in the main menu and press ENTER button to enter into the music file list

Step 2. Use the navigation buttons to select the desired song.

Step 3. Press Enter button to play the selected song.

Note: During playback, press PLAY/PAUSE button on the right side of the panel to pause the song. Press the button again to continue playing

Adjusting the volume

During playback, use the Vol+ or Vol- buttons to adjust the volume.



Photo + Music

Tip1:

Press MENU to enter the main menu screen, select Photo+Music to start displaying photos in music background.



Tip2:

During the pictures displaying, press the MUSIC button to display the pictures in music background. Background. (Press the MUSIC button again to mute the sound.)

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Operations in Setup Menu

Make a Setting

Step 1. Select Setup icon in the main menu to enter the SETUP menu.



Step 2. Press the \blacktriangle or \triangledown buttons to select items.



Step 3. Press the button to enter the sublist.



Step 4. Press ▲ or ▼ buttons to select desired setting items

Step 5. Press OK to confirm the selected setting.

Step 6. Press the Exit button to return to the main menu, and your setting values will be saved automatically.

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Photo Setting. Then select Interval Time item to set the desired time.





Music

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Auto-play. Then select Music item to set on / off.

Set the music playback auto or manual:

- 1. ON: It will auto display the music when enter into the music menu mode.
- 2. OFF: For manual play.

Movie

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Auto-play. Then select Movie item to set on / off.

Set the movie playback auto or manual:

- 1. ON: It will auto display the movie when enter into the movie menu mode.
- 2. OFF: For manual play.

Brightness

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select Brightness item to change the brightness mode.

Contrast

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select Contrast item to adjust the contrast.

TFT Brightness

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select TFT Brightness item to adjust the TFT brightness.

TFT Contrast

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select TFT Contrast item to adjust the TFT contrast.

TFT Saturation

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select TFT Saturationt item to adjust the TFT saturation.

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Setup Menu - Custom Setup

OSD Language

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select OSD Language item to change the displaying language.

Style

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select Style item to set different style.

Repeat Mode

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select Repeat Mode item to set different repeat mode.

Default

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select Default item to reset the unit to factory default.

In the Setup menu mode, select Setup Menu-Exit and press ENTER button to exit the Setup menu..

Editing

Edit: Adding the pictures from external memory to the DPF, or deleting the pictures stored in the DPF.

Copying pictures


Step 1. Select EDIT item in the main menu and press ENTER button to enter into the Edit mode.



Step 2. Select Copy item in the Edit Dialog and press ENTER button to enter into the file list

Step 3. Select the picture you want in the file list and press Enter button to confirm.




Note: there is a remark on the file name that is selected. The DPF only can store 15 pictures. If you exceed 15 pictures, the selected picture will not be remarked.

Editing

Step 4. Select Save item and press ENTER button to start transfer the pictures.

Step 5. After saving, you can press Exit button to return to main menu.



Deleting pictures

Note: Pictures deleted cannot be recovered. Thinking over carefully before you confirm to delete.

Step 1. Select EDIT item in the main menu and press ENTER button to enter into the Edit mode.

Step 2. Select Delete item and press ENTER button to enter Edit Mode.

Step 3. Select the Delete item in the Edit Mode.

Step 4. Select the picture you want in the file list and press Enter button to select.

(If you want to delet all pictures in the frame, you can press Delete All item)





Sort

- Step 1. Select the Sort item in the edit mode and press ENTER to enter the Sort Mode.
- **Step 2.** Select the desired photo and press ENTER button to enter the photo browse screen.
- Step 3. Press the direction key to move the photo.
- **Step 4.** Press the Exit button to return to the main menu, and your setting values will be saved automatically.

Question & Answer

Q&A

This chapter will attempt to troubleshoot common problems that one may experience with the Multimedia DPF. If this guide does not solve your problem, do not dismantle the machine yourself.

Question	Answer
What memory cards are compatible with the digital frame?	Secure Digital Card (SD)/MultiMedia Card (MMC)/XD/ Memory Stick .
Does Multimedia Digital Photo Frame have built-in memory?	Yes. The player has an internal memory to store media file. You can store 15 pictures at most.
What is the best picture resolution displayed on the screen?	The player's best resolution is 480 X 234.
Can I rotate a picture on the screen?	Yes. Use the ROTATE button on the remote control to rotate a picture. Note: The rotated picture will return to its original orientation after you power off the digital frame.
Can I adjust the colors of the picture?	No. All color settings are preset at the factory. You can only adjust the brightness and contrast of the screen.
Why Digital picture Frame does not advance to next picture?	 There is only one picture in the frame. You are viewing high -resolution pictures on the card, High-resolution pictures can take longer time to display. You are in single picture display. The next picture is damaged.
Why is only 15 pictures displayed?	Use the NEXT button to see next 15 pictures thumbnail.
Why picture display seems slow?	You are viewing high-resolution pictures, high- resolution pictures can take longer time to display.
Why Digital Picture Frame doesn't display any pictures?	Make sure the pictures are in JPEG format. Make sure you have inserted a card or USB device properly and selected the PHOTO icon in the main menu. Or make sure there are pictures in the internal memory and you have selected the FAVORITE icon in the main menu.
How can I see the file list?	Please set setup Menu-Photo Setting. Browse item to File Manger.

Could not read the card	 Please copy the content in your card to your PC, then format your card, then past your photos/music/movies in your card again, then insert the card to DPF to read it. Ensure the card is not damaged Ensure the card is connected to the DPF correctly Ensure the card has content(photo/ music/movie), if no content in card, the screen will display "no playable file" Do not insert your card and USB together at same time. Otherwise one of the devices can not be recognized
Could not read the USB portable flash driver	Do not insert your card and USB together at same time. Otherwise one of the devices can not be recognized
Remote control not working	 Ensure the batteries are inserted Ensure the batteries "protective plastic" is pulled out.
