

Sungale CD706A is a portable eReader and digital album. With its colorful LCD screen, you can review pictures, enjoy music, watch video, read eBooks and display calendar and clock as well as set up alarm clock. Besides, it has built-in dictionary for unknown words inquiry. It supports files of many formats. Please find its specification as follow:










Navigation controls



1 Indicator

Lights up in red while charging and lights up in green after charging complete.

- 2 DC IN slot
 Insert the DC power adaptor to the unit.
- 3 USB connector

Connect the unit to the PC.

- 4 PHONE
- __ Insert for earphone use.
- 5 SD/MMC card slot
- 6 EXIT

Return to the previous menu or item.

- 7 Navigation Button
 - **OK**: Press to confirm and enter.
 - ▲/▼:Press to move the cursor up and down, turn to the previous page and next page, and when displaying the video or audio, press the buttons to adjust the volume.

- IPress to move the cursor left and right, and turn to the previous row and next row.
- 8 Power Switch

Press to the right to power on, and press to the left to power off.

9 Book

Press the button to enter into the ebook list in the internal memory directly.

10 Photo

Press the button to enter into the photo list in the internal memory directly.

11 Book Mark

Press to add a new book mark while reading.

12 **Zoom**


Press to zoom in while reading.

Memory cards and PC connection

Insert a memory card

Insert card in the direction indicated by the arrow on the top of the card. (the side of the memory card on which sticker is affixed should face in the opposite direction as you look at the frame)

SD and MMC cards are compatible with this unit. Aligning the memory card upside down and forcing the card in the frame may cause damage. Please take caution when inserting a memory card.



Removing the Memory Card

When removing a memory card from the unit pull the card straight up and away. Avoid bending the card.

Memory cards and PC connection

PC connection

Use the supplied USB cable to connect your Entertainment Station to PC. Insert the small end of the USB cable into the unit and the large end into an open USB slot on your computer. After connection the internal memory and any card inserted into the unit will be accessible in Windows

by going to the "MY COMPUTER" Window and accessing the "removable disc" icons(s). Under a Mac OS-X system the unit will show up on the Mac desktop.

To disconnect; User the "Safely Remove Hardware" icon on the task bar window to remove the device. Then disconnect the USB cable.



Use ASSP

- **1.**Click "FileConverter.exe" and then click "Add File", your computer's files and folders will appear, double click the file or photo to add them to your eReader.
- 2. Hold on "Shift" or "Ctrl", you can download multi files or photos to your eReader. In this way, the photos downloaded will be stored at 800×600 pixels to suit your eReader screen and the MP3 files will be transferred into WMA file. When you have finished the operation, please safely remove the USB cable from your PC.

Tip: You also can take the eReader as a regular storage device, select the photos from your computer, and then paste them into internal memory of your eReader In this way, the photos will be stored without compression. If you want to optimize your internal memory, you can select the photos, then click the "Convert".

Attention: Once you format the internal memory of your eReader the ASSP software will be deleted.

In this situation, you can still use the eReader as a regular storage device, you can copy, paste and delete files after connecting your eReader to the PC. But there will be no ASSP tool to convert files anymore.

Reading eBooks

1.Choosing a book

There are two ways to find books on the unit.

- In the main menu, use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to select the Books menu and press OK.
- Press the Book button.
- 2. Continue reading
 - In the main menu, use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to select the Continue Reading menu and press OK to continue reading the ebook from your last session.
- 3.To turn rows, press the ▲ / ▼ buttons, and press the ◀ / ▶ buttons to turn pages.
- 4. When reading eBooks in WORD format, the text content will be fully displayed. If there are pictures or diagrams in your WORD format eBook, then the pictures will not be displayed.
- 5.To add a bookmark, just press the Book Mark button while reading; In the main menu, select the Bookmarks menu and press OK to enter into the bookmark list, select a bookmark and press OK to continue reading.
- 6. Press "Zoom" to increase the font size.
- 7. To return to the previous menu, press the Exit button.

Getting eBooks

- 1.To purchase or download ebooks on internet. Put the purchased or downloaded ebooks to the SD/MMC cards or to your computer.
- 2.Insert SD/MMC cards to the eReader if there are ebooks in the cards, and the eReader can read the ebooks in the cards directly.
- 3.If the ebooks are in the computer, use the USB cable to connect the eReader to the computer, copy and paste the ebooks to the storage of eReader. After the file transfer, please Safely Remove Hardware from the PC, and then directly unplug the USB connection, then find and read the ebooks in the storage of eReader.
- 4.The eReader can support the ebooks formarts as below: TXT, HTML, EPUB, FB2, CHM, PLUCKER, PALMDOC, ZTXT, TCR, RTF, OEB, OPENREADER, NON-DRM'ED MOBIPOCKET, and support plain WORD format ebook text.

Books

When you turn on the machine, it will go to the main menu and the underline will stop at the first option---"Continue Reading".

Press "OK" button to read the book that you have read last time.

How to read a book in the eReader

If you haven't read any book before, please press ▼ to move the underline to "Books" and press "OK" button to enter the internal memory (or also with SD/MMC card if you have inserted it into your eReader).

Press "OK" to enter "Internal memory", a folder named "demo" will appear, press OK to enter the eBooks list.

You may also press the "Book" button to enter the eBooks list directly. Press \bigvee / \bigwedge to move the underline to select a book and press OK to start reading.

When reading a book, press ▼ / ▲ to turn rows, and press ◀ / ▶ to turn pages.

How to set up a bookmark and delete a bookmark

When reading a book and you want to make a bookmark for the present page, press "Book Mark" icon, a quill-pen will appear on the upper-right corner of the screen. Then this page has been bookmarked.

When you read this book next time, go to the main menu and press ∇ to move the underline to "Bookmarks". Press OK to find the bookmark. And then press OK to enter the bookmark page.

If you want to delete the bookmark, select the bookmark and press OK to enter that page, then press "Book Mark", the bookmark will be deleted.

Photos

There are two ways to go to photos.

1. In the main menu, press ▼ to move the underline to "Photos" and press OK, you will find "Internal memory" or also with SD/MMC card listed. Press OK to enter. There will be files listed. Press OK to start playing pictures.

2. Press "Photo" button and the pictures names will be listed on the screen. Press OK to start playing pictures.

There will be several icons at the bottom of the screen, there functions are as follow:



:Add or close background music

:full screen slideshow

:last picture

:next picture

:rotate photos

:return

Press ◀ / ▶ to select the 6 icons above and press OK to confirm you selection.

Music

In the main menu, press ▼ to move the underline to "Music" and press OK, you will see "Internal memory" or also with SD/MMC card listed. Press OK to enter the songs list. Then press ▼/▲ to select the song you want to play. And then press OK to play.

There will be several icons at the bottom of the screen, there related functions are as follow:



:show songs list
:Play
:Pause
:Last song

:Next song

Press "Exit" button to exit.

Video

In the main menu, press ▼ to move the underline to "Video" and press OK, you will see "Internal memory" or also with SD/MMC card listed. Press OK to enter the video files list. Then press ▼/▲ to select the video you want to play. And then press OK to play.

Press \bigvee / \triangle to adjust volume and press \bigvee / \triangle to play the last or next video. Press OK to pause or continue play.



Clock

How to set up date and time

In the main menu, press ▼ to move the underline to "Clock" and press OK to enter the interface with three options: Set Date, Set Time, Set Alarm. And "Set Date" is highlighted in yellow.

Press OK to set Date and you will enter the interface as follow:



Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ to change month, day and year and press $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$ to move cursor among month, day and year.

Press OK when finished setting. It will return to the clock with calendar interface. Press \blacktriangleright to move cursor to "Set Time" and it will be highlighted in yellow. Press OK to confirm. Then press $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$ to move cursor among hour and minute, and press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ to change the time. Press OK when finished and it will return to the clock with calendar interface.

How to set up alarm clock

Press ▶ to move cursor to "Set Alarm" and press OK to confirm. Press ◀ / ▶ to move cursor among time and alarm clock state(OFF/ON), and press ▲ / ▼ to set up alarm clock time and change alarm clock state between OFF and ON. Press OK when finished setting and it will return to the clock with calendar interface.

Tips: please make sure that your eReader has power and has been turned on when alarm clock time is up, and the alarm clock state has been set up to "ON", or the alarm clock bell won't ring.



Clock

5 minutes snooze

This alarm clock has 5 minutes snooze function. When time is up, the bell will ring and cursor will stay at "Snooze" for the first time. At this time, if you want 5 minutes snooze, please just press OK and the alarm clock bell will ring again after 5 minutes. Or else press ▶ then press OK to exit. Then the alarm clock bell won't ring after 5 minutes.

After the first 5 minutes snooze and the alarm clock bell is ringing, the cursor will stay at "Exit" icon. If you just press OK then the alarm clock bell won't ring after 5 minutes. If you need 5 minutes again, you have to press ◀ and then OK to have another 5 minutes snooze.

Dictionary

In the main menu, press ▼ to move the underline to "Dictionary" and press OK to enter the interface as follow:



Input the words by using the on-screen-keyboard. Press ◀ / ▶to move cursor left or right and press ◀ / ▶ to move cursor up and down.

When you finished inputting, move the cursor to "Back" and then press \bigvee to move cursor to "Search", then press OK to search the word. The related word explanation will appear on the screen.

Press ▼ / ▲ to turn rows and press "Exit" button to exit.

Setting

In the main menu, press \bigvee to move the underline to "Setting" and press OK to enter the interface with two options: Slideshow interval; Information. The underline will stay at "Slideshow interval".

Press OK to set up slideshow interval, you may choose 5 seconds, 10 seconds or 15 seconds by pressing \blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown . And then press OK to confirm. It will go back to the last interface.

Press ▼ to move the underline to "Information" and press OK to find the technology information of your eReader such as software version.
