

Setting up the DocuPrint P365 d printer on a wireless network with Mac OSX



Before you begin

Ensure your Mac is already setup on your network, and you have your network name (SSID), type of security encryption (type of password), and wireless network password.

To find the name and type of security encryption on your Mac computer (OS X 10.9):

- a) Go to System preferences.
- b) Click Network
- c) Select Wifi (on some OS X 10.X versions it is Airport).
- d) Click Advanced.
- e) Note your preferred network name and the associated type of security encryption.

Install the WiFi Adapter to your Printer


At the back of the printer:

- 1 Switch off the power to the printer. The switch is located on the lower left side of the printer.
- 2 Unpack the Wireless Network Adapter.
- 3 Insert the Wireless Network Adapter into the Wireless Network Adapter Port on the rear left of the printer.




Switch on the power to the printer.

Connect the printer to the Network





Press the small green Energy Saver button to wake up the printer





Press the System button. This is the button to the top left of the LCD screen.

8 At the printer power switch turn off the printer, wait five (5) seconds before turning the printer back on. Wait a few minutes while the printer restarts.

To check that the printer is connected to the wireless network:

- a) Press the **System** button on the operator panel.
- b) Scroll to **Admin Menu** and press **OK**.
- c) Scroll to **Network Menu** and press **OK**.
- c) Select Wireless Status and press OK.

If the status is **Good** the printer is successfully connected.

Install the drivers on your Mac computer

The following procedure uses Mac OS X 10.9 as an example:

- Run the PostScript Library CD-ROM on the Mac OS X.
- 2 Double-click FXSOPS-PS.
- 3 Double-click the **English** folder.
- Double-click the MacOSX10.3.9--10.7 folder.
- 5 Double-click mac103ps.dmg
- 6 Double-click P355 Print Installer, then click Continue.
- Click Continue.
- 8 If you agree to the terms and conditions, click **Continue** and then click Agree.
- 9 Click Install.
- 10 Enter your computer password if requested, and click Install software.
- 11 Click Close.

Add the printer

The following procedure uses Mac OS X 10.9 as an example.

- 1 From the Apple menu, open your System Preferences, then click Printers & Scanners.
- 2 Click the + plus sign and select Fuji Xerox DocuPrint P355 d

Wait while the printer is set up and then print a test page

With the Fuji Xerox DocuPrint P355 d selected. Click Open Print Queue, then from the Printer menu choose Print Test Page, when successful a test page will print.

The printer is now set up on your computer

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
