




Buzz Lightyear's Electronic Spaceship


Thanks for purchasing this Toy Story toy!

Includes ship, launcher, 2 projectiles and figure.




NOTE: Adult should remove and discard all plastic fasteners.


Playtime




 Press green button to activate engine lights and blasting sounds.




Push "secret" switch to activate trap door.



Use tabs on back to reveal command center




2. Press red button to launch.

- Press button to launch projectile and activate lights and sounds.


Note: Launcher can be used with other awesome Toy Story playsets and vehicles.

To Replace Batteries

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment door (screw remains attached to door). Remove door and discard old batteries. Insert 2 x 1.5V fresh "AA" or R6 size batteries. Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace door and tighten screw.

CAUTION:

- 1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
- 2. Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;

CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert item correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.

- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
