## 3Com Limited Warranty

The following standard limited warranty applies to the SuperStack II Switch 3800 1000BASE-SX Interface Connector (Part Number 3C16911). For the purposes of this standard limited warranty, the Switch 3800 1000BASE-SX Interface Connector is classified as "Other hardware products" (see below).

HARDWARE: 3Com warrants its hardware products to be free from defects in workmanship and materials, under normal use and service, for the following lengths of time from the date of purchase from 3Com or its Authorized Reseller:

Network adapters: Lifetime

Other hardware products: One year unless otherwise specified above

Spare parts and spares kits: 90 days

If a product does not operate as warranted above during the applicable warranty period, 3Com shall, at its option and expense, repair the defective product or part, deliver to Customer an equivalent product or part to replace the defective item, or refund to Customer the purchase price paid for the defective product. All products that are replaced will become the property of 3Com. Replacement products may be new or reconditioned. - 4 Slide the connector as far back into the slot as possible, until you hear it click.

The SuperStack II Switch 3800 can now be connected to a 1000BASE-SX network.
