- 2 Click on **AcerSystem User Guide.**



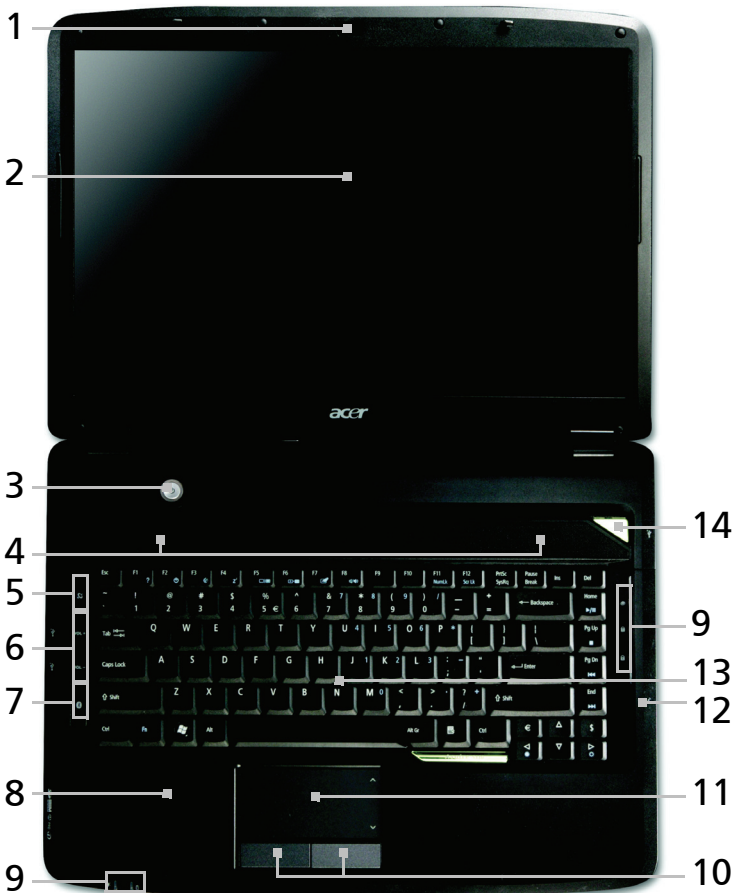

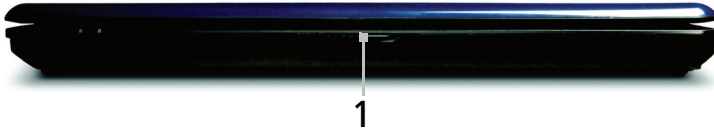

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Acer Crystal Eye webcam	Web camera for video communication (only for certain models).

#	Icon	Item	Description
2		Display screen	Also called Liquid-Crystal Display (LCD), displays computer output.
3		Power button	Turns the computer on and off.
4		Speakers	Left and right speakers deliver stereo audio output.
5/7		Easy-launch buttons	Buttons for launching frequently used programs. Please refer to the Generic User Guide for more details.
6	VOL+/ VOL-	Volume up/ Volume down	Increases the sound volume/Decreases the sound volume.
8		Palmrest	Comfortable support area for your hands when you use the computer.
9		Status indicators	Light-Emitting Diodes (LEDs) that light up to show the status of the computer's functions and components. Please refer to the Generic User Guide for more details.
10		Click buttons (left and right)	The left and right buttons function like the left and right mouse buttons.
11		Touchpad	Touch-sensitive pointing device which functions like a computer mouse.
12		Microphone	Internal microphone for sound recording.
13		Keyboard	For entering data into your computer.
14		Empowering key	Launch Acer Empowering Technology.

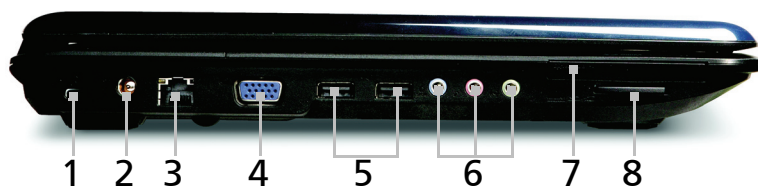

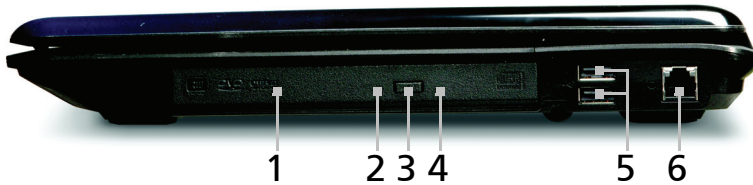

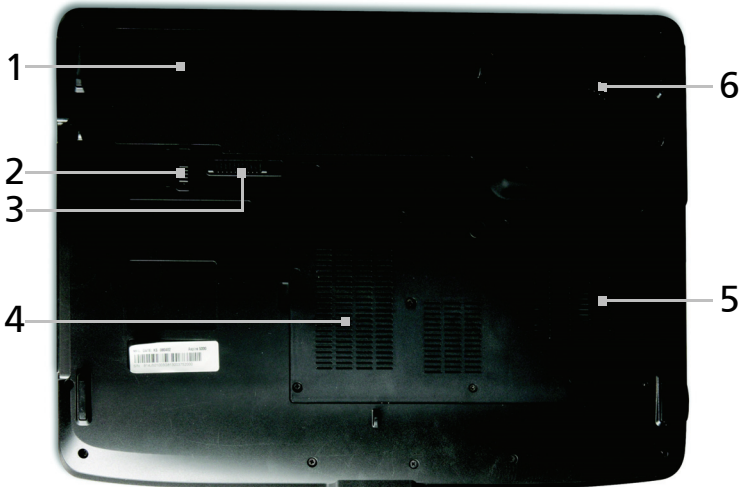

1		Kensington lock slot	Connects to a Kensington-compatible computer security lock.
2		DC-in jack	Connects to an AC adapter.
3		Ethernet (RJ-45) port	Connects to an Ethernet 10/100/1000-based network.
4		External display (VGA) port	Connects to a display device (e.g., external monitor, LCD projector).
5		USB 2.0 port	Connects to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
6		Line-in jack	Accepts audio line-in devices (e.g., audio CD player, stereo walkman, mp3 player)
		Microphone jack	Accepts inputs from external microphones.
		Headphones/speaker/line-out jack	Connects to audio line-out devices (e.g., speakers, headphones).
7		ExpressCard/54 slot	Accepts one ExpressCard/54 module. Note: Push to remove/install the card.
8		5-in-1 card reader	Accepts Secure Digital (SD), MultiMediaCard (MMC), Memory Stick (MS), Memory Stick Pro (MS PRO), and xD-Picture Card. Note: Push to remove/install the card. Only one card can operate at any given time.

1		Optical drive	Internal optical drive; accepts CDs or DVDs.
2		Optical disk access indicator	Lights up when the optical drive is active.
3		Optical drive eject button	Ejects the optical disk from the drive.
4		Emergency eject hole	Ejects the optical drive tray when the computer is turned off. Note: Insert a paper clip to the emergency eject hole to eject the optical drive tray when the computer is off.
5		USB 2.0 port	Connects to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
6		Modem (RJ-11) port	Connects to a phone line.

1		Battery bay	Houses the computer's battery pack.
2		Battery lock	Locks the battery in position.
3		Battery release latch	Releases the battery for removal.
4		Memory compartment	Houses the computer's main memory.

6		Ventilation slots and cooling fan	Enable the computer to stay cool, even after prolonged use. Note: Do not cover or obstruct the opening of the fan.
