

1 DOOR STATIONS

(1)	A call from door station is announced at all programmed master stations by electronic chime.
	* If the chime is 4 strokes, the call is from the first door station.
	Press 5 buttons.
	* If the chime is 2 strokes, the call is from the second door station.

Momentary operation: Press and hold button down to activate door release, etc. Press button.				
(2) When intermittent tone is heard;				
It means other station is operating paging or remote control and the channel is occupied. Press • button to disconnect and call later.				
NOTES: 1. It is not possible to operate two or more adaptors at the same time. 2. Paging/remote control operations can be made by master stations RA-A, RA-B and RA-D.
