When you start your MacBook Air for the first time, Setup Assistant will help It's easy to move files like documents, email, photos, music, and movies you get going. Just follow a few simple steps to guickly connect to your Wi-F to your new Mac from another Mac or a PC. The first time you start your network, transfer your stuff from another Mac or a PC, and create a user new Mac, it will walk you through the process step by step. You'll also be able to log in with your Apple ID, so you can download apps from the App Store, shop the iTunes Store and the Apple Online Store, access iCloud, and make video calls with FaceTime. If you don't have an Apple ID. creating one is easy and free.



Multi-Touch gestures

You can do a lot of things on your MacBook Air using simple gestures on the trackpad. Here are some of the most popular ones.



Double click Press down anywhere on the trackpace Press down two times anywhere on th to click, Or, with Tap to Click enabled trackpad, Or, with Tap to Click enabled. double-tap the surface.

Brush two fingers along the trackpad
